Escalation of Force, 27 FEB 06

1. Purpose: To provide the facts, findings, and recommendations regarding a lethal escalation of force engagement on 27 0520 FEB 06. The incident involved a squad from A/2-506 IN that was on patrol in the 810 area of zone 25, vicinity ██████████ (Exhibit R). One local national was killed and his vehicle was destroyed as a result of this engagement. An informal investigation was conducted with the following results. SUC552(b)(1)
2. Summary of Incident:

At approximately 27 0520 FEB 06 a squad from A/2-506 IN was on patrol in zone 25 investigating a possible attack on a Mosque when it stopped vicinity ██████████ for a security halt. During the security halt, the squad noticed a vehicle moving south on a road just north of ██████████. The squad moved to investigate this vehicle for two reasons: it was during curfew hours when no civilian traffic was allowed access to these roads; and unit pattern analysis indicates that the most likely time for AIF IED implants occur in the morning between 04:30 – 06:30, this patrol was operating in the morning window (Exhibit Q). SUC552(b)(1)

When the squad arrived at the scene they witnessed the occupants of the suspect vehicle moving pieces of a make shift road block established to deny southbound traffic unrestricted access to ██████████. In a few, short minutes this incident escalated from a hasty TCP/search to a non-lethal engagement, and ultimately a lethal engagement. SUC552(b)(1)

The squad leader attempted to question the two suspects from the vehicle through use of his interpreter when one suspect fled the area; the other suspect got into the car and tried to flee the scene. The individual that fled on foot escaped down an alley. The suspect that got into the vehicle committed hostile acts toward the squad leader by attempting to run him and his interpreter over. This act led to an escalation of

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force by the squad using non-lethal and then lethal means that ultimately killed the suspect in the vehicle.

After lethal rounds were fired, the vehicle moved forward slowly, struck a wall, and burst into flames. During the fire, the squad heard multiple popping sounds similar to ammunition exploding and two distinct, larger explosions similar to that of a hand grenade. The Iraqi Police and fire department were called to the scene to help control the situation and extinguish the fire. The squad checked the vehicle but could not find any additional evidence of weapons due to damage caused by the fire. The squad distributed claim forms to local residents and left the Iraqi Police in charge of the scene.

3. Chronology of Events:

- a. The incident began when the squad stopped at a road junction on [REDACTED] vic [REDACTED] They stopped to conduct a security halt to gain more information about an attack on a Mosque in their AO (Exhibit A, D). SUSC552(L)(J)
- b. The lead vehicle in the squad noticed a vehicle moving south toward [REDACTED] on an unnamed road the squad went to investigate it (Exhibit A, B, D, E, F, J, K, M, N, O). SUSC552(L)(J)
- c. The squad stopped in front of the suspect vehicle and blocked the road to prevent forward progress (Exhibit A).
- d. One suspect flees the vehicle on foot and a soldier chases him until he enters a dark alley. This suspect escapes (Exhibit A, B, C, F, N).
- e. The suspect in the vehicle attempts to turn it around and drive off in the opposite direction (Exhibit A, B, C, E, F, H, I, N, P).
- f. The squad leader's gunner yelled and waved at the vehicle for the suspect to get out of the vehicle (Exhibit B, C).
- g. The squad leader and his interpreter exited their vehicle in order to talk with the two suspects and discuss their business on the road during curfew (Exhibit B, C, E, F, I, L, N, O).
- h. The squad leader's gunner fires a non-lethal round from his shotgun into the suspect vehicle's side to force the driver to stop and exit the vehicle (Exhibit B, C, E, F, N, O, P).
- i. The vehicle stops and the suspect driver removed his head cover and made what looked like a "Hail Mary" prayer type gesture. He continues to move backward toward the squad leader and interpreter to within 10 feet (Exhibit B, C, E, H, N, P).

