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INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

"This is an Operation Iraqi Freedom investigation 2004-2006."

This investigation was initiated upon notification by Staff Judge Advocate (OSJA), Task Force Freedom (TFF), Forward Operating Base (FOB) Courage, Mosul, Iraq, that a soldier was involved in a traffic accident which caused the death of a six month old Iraqi child.

Investigation established probable cause to believe committed the offenses of negligent homicide and reckless endangerment when throve vehicle recklessly, crossing the center line of the road on a curve. Experience vehicle subsequently struck the vehicle carrying Miss MEERO head on, resulting in Miss MEERO's death and the injuries to



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
