On 21 Apr 05, All Affairs Battalion, Parwan Provincial Reconstruction Team, Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan, APO AE 09354 (BAF), notified this office Mr. RAHMAN, was struck by the mirror of a HUMVEE, driven by 164th MP CO, Ft. Richardson, AK 99505, (deployed in support

of TF-Guardian, BAF). Mr. RAHMAN was transported to the General Army Hospital, Bagram Air Field, where he subsequently died of his injuries.

Investigation failed to establish probable cause to believe committed the offense of Negligent Homicide as initially alleged.

Further Investigation revealed was traveling at a low rate of speed, following units Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), and was driving in a safe manner appropriate for the area was traveling in when Mr. RAHMAN, without warning, turned sharply into the path of the vehicle applied brakes and turned the vehicle sharply to the left to avoid hitting Mr. RAHMAN. The right mirror of the vehicle struck Mr. RAHMAN causing the injuries, which subsequently lead to his death. The Military Police Traffic Investigator's Report listed rate of speed to be 17.32 miles per hour.




