I invite you to join the ACLU delegation on April 25th at the March for Women's Lives in Washington, D.C.

In recent years, we have witnessed an unprecedented attack on our civil liberties, and reproductive rights are a prime target.

Since 1995, states have passed nearly 400 measures that block access to abortion, contraceptives, sexuality education, and other essential reproductive health services.

And last year, the government enacted the first-ever federal ban on abortion aimed at severely curtailing women's ability to obtain abortions after the first trimester. Because of court challenges brought by the ACLU and others, this dangerous and extreme measure has been blocked while the cases proceed.

Now is the time to stand up and say enough is enough. With more than 400,000 members, the ACLU can help make this the largest demonstration for reproductive rights in history. To march with the ACLU, go to aclu.org/marchforwomen or call your local ACLU affiliate.
