FACTS AND FINDINGS OF INVESTIGATION:

FACTS: A SECURITY ELEMENT WAS ESCORTING A FSC/3-187 COMBAT LOGISTICS PATROL (CLP) █████ OF PATROL BASE (PB) RAZOR AND █████ OF PB OLSON ALONG THE █████ █████ AS THE ELEMENT APPROACHED THE BRIDGE, IT WAS SENT TO SECURE THE EASBOUND ROUTE ACROSS THE BRIDGE. UPON COMING TO A SEVERE LEFT TURN IN THE ROAD, THE LEAD SECURITY VEHICLE'S TC MADE THE DECISION TO HALT ALL WESTBOUND TRAFFIC TO ALLOW THE CLP TO PASS SAFELY. USING VERBAL COMMANDS AND HAND AND ARM SIGNALS, THE LEAD VEHICLE'S GUNNER SUCCESSFULLY HALTED 3XLN VEHICLES APPX. 100M TO IT'S FRONT. SHORTLY AFTERWARD, THE GUNNER IDENTIFIED A BLUE CHEVY TRUCK TRAVELING WESTBOUND AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED. THE BLUE TRUCK PROCEEDED TO SWERVE INTO THE EASTBOUND LANE, HEADING WEST, AROUND THE THREE STOPPED LN VEHICLES. THE GUNNER BEGAN TO YELL AND DISPLAY HAND AND ARM SIGNALS, ATTEMPTING TO STOP THE BLUE TRUCK. THE VEHICLE DID NOT WAIVER IN SPEED OR DIRECTION. AS THE VEHICLE CONTINUED DIRECTLY TOWARDS THE CLP, THE GUNNER WAS FORCED TO ENGAGE THE VEHICLE WITH APPX. A 3XRN BURST OF AIMED DISABLING FIRE TO THE FRONT OF THE TRUCK. THE TRUCK CONTINUED FORWARD AND INCREASED ITS SPEED. AT THIS TIME, THE GUNNER WAS FORCED TO ENGAGE THE TRUCK A SECOND TIME WITH 10X 7.62MM DISABLING ROUNDS; THE ROUNDS FIRST IMPACTED THE GRILL OF THE TRUCK; THEN IMPACTED THE ENGINE COMPARTMENT AND CAB. THE TRUCK PASSED THE LEAD VEHICLE AND STOPPED APPX. 75M TO THE REAR OF THE LEAD VEHICLE. BDA: DAMAGED ENGINE BLOCK AND 3X LN WIA. 2XWIA LN'S WERE MEDEVAC'D AND 1XLN WIA WAS TREATED AND RELEASED TO IP. SSE OF THE VEHICLE RESULTED IN NEGATIVE FINDINGS AND NO MECHANICAL PROBLEMS WERE FOUND TO THE LN TRUCK THAT WOULD HAVE CAUSED IT TO BE UNABLE TO STOP. Ex 2

FINDINGS:

- 1) THAT ALL TROOPERS INVOLVED IN THE INCIDENT WERE PROPERLY BRIEFED AND REHEARSED ON TF BoB ROE AND EOF PROCEDURES BY THE CONVOY CDR PRIOR TO THE MISSION.
- 2) THAT THE THREAT FROM VBIEDS WITHIN SAMARRA WAS SIGNIFICANT, WITH THE MOST RECENT VBIED ATK OCCURRING ON 10 MAR 06. IT WAS REASONABLE FOR ALL SOLDIERS AND CF THAT ENTER SAMARRA TO BE PREPARED FOR A VBIED ATK. ADDITIONALLY, THE CONVOY CDR HAD BRIEFED THAT THERE HAD BEEN INCREASED AIF ACTIVITY PRIOR TO THE PATROL

