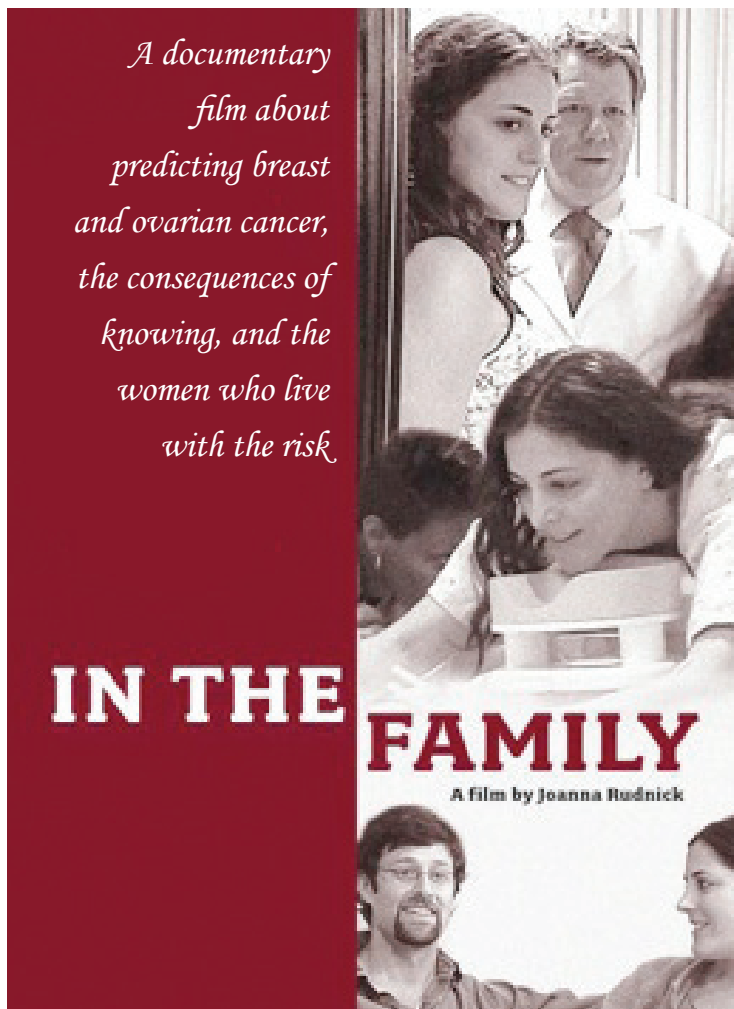


Breast Cancer, Patenting Human Genes & Your Civil Liberties