- j. The suspect continues to try and turn his vehicle around by backing further around clockwise, threatening both the squad leader and interpreter (Exhibit B, C, D, E, F, I, N, P).
- k. The squad leader fires two lethal warning shots from his M4 toward an open field, away from the vehicle. The vehicle continues to move backward toward the squad leader and interpreter (Exhibit B, C, I, J, N, O, P).
- l. The squad leader fires another lethal two round warning shot from his M4. The vehicle continues to move back toward the squad leader (Exhibit B, C, F, G, J, L, M, N, O, P).
- m. The Squad leader and interpreter jump/dive out of the vehicles way to avoid being hit (Exhibit B, D).
- n. The squad leader's gunner fires his M240B MG at the suspect and another gunner fires an M2 .50 Cal MG into the vehicle (Exhibit A, B, C, E, F, G, H, I, J, L, M, N, O, P).
- o. The vehicle stops moving backward and starts to roll slowly forward, runs into a wall, and bursts into flames (Exhibit A, B, C, D, E, F, N, O).
- p. Squad members move toward the vehicle to inspect the damage and possibly extricate and treat the suspect until they hear popping sounds coming from the vehicle that sound like exploding small arms ammunition. They repositioned themselves about 100-150 meters away and soon heard two larger explosions similar to what a hand grenade would make (Exhibit B, C, D, E, H, L, N, O).
- q. The squad reports the incident to the unit, contacts the Iraqi Police and Fire Department (Exhibit A, C, D, E, H, I, M, N).
- r. Iraqi police and fire-fighters arrive and take control of the situation. The squad hands out claim forms to local residents and the suspect's family (Exhibit A, C, E, H, M, N, O).

4. Additional Facts:

- a. Pattern Analysis: Unit pattern analysis demonstrates that the time of this incident is within the most likely window for enemy forces to implant IEDs in the area of this incident. There were 15 IEDs found or detonated in this zone in January 2006 and 16 IEDs found or detonated in this zone in February 2006 with most likely times between 0430 – 0630 and 1800 – 1930 (Exhibit Q). These facts further justify the squad's effort to investigate the suspects in this incident.

b. Recent published guidance from MNC-I in Policy Letter #15 requires the following (Exhibit W):

- (1) Ensure that personnel are briefed on Escalation of Force procedures and Rules of Engagement prior to any mission.
- (2) Ensure all units are equipped with adequate supplies of visual and physical warning items.
- (3) Prior to conducting any operations outside of a FOB, conduct back briefs, rehearsals, PCIs, and period scenario-based decision exercises.
- (4) Every Leader and Soldier directly involved in an EOF Incident will receive refresher training and certification by their chain of command.

5. Findings:

- a. Hostile Act/Intent: This investigation reveals that the squad was justified in stopping this vehicle and that the driver committed a hostile act that threatened the lives of the squad leader and interpreter. The suspects in this incident warranted investigation because they were driving a vehicle and conducting suspicious activity during curfew hours. They warranted further investigation when the passenger fled into the alley. The driver committed a hostile act when he appeared to try and run over the squad leader and interpreter with his vehicle.
- b. Proper use of MNC-I Escalation of Force: This escalation of force incident complies with the MNC-I ROE and recent MND-B EOF guidance as demonstrated below:
 - (1) Show/Shout – The squad leader's gunner made every effort to get the suspect's attention by making gestures and yelling at them. The suspects ignored the gunner's commands. The squad leader and interpreter made every effort to get the suspect's attention by yelling at them using the local language.
 - (2) Shove – There was no ability for the squad to shove the suspects since the squad leader was dismounted and the suspects had either fled the area or started to move the vehicle toward the dismounted soldiers. The makes shift barrier was located between the two vehicles which further prevented the M1114 driver from using his vehicle from shoving the suspect vehicle out of the squad leader and interpreter's path.
 - (3) Shoot non-lethal warning shot – The engagement began with non-lethal means when the gunner from the squad leader's vehicle observed that the suspect vehicle did not comply with the squad leader and interpreter's demand that he get out of the vehicle but instead started to drive away. The first shot fired

was a non-lethal round from a shotgun. It was fired at the suspect's vehicle and the suspect continued to commit hostile acts by continuing to back up into the squad leader and the interpreter.

- (4) Shoot a lethal warning/disabling shot – The squad leader fire two sets of lethal warning shots away from the vehicle in an effort to get the suspect driving the vehicle to stop. The suspect vehicle responded by trying to run the squad leader over, forcing him shoot a second pair of lethal warning shots from his M4 and to dive out of the vehicle's path.
- (5) Shoot a lethal deadly shot – Once all efforts to stop the vehicle and eliminate the threat to the squad leader and interpreter were exhausted through non-lethal means, the squad opened fire with two weapons into the vehicle. They stopped the vehicle and eliminated the threat to the dismounted soldiers.

