About 1430, 15 Jan 05, this office was notified by Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC), 1-185 Armor (AR), Convoy Support Center (CSC) Scania, IRAQ, of a shooting of Iraqi nationals by an American convoy.

Investigation established probable cause to believe the family was fired upon by a civilian contractor providing convoy security for the U.S. military convoy, operated by the U.S. Army Garrison, An-Numaniyah, Iraq, when the vehicle they were traveling in approached the convoy and failed to yield to multiple warnings from the lead convoy vehicle. As a result, the lead vehicle fired a five round burst of 7.62mm ammunition from an AK47 rifle, into the vehicle injuring

Further investigation revealed one of the rounds fired by the civilian contractor providing convoy security ricocheted, striking Mr. HAMZA, a bystander in the area. Mr. HAMZA subsequently died while being transported to a nearby medical facility.

Investigation established the incident was a justified response, which was within the established Rules of Engagement (ROE), therefore no crimes were committed.




