Weekly Electronic Media Report

**Purpose:** Provide information and counts with regard to electronic media searches, detentions, and seizures for the week of 4/29/09 to 5/5/09.

**Executive Summary:**

- Electronic media searches, detentions, and seizures continue to comprise an extremely small percentage of secondary examinations.
- So far in FY2009, 696 laptop searches have been performed.
- For the week of 4/29/09 to 5/5/09, 17 laptops searches were performed, one was detained, and none were seized.
- The lone electronic media seizure occurred on 5/1/09 when CBP Officers at the (b)(2); (b)(7)(E) (b)(2); (b)(7)(E) seized cell phones containing suspected child pornographic images. (b)(2); (b)(7)(E) responded and interviewed the subject. Due to question over the actual ownership of the device, the subject was released. Two cell phones were seized and turned over to (b)(2); (b)(7)(E) for further investigation.
