

(b)(6) Yes, the locals call it (b)(1) The one by (b)(1)  
the road by camp (b)(1)

LT: If we got a map here do you think you show us.....

(b)(6) yes

LT: We are going to the map. What direction was traveling on the road that he is pointing out to us? OK the answer to that question was the he was driving toward (b)(1) (North to South). OK, the next questions are going to be on the military vehicles that you saw. OK...first question is what kind of vehicles were they?

(b)(6) Hummer, two

LT: So you saw two HMMWVs. OK, what color?

(b)(6) It was kind of dark but it was a kind of tan (which sounded like he said "tint") color.

LT: Tint? Oh, a tan color. A tan colored HMMWV. OK we will stop.....OK one more question, what time was this the exact time.

(b)(6) The exact time to be honest with you was five five five....

LT: OK, so five-fifty five in the evening...

(b)(6) Yes, it was at the break fasting time and he was taking his wife to break fast together since he had spent eighteen days here (at work) and that was his first vacation day...(not clear for about 6 seconds)

LT: Next question with the vehicles, how many did you see?

(b)(6) Two HMMWVs

LT: Just two?

(b)(6) yes

LT: Where there any big trucks with the HMMWVs?

(b)(6) Only two HMMWVs

LT: Any forklift, or barriers....?

(b)(6) No, and they went and entered (b)(1) and I saw them with my eyes.

LT: Where there any Iraqi ING soldiers or anything with them?

(b)(6) No, there was only me and them on the streets and the shop owners. There was no police, no ING.

LT: So, do you know the difference between an American HMMWV..you know what a HMMWV looks like?

(b)(6) I am three years ING....

LT: I understand, it is for clarification. Next question, did you see any vehicle markings any orange panels.....?

(b)(6) At that time, I was not thinking of vehicle markings, but I saw in the first vehicle, the vehicle that shot my wife, there was two cones..the orange traffic things...

LT: Cones....

(b)(6) There were two orange cones. After he shot the round he came by my vehicle he was pointing his big light on me so it kind of blinded me and I couldn't see except the orange stuff because it was shiny.

LT: The orange cones, where they on the front of the vehicle or the back?

(b)(6) On the back.

LT: Was this an orange cone or was it the bright orange strip of cloth that we have on the back of our vehicles was it a cone or a strip?

(b)(6) Cones, cones they were cones.

LT: You did not see a strip of cloth? See we have VS-17 panels it is a bright strip of cloth ...do you know what they are?

(b)(6) yes...

LT: and you did not see them?

(b)(6) No, my BC has it and I know it I can recognize it. I am the front gate guard and I see lots of HMMWVs going in and out. With the big flashlight I could not see like their uniforms.

LT: Next question, could you identify the type of uniform the soldiers were wearing if you could see the gunner?

(b)(6) He was in the turret and he put the light and it was not easy to concentrate on these things with my wife....

LT: At this time I am showing him Duck's and Ace's but apparently he was blinded and could not make out the difference. Final question with the uniforms, one last time, anything that sticks out in your mind...?

(b)(6) My wife was screaming and the Hammers with the light in my face I could recognize the cones and then they entered into (b)(1) Like I waited for them to pass for like 50 meters to start to evacuate my wife to the hospital to start to drive the vehicle to the hospital. There was no U-turn on the road we both were taking so I had to drive behind them afterwards and so then I saw that they went to (b)(1) then I made the turn to the hospital.

LT: So you are saying that you physically saw the convoy enter (b)(1) ?

(b)(6) Because I could not have a U-turn to go to the hospital so I had to drive behind them so I drove to with them all the way up then they made the Turn into (b)(1) and I U-turned it back to the hospital.

LT: So, and this happened almost immediately after the shooting at 17:55 in the evening, about that time you are saying that they went into (b)(1) ?

(b)(6) Yes, and they didn't even stop to see what was going on.

LT: Next question, right before the shot rang out what was the disposition of the vehicle... where you in the center of the road....?

