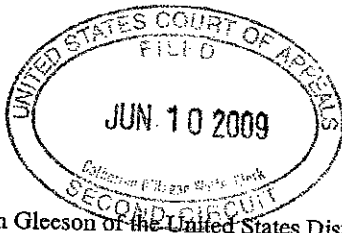
ORDER
