She did not participate in any interrogations, but she was brought to Camp Delta to observed interviews, [redacted] does not recall who conducted those interviews and that her visit there was for a short duration; it was for her benefit to get the feel of what was going on. [redacted] said that she did not receive any special training for her U.S. Naval Base Guantanamo Bay, Cuba tour, but she was only there for approximately 2 weeks to fill in for another IRS person whom went on vacation.