(b)(6) You know the road he is talking about is a three lane road, one lane was busy with people parking at the restaurant eating food at the restaurant and he was like the second lane by the first vehicles parking. There were two more lanes they were like three or four other vehicles to be traffic. He was in the middle lane.

LT: When-did you pull away from the restaurant and start driving?

(b)(6) I took the same lane I was in because it was already empty, and he was planning to take the next road after the restaurant which would lead him directly to his family house, there was no reason for me to pull away from the restaurant I took the same lane planning to go but...

LT: When you started driving, and you noticed the vehicles behind you did you any lasers, hear any sirens, did you hear any loud speakers?

(b)(6) The round, the first thing was the round then there was the light and with the light there was the horn.

LT: OK, so your saying that when you were driving there was no warning or anything, no lasers no sirens?

(b)(6) No, but after the round there was the light and the horn.

LT: So did the vehicles, did the HMMWVs did they just suddenly appear...just show up and then the shot was fired? Is that what happened?

(b)(6) Yes....

(b)(6) OK, could repeat the question because I think I got it wrong.

LT: OK, the question was did the HMMWVs give any advance warning that they were there?

(b)(6) There was no one in the street or road at that time and I was checking that was nobody till I moved then I heard the shot.

LT: Can you describe to me the disposition of the vehicle when the bullet impacted? Where was the HMMWVs where was your car on the road?

(b)(6) I was like parked.....(the Arabic is louder than the translation here unfortunately) distance between my car and their vehicle was like the distance between here and the other wall.

LT: So about 50 meters behind you?

(b)(6) closer than that

LT: 20 meters? You are saying 20 meters....

(b)(6) yes

LT: Could you briefly describe what happened when the bullet went through?

(b)(6) There was kind of like a smoke and the stuffing inside the seat were all over the vehicle. While I stopped and looked I didn't think that they shot...I thought there was something wrong with the vehicle. I hear the shot then I heard my wife screaming. I know

what the rules of an engagement and I know how to act when I am downtown-not to look hostile to the patrol is is not like I would just drive by them not noticing that they are around or being behind me.

LT: Alright , next question, I know this might be a little bit painful but once your wife was hit, what did you do and tell me what the convoy did?

(b)(6) She was screaming...I was surprised....like hey what's up? I saw her (b)(6) (b)(6) (unable to hear the English for about 3 seconds) so I pulled her to my chest and I was like putting my hand on the wound. She was calling my name and asking me to help me like I am going to die I am going to die. So I told her, OK let us wait until they pass, so I started driving and when I waited for them to move another hundred meters and then I started driving.

LT: OK, so how far did drive down the road before you saw them turn?

(b)(6) I didn't drive I was stopping and looking at them moving until they went to (b)(1) then I started driving again.

LT: OK, so when you said they went into (b)(1) was this the main gate of (b)(1) ?

(b)(6) The gate by the bridge, the first gate of (b)(1) he does not know if it is the maingate or not. It is the one before the bridge.

LT: Could you describe the gate one more time?

(b)(6) Black, slide, big gate. The gate guard of (b)(1) the ING they were worried about me because I was driving kind of crazy, so fast so I could get her to the hospital as soon as possible. And they were like wait..then I made the turn and said I need to go the hospital and they said OK.

LT: How far away were you from the gate?

(b)(6) It is like the distance between here and the front gate (the room we were in and the Main gate of (b)(1)

LT: So probably like three or four hundred meters up the road.....?

(b)(6) No, like one hundred one fifty

LT: So, 150 to 200 meters away. Alright, the convoy, once they fired did they stop or anything like that?

(b)(6) They were driving-they did not even hit the brakes.

LT: What was the time that the convoy entered (b)(1) ?

(b)(6) Just like I told you, 1755 hrs and 1800 that was the whole thing. We were doing the break fast thing and that is when the time happened.

LT: Final question was, what hospital did you go to?

(b)(6) (b)(1) Hospital

(b)(6) (b)(1)

(b)(6) The police officer at the hospital ws trying to talk to me...usually there is usually police patrol inside hospital to see if people who have gotten shot were involved in bad stuff...and I didn't like answer him respectfully because I was kind of going crazy.