3) THAT PROPER EOF PROCEDURES WERE USED BY THE LEAD VEHICLE GUNNER AND THAT THE ENGAGEMENT WAS IAW TF BOB ROE. THE GUNNER WAS GIVEN THE ORDER TO STOP ALL WESTBOUND TRAFFIC ON THE [REDACTED] AND USING EOF PROCEDURES SUCCESSFULLY STOPPED 3xLN VEHICLES. THIS PROVES THAT THE LEAD GUN-TRUCK WAS IN PLAIN SIGHT OF ON-COMING TRAFFIC AND THAT THE GUNNER'S SIGNALS WERE BEING UNDERSTOOD AND COMPLIED WITH. AS THE BLUE TRUCK BEGAN TO BYPASS STOPPED TRAFFIC, THE GUNNER CONTINUED HIS EOF PROCEDURES. IGNORING HIS CLEAR SIGNALS, THE TRUCK WAS PERCEIVED THREAT TO THE CLP. THE GUNNER'S ONLY OPTION TO MAINTAIN THE SAFETY AND SECURITY OF THE CLP WAS TO ENGAGE THE VEHICLE WITH HIS WPN. THE BLUE TRUCK FAILED TO RESPOND TO THE FIRST DISABLING SHOTS AND INCREASED ITS SPEED TOWARD THE LEAD VEHICLE, CAUSING THE GUNNER TO ENGAGE IT A SECOND TIME. THE BLUE TRUCK REASONABLY SHOWED HOSTILE INTENT BY DISREGARDING OTHER LN VEHICLE'S ACTIONS, ALL CF VERBALLY COMMANDS, GESTURES AND DISABLING SHOTS, THUS MAKING IT AN IMMINENT THREAT TO THE CONVOY. THE SPEED OF THE LN TRUCK WAS EVIDENT IN THAT IT STOPPED APPX. 75M BEHIND THE LEAD GUN-TRUCK, ENTERING THE CONVOY. BASED UPON ALL THE FACTS, THE LEAD VEHICLE'S GUNNER USED PROPORTIONAL FORCE IN ENGAGING THE LN TRUCK.

RECOMMENDATION(S) OF INVESTIGATION: BASED UPON THE FINDINGS THAT PROPER EOF WAS USED WITHIN THE TF BoB ROE, NO FURTHER ADMINISTRATIVE OR UCMJ ACTION RECOMMENDED. THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER ALSO RECOMMENDED THAT THE SECURITY ELEMENT AND ALL TF IRON UNITS CONTINUE TO REVIEW AND ENFORCE EOF PROCEDURES PRIOR TO AND DURING EVERY OPERATION. FINALLY, THE INVESTIGATING OFFICER RECOMMENDED THAT ALL TF IRON UNITS APPLY THIS INCIDENT AS A ROE VIGNETTE FOR LESSONS LEARNED TO BE INCORPORATED IN EVERYDAY OPERATIONS.

SUBJECT: 15-6 Investigation Facts, Findings and Recommendations to FSC/3-187IN Escalation of Force 23 March 2006

1. The following are the facts of the FSC/ 3-187IN Escalation of Force on 23 March 2006:
On 23 March 2006, elements of FSC/ 3-187IN and HQ/C/3-187IN conducted a combat logistical patrol (CLP) consisting of four vehicles and 22 personnel in the Salah Ad Din province of Iraq. The purpose of this CLP was to supply elements of Task Force Iron at Patrol Bases Razor and Olson, located in Samarra, Iraq. The elements of HQ/C/3-187IN were attached to FSC/3-187IN and tasked to provide security and route clearance for the CLP. The CLP was moving from FOB Brassfield-Mora [REDACTED] to planned logistical drops at Patrol Base Razor [REDACTED] then Patrol Base Olson [REDACTED] using [REDACTED] proper to Patrol Base Razor then moving across the [REDACTED] to Patrol Base Olson. Upon completion of the logistical drop at Patrol Base Razor the CLP proceeded eastbound to Patrol Base Olson via the [REDACTED]. Elements of HQ/C/3-187IN pushed in front the CLP to clear and secure the eastbound route across the [REDACTED]. Upon coming to a severe left turn in the road the lead security vehicle's truck commander [REDACTED] (HQ/C/3-187IN), made the decision to halt all westbound traffic coming toward the CLP in order to allow the CLP to safely pass. [REDACTED] (HQ/C/3-187IN), gunner for the lead security gun-truck, received the command to halt all westbound traffic proceeding in the direction of the CLP from [REDACTED]. Using verbal commands and hand and arm signals, [REDACTED] successfully halted three local national vehicles heading westbound across the [REDACTED] approximately 100 meters to the east of the lead vehicle. Upon these three vehicles halting, a fourth local national vehicle, a blue Chevrolet pickup truck, proceeded to swerve into the eastbound lane, heading westbound, around the three halted local national vehicles. At this time, [REDACTED] continued to yell and display hand and arm signals attempting to stop the oncoming vehicle. The blue Chevrolet pickup truck continued westbound toward the lead gun-truck of the CLP, ignoring [REDACTED] measures to stop the vehicle. The blue Chevrolet pickup truck moved toward the lead gun-truck of the CLP causing [REDACTED] to engage the vehicle with a disabling, three round burst, from his M240B, into the grill of the pickup truck. The blue pickup truck continued westbound toward the lead gun-truck in the CLP, increasing its speed. [REDACTED] then engaged the vehicle a second time with his M240B, disabling the driver and the vehicle. The blue Chevrolet pickup truck then came to a halt approximately 75 meters to the rear of the lead gun-truck. At this point [REDACTED] ordered [REDACTED] to maintain security to the east, also [REDACTED] reported to the Convoy Commander [REDACTED] (FSC/3-187), of the situation and advised that medics be sent to the location of the blue Chevrolet

