| 06/??/2004 | <p>[redacted] trip to Afghanistan in June 2004 was for the purposes of assessing the Federal Bureau of Investigation's mission but also to determine how to enhance the contribution of his Fly Team personnel in the global war on terror. He did not sit in on or observe any detainee interviews during this Afghanistan assessment trip. Other than courtesy calls on military personnel in Bagram, he did not spend more than an hour with military personnel as part of his assessment work, explaining who they were and that they were there to determine if they would be a good fit with the military. Does not recall discussing with the military the issue of how Federal Bureau of Investigation and military personnel would work together in the interviews of detainees.