LT: First confirmation question: Can you tell what kind of uniform the soldiers were wearing?

(b)(6) No...

LT: No, you can not

(b)(6) He can not confirm it.

LT: Can you confirm that you saw the trucks entering (b)(1)

(b)(6) yes.

LT: Are there any distinct markings, or something that stands out in your mind about the vehicles.

(b)(6) Only the two orange cones.

LT: Are there any ING?

(b)(6) No, nothing, no IPs nothing

LT: There were no big army trucks....?

(b)(6) Only two HMMWVs

LT: When your vehicle was shot, you were traveling down the road towards (b)(1)  
(b)(1) is that correct? (from North to South)

(b)(6) Yes...

LT: and the name of this road is....

(b)(6) (b)(1)

LT: Uh... did the HMMWVs before the shot was fired was there any warning shots, lasers, or sirens?

(b)(6) No... only one shot and then after the shot was light

LT: Final question, the time. Tell me the time.

(b)(6) 17:55 hrs.

LT: And the convoy entered (b)(1) he saw them go in

(b)(6) yes....

LT: Alright, (b)(6) again we are just trying to see that justice is served on this. The United States Army, when mistakes are made, we take it very seriously and we want to do the right thing. I know this was painful and hard but we can't fix this or try help things without your help.

(b)(6) That something required by God.

LT: This was very unfortunate... alright now we are going to go out and take more pictures of your vehicle. Ok, so we are wrapping it up right now. The questions were asked by LT (b)(6) FSO B-TRP 1-71 CAV. This recording took place on (b)(1) on this the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 2005. The interpreters (b)(6) and (b)(6) were present and assisted in translating Mr. (b)(6) words. The session was recorded on paper by PV2 (b)(6) of 1<sup>st</sup> Platoon. Before we tape-recorded the session, permission was asked for and granted by CPL (b)(6) of 2<sup>nd</sup> PLT HHC 1-1 IA to record the conversation.

9. (b)(6) , WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

My involvement with the shooting incident outside of (b)(1) began at approximately 2330 hours on 16 October, 2005. The incident occurred several hours earlier, and I was summoned to go out and take pictures of a vehicle. As I proceeded out to the Iraqi part of (b)(1) I saw a white Toyota parked outside of the S-3 building and was briefed on what happened by (b)(6) one of evening interpreters, as I set up my camera. I began to photograph the vehicle as I listened to (b)(6) sequence of the evening's events. At this time, I began to mentally compare his account with the evidence on the car. For this first sequence of photographs, I concentrated from the rear of the vehicle to the front of the vehicle, essentially tracking the path of the bullet from its initial entry at the trunk door all the through to the front window. I saw what appeared to be one .50 caliber entry hole in the trunk, another hole underneath the trunk door, a hole through the back seat, evidence of fragmentation as the bullet passed through the passenger seat, a partial hole in the front window, and blood from the unfortunate woman located in pools in the front seat and also on the floor of the vehicle. I offered my condolences to Mr. (b)(6) and left. I showed the photographs to CPT (b)(6) and later sent them on to CPT (b)(6). The reason why (b)(6) came to (b)(1) was because he is in HHC 1st BN 1st BDE IA.

CPT (b)(6) instructed me to gather as much information as possible about the incident and present all of my findings to CPT (b)(6) the investigating officer, as soon as possible on the morning of the 17th of October. I wanted to formally interview (b)(6) immediately, but the mourning period, understandably, interfered with this and so I had to wait three more days before this could be arranged. I also was instructed to take more detailed photographs of the vehicle as well. Both the soldier and the vehicle eluded me throughout the 17th of October. Until that time, I extracted as much information about the incident as I could from (b)(6) who was the interpreter on duty during the night of the shooting. This information was passed up to CPT (b)(6) at (b)(1). I did not see the car or the soldier the next day either, but the car, which is owned by another soldier (b)(6) made an appearance at the FOB on 18 October. A bullet was discovered by an (b)(1) IA soldier SPC (b)(6) and recovered by SGT (b)(6) of 2nd PLT while he was on guard at the front gate of (b)(1) around 1100 hrs on the morning of the 18th. The bullet was identified as a .50 caliber and when I arrived at the gate with the CPT (b)(6) had already left. When I photographed the car again, (b)(6) showed me that he recovered the bullet from the passenger seat cushion.