pickup truck. After establishing security, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (HQ/C/3-187IN) then moved from their gun-truck to the blue Chevrolet pickup truck that had been engaged. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] searched the vehicle for any weapons or explosives and began treating the wounded local nationals. The engagement resulted in three local national casualties consisting of: one litter priority/urgent, one ambulatory and one with superficial wounds. The casualties were immediately given medical aid and evacuated to Patrol Base Razor for advanced medical treatment. Following the evacuation of the three local nationals, the Convoy Commander [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] conducted a Sensitive Site Exploitation (SSE) on the vehicle. No weapons, explosive residue, or intelligence was found on the site or the local nationals. The vehicle was inspected for mechanical failures in which none could be found and then moved to Patrol Base Razor. After the vehicle was secured, the CLP continued mission to Patrol Base Olson.

2. The following are the findings of the FSC/3-187IN Escalation of Force on 23 March 2006: All the Soldiers involved in the Escalation of Force 23 March 2006 were properly briefed and rehearsed on Task Force Band of Brothers Rules of Engagement and Escalation of Force procedures by the convoy commander [REDACTED] and their truck commanders (Exhibit 10 & 13).

The history of VBIEDs and attacks against Coalition Forces pose a threat to all coalition forces that enter Task Force Iron area of operations, to include the city of Samarra, Iraq. Historical story boards of previous VBIEDs, most recently against a Samarra Iraqi Police combat patrol 10 March 2006, would indicate that the possibility of an VBIED attack is high (Exhibit 4). The reasonable conclusion would be for all soldiers and coalition forces that enter the city of Samarra, Iraq to be prepared for a VBIED attack or an attack on coalition forces. Also, an increase of AIF activity in Samarra was briefed during the convoy commander's brief (Exhibit 10).

Proper escalation of force was conducted by [REDACTED]. He was given the order to stop all westbound traffic on the [REDACTED] and successfully halted three local national vehicles 100 meters in front of the convoy through verbal commands and hand and arm signals (Exhibit 7, 10 & 12). This proves that the lead gun-truck was in plain sight of oncoming traffic and that [REDACTED] was properly gesturing to stop oncoming traffic. At the time the blue Chevrolet pickup truck swerved toward the lead vehicle in the CLP, becoming a direct threat to the lead vehicle. [REDACTED] was in the process of gesturing all oncoming traffic to stop (Exhibit 7). The blue Chevrolet pickup truck driven by local nationals ignored [REDACTED] hand gestures, thus becoming a perceived threat to the CLP. His only option, to maintain the security and safety of the CLP, was to engage the vehicle with his weapon (Exhibit 7). The blue Chevrolet pickup truck failed to respond to the first disabling shots and increased its speed toward the lead gun-truck, causing [REDACTED] to engage the vehicle a second time (Exhibit 5, 7 & 9). The blue Chevrolet pickup truck reasonably showed hostile intent by disregarding other local national vehicles' actions, all coalition verbal commands, gestures, and disabling shots, thus making it an imminent threat to the convoy (Exhibit 3). Also, the vehicle was being driven at a high rate of speed. Once disabled, the vehicle proceeded west past the lead security vehicle and halted approximately 75 meters behind the lead gun-truck, entering the convoy (Exhibit 10). The actions of the blue Chevrolet pickup truck in correlation with the briefed increased enemy activity in the Samarra area (Exhibit 10) caused [REDACTED] to use proportional force and engage the vehicle. No mechanical problems were found on the blue Chevrolet pickup truck leaving no room for mechanical error (Exhibit 10).

3. Recommendations by the Investigating Officer (IO) in reference to the findings of the FSC/3-187IN Escalation of Force on 23 March 2006:

Based on my findings the proper Escalation of Force was used within the Rules of Engagement for Task Force Band of Brothers (Exhibit 3). I recommend no further administrative or UCMJ action against [REDACTED] or any other Soldier. Also, I recommend that FSC/3-187IN and all

units within Task Force Iron continue to review and enforce Escalation of Force procedures prior to and during every operation. Finally, I recommend that all units within Task Force Iron apply this Escalation of Force incident to everyday operations and situations IAW Rakkasan ROE.

