In that capacity, he said he had oversight over Military Liaison and Detainee Unit (including U.S. Naval Base Guantanamo Bay, Cuba -- working with Naval Criminal Investigative Service in Ft. Belvoir, support and assistance to U.S. Naval Base Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, recruit TDY investigators) the National Joint Terrorism Task Force, overseeing JTTFs, and start up of Fly Teams. There were conversations or a paper he recalls, containing recommendations for appropriate interviewing techniques to maximize interrogation effectiveness. He thinks [redacted] did that. To Be Determined	[redacted] said he that the Federal Bureau of Investigation was aware of the two differing philosophies of interviewing and that the Federal Bureau of Investigation was trying to work with the military to bring them around to the methods that we felt were more productive. But the issue was, who is in charge? The Federal Bureau of Investigation's role down there was to be part of the team and try to influence things in a very professional manner. He said he was involved in writing the proposal for and recruiting a gs-15 to supervise the operation, [redacted] to try to promote the interests of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and making the military aware of who we are what are our assets and capabilities.
