

testimony -- the quality and condition of NIDA marijuana -- that have previously been disclosed to the Government. Thus, the government will not be prejudiced in addressing this testimony.

Respondent discussed this supplementation with Government's counsel last Friday, August 12, and left a message about it today, but did not hear back by the time Respondent had to file the motion, as to whether the Government objected to the supplementation.