SUBJECT: COMMANDER'S INQUIRY: Escalation of Force on 23 March, 2006

1. While on a Combat Logistic Patrol (CLP), the security element [REDACTED] C. CO/3-187IN) attached to FSC, 3-187IN conducted an escalation of force ~~incident~~ at the Samarra Bridge, approximately [REDACTED] of Patrol Base RAZOR. The CLP was traveling east on [REDACTED] when it encountered a blue pickup truck with 3 LNs driving at a high rate of speed west towards the CLP. The pickup truck passed three stopped LN vehicles and continued toward the CLP. The security element initiated escalation of force procedures. The gunner used verbal commands and hand and arm signals to alert the driver of the vehicle to pull to the side of the road, and let the CLP pass. After both verbal and visual cues were ignored, a total of 18 disabling shots were fired into the vehicle. The shots penetrated the vehicle hood and driver's side windshield, wounding the three military aged male occupants. The vehicle swerved to the westbound shoulder of the road and stopped. Security elements immediately rendered first aide, and conducted SSE of the site with negative results. The LNs were transported via FLA to PB RAZOR, where there were tested for Exspray and received further medical treatment; the LNs tested negative with Exspray. One LN was immediate priority, while the other two were ambulatory. The vehicle was brought to RAZOR Circle and searched with NSTR. Ex 2
2. A detailed interview has been conducted with those personnel who witnessed the EOF. Additionally, negative Exspray swipe pads were reviewed, as well as photographs of the scene, the LNs, and the vehicle. Ex 2
3. My recommendation is no action be taken, as the proper escalation of force measures were taken to ensure the safety of everyone in the CLP. Ex 2

At 231201M MAR2006, an Escalation of Force (EOF) was initiated by a C/3-187 Gun Truck escorting a f-SCC-187 Combat Logistics Patrol (CLP) in the Sallah Ad Din province of Iraq. Of Patrol Base (PB) RAZOR and [REDACTED] OLSON along the Samarra Dam Bridge vicinity [REDACTED] The C/3-187 escort element had increased their interval from the CLP (traveling eastbound enroute to the PBs) inside Samarra in order to conduct a resupply and subsequently instructed 3x Local National (LN) westbound vehicles to pull off to the shoulder of the road so that they would not endanger the CLP. The C/3-187 escort identified a blue Chevy truck travelling westbound at a high rate of speed. When the truck approached the three vehicles that were pulled over for safety, the truck intentionally veered left and began to pass the vehicles making its way towards the C/3-187 escort and CLP. The gunner graduated his responses to this emerging threat by issuing hand and arm signals to the threat vehicle in an effort to alert all involved. The vehicle did not waiver in speed or direction. As the vehicle continued to push rapidly towards the CLP, the gunner was forced to engage the vehicle with approximately 10x 7.62mm disabling rounds; the rounds first impacted the grill of the truck, then impacted the engine compartment and cab resulting in a damaged engine block and 3x Local Nationals (LN)s WIA. This EOF brought the vehicle to stop. UPDATE: The CLP secured the site; approached the vehicle, cleared the vehicle, and provided immediate first aid to the LN's. The CLP ground evacuated the LN's to PB RAZOR's Level II Medical Treatment facility where 1x WIA was released after lacerations were cleaned and bandaged. 2x LN's were categorized as priority patients and were further ground evacuated to FOB BRASSIFETT-D-MORA for an Aero-MEDDEVAC in FOB SPECIFICER. A Commander's Inquiry has been completed. CLOSED 231701M MAR2006

AT 021535DEC05 ELEMENTS OF B/3-69 AR A* PB UVANNI VICTORY AND C/1-33 CAV AT PB OLSON [REDACTED] REPORTED HEARING A LARGE EXPLOSION SOMEWHERE SOUTHWEST OF THE GOLDEN MOSQUE IN [REDACTED] BOTH UNIT OBSERVED SMOKE FROM THE ORIGIN OF THE EXPLOSION AND HEARD FOLLOW-ON SAF. THERE WERE NO REPORTS OF FRIENDLY UNITS IN CONTACT. AT 1542 HOURS, JCC REPORTED IP ARRIVED AT THE LOCATION OF THE EXPLOSION AND CLAIMED A VBIED PARKED WEST, ACROSS THE STREET, OF THE UMM AYMAN PRIMARY SCHOOL AND GAZAN HIGH SCHOOL FOR GIRLS, LOCATED [REDACTED] DETONATED. THE VEHICLE HAD BEEN PARKED AT THE LOCATION SINCE YESTERDAY. IP REPORTED 2X LN MALES AND 1X LN CHILD WERE LIGHTLY INJURED AS A RESULT OF THE ATTACK. As we continued, the road took a sever left turn so I had my gunner, [REDACTED] come up in the turret to wave oncoming traffic to the side of the road so we could complete our mission. [REDACTED] flagged down three vehicles which pulled to the side of the road. As the third civilian vehicle came to a stop, a fourth blue pick up truck swerved around the three stopped vehicles and was heading directly for my truck. At this point, [REDACTED] had already given a visual signal which led him to engage the truck with a three round burst to front of the vehicle with the M240B. The truck hit the gas and [REDACTED] engaged the vehicle with about 15 rounds from the M240B, wounding the three occupants. The vehicle rolled to a stop just behind my M1114. 