Finally, on 20 October, I sat down and formally interviewed (b)(6) about the events which occurred on the night of 16 October 2005. Before the interview, I spoke with CPTs (b)(6) and 1SG (b)(6) in order to make sure that my interview would have the desired effect. For the interview I secured a tape recorder, had two interpreters on hand, and had a soldier to serve as a scribe. When I saw (b)(6) again, I offered my sympathy but urged him to help us out with accurate facts so that we can ensure that justice would be done and then interviewed him for about 45 minutes. I then typed up a transcript of the tape, and gathered up (b)(6) sworn statement as well as the other papers he had provided me into a file. Later that day, the car arrived, and though the hole in the trunk was patched, the other hole underneath the trunk was not and using a ruler and an antenna I took several more detailed pictures so that they could be of use to CPT (b)(6) in his report. I then took these pictures and built a PowerPoint presentation which, along with the transcript was emailed to CPT (b)(6). I then printed out hard copies of both these documents and added them to my file. CPT (b)(6) who could not make it to (b)(1) to pick up the file, instructed me to hand carry it to Major (b)(6) and so I rode along with CPT (b)(6) to the 1-71 command and staff meeting which occurred on the night of the 21 October. In this file I had, the original interview tape, a copy of (b)(6) (the woman's name) death certificate and ID card, a typed transcript of the taped interview, a print out of the picture PowerPoint show, my scribe's notes, some of my handwritten notes, and a small picture of (b)(6). Since I turned in the file yesterday night, I have been standing by to answer any further questions on this matter or coordinate any future events as a result of this most unfortunate incident.

THE LEAD VEHICLE IN MY CONVOY WAS HQ-58 WITH A M240B AS THE MOUNTED WEAPON SYSTEM, SPC (b)(6) WAS THE GUNNER ON THAT VEHICLE AND SGT (b)(6) WAS THE TC. THE NEXT VEHICLE WAS HQ-55 WITH AN M240B AS THE MOUNTED WEAPON SYSTEM WITH PFC (b)(6) AS THE GUNNER AND MYSELF SFC (b)(6) AS THE TC. THE THIRD VEHICLE WAS AN UP-ARMORER TOYOTA LAND CRUISER CARRYING GEN (b)(6) 1/1 IA BDE CDR, CSM (b)(6) 1/1 IA BDE CSM, MAJ (b)(6) TF (b)(2) LOW MITT CHIEF, AN IA CAPTAIN AS THE DRIVER AND A (b)(6) INTERPRETER. THE VEHICLE DOES NOT HAVE ANY MOUNTED WEAPON SYSTEMS. THE FOURTH VEHICLE WAS HQ-57 WITH A M2 AS THE MOUNTED WEAPON SYSTEM, WITH SGT (b)(6) AS THE GUNNER AND SSG (b)(6) AS THE TC.

THE CONVOY LEFT (b)(1) AT APPROXIMATELY 1731 FROM (b)(1) TRAVELLING EAST ON RT (b)(1) TO CP (b)(1) THEN NORTH ON RT (b)(1) THEN SOUTH EAST ON RT (b)(1) TO GRID (b)(1) THEN EAST ON RT (b)(1) TO GATE 2 AT (b)(1) ARRIVING AT APPROXIMATELY 17:52.

TO MY KNOWLEDGE, DURING THE CONVOY, NO WARNING SHOTS WERE FIRED, THERE WERE NO NEGLIGENT DISCHARGES, NO ESCALATION OF FORCE SITUATIONS AND THERE WERE NO SIGACTS.
