As ACLU attorneys have accompanied the men to the interviews, the lawyers have recorded some frequent questions raised during the process. Below is a list of these questions to take note of:

1. Do you attend a mosque?
2. What mosque do you attend?
3. Who attends your mosque?
4. Is there a stockpile of weapons at your mosque?
5. Are there airplane parts at your mosque?
6. Are you religious?
7. How many times a day do you pray?
8. What particular sect do you follow?
9. Who is your religious leader?
10. What do you think of Sadaam Hussein?
11. What do you think of President Bush?
12. Do you have any problems with American policy in the Middle East?
13. What is your social security number?
14. Are you a US Citizen?
15. Give me your passport.
16. Do you have dual citizenships?
17. Do you have any foreign passports?
18. Do you do anything suspicious on flights?
19. Have you ever travel abroad?
20. Have you ever to the Middle East?
21. Do you maintain contacts with any groups overseas? Which groups?
22. Are you in contact with any terrorist groups in your home country?
23. Do you have family in the Middle East?
24. Are you in contact with any terrorist groups in your home country?
25. Do you know anyone in your city who is Iraqi?
26. Do you know anyone in your city who is Iranian?
27. Do you know anyone in your city who is Palestinian?
28. Are you in contact with anyone from Iran?
29. Are you in contact with anyone from Iraq?
30. Are you in contact with anyone from Palestine?
31. What car are you driving?
32. What is your license plate number?
33. Can we go search your car, right now?
34. Give me your cell phone. (agents record all names and numbers stored within)
35. Give me your wallet. (agents sift through and record all contents)
36. Have you ever been arrested?
37. Where were you born?
38. Who are your parents?
39. What are your parents' addresses?
40. What are your children's contact information?