- c. CGs Combat Guidance: This squad conducted an EOF rehearsal prior to this mission IAW item 2 of the MND-B commander's combat guidance (Exhibit AA). The unit conducts a standardized convoy brief prior to every mission using a standard briefing format (Exhibit CC).
- d. CG's Standing Orders: This squad complied with the MND-B commander's standing order of knowing the ROE and level's of force outlined in item 2 (Exhibit Z). All members of the squad were well versed in EOF ROE when questioned.
- e. Full use of vehicle EOF equipment. The squad on this mission has not been equipped with all of the EOF items outlined in BDE and higher guidance. They had one combination Siren/PA system for four vehicles, three handheld spot lights, and two green lasers (Exhibit BB). While these were present, the speed at which this incident unfolded prevented use of them in a sequential manner. The unit has requested additional EOF items through purchase requests to meet brigade and division intent but they are waiting on approval and receipt.
- f. Witness Statement Validity: All witness statements to this incident are in agreement with each other as to what happened that night. Those with direct involvement or visibility of the incident all confirm the facts as stated. Those with limited involvement or visibility of the incident support the statements of those more involved. The quality and content of the witness statements provide a credible account of this incident.

6. Recommendations:

- a. There is no recommendation for any administrative or punitive action in this incident because these soldiers complied directly with published EOF ROE.

- b. The soldiers/unit involved in this incident should continue to enforce ROE and EOF standards currently in place in this unit. They acted IAW published guidance and directives as circumstances would permit.
- c. The vehicles in this unit require full fielding of all EOF equipment. The soldiers attempted to shout at these individuals with no indication they used bull horns, loud speakers, or sirens. This is due in large part to insufficient fielding. The unit must ensure the soldiers have the EOF equipment required to execute the Shout and Show aspects of EOF. The unit must ensure patrols use all non-lethal EOF equipment as a primary means to avoid lethal engagements before taking any lethal EOF action. Note – The required EOF equipment is on order through a purchase request initiated prior to this engagement.
- d. The soldiers involved in this EOF should be pulled off mission long enough to conduct EOF refresher training and certification IAW MNC-I Policy Letter #15.

ON 27FEB06 MY PATROL WAS ATTEMPTING TO GAIN KNOWLEDGE ABOUT A MOSQUE THAT WAS SUPPOSEDLY ATTACKED. WE HAD REQUESTED FOR A SECURITY HAUL TO WAIT ON THE INFORMATION WHEN I OBSERVED A CAR DRIVING TOWARDS US [REDACTED] IN MULHALA 810, SO WE DECIDED TO STOP IT BECAUSE IT WAS BEFORE CURFEW (0522). WE CROSSED SONICS & THE FIRST TWO HUMVEES STOPPED AT A MAKESHIFT ROAD BARRIER WHERE THE SAID VEHICLE'S DRIVER WAS MOVING PORTIONS OF THE BARRIER. AS MY HUMVEE (THE THIRD) DROVE UP, I ORIENTED MY TRUCK TO THE RIGHT TO ENSURE I HAD VIEW OF THE VEHICLE. During patrol number 833 (2200-0600), around 0520 the patrol was gathering information about IPs that had fired upon a mosque, when the lead vehicle in the patrol noticed a car across the street vic grid [REDACTED] that was moving prior to lift of curfew. We crossed [REDACTED] to investigate (primary times for IED emplacement in the AO is between 0530 to 0630 and 1700 to 1800). The driver was moving barricades to allow his car to move out of the mohalla and onto [REDACTED] (the car was facing South). I was the trail vehicle, so by the time I crossed the road and linked up with the rest of the patrol, I saw [REDACTED] firing warning shots from his M240B on the lead vehicle on the left side of the road (road runs North/South and the M1114 [REDACTED] was on the West side of the road with [REDACTED] and his M2 on the other M1114 on the East side of the road even with each other, effectively blocking passage down the road to [REDACTED]). I saw [REDACTED] and the Interpreter (Z) dive toward the right side of the road, and the lead two vehicles engaged the vehicle backing up towards the patrol. The vehicle sustained several hits to the trunk area of the vehicle, started rolling forward, then burst into flames. I believe the tracer rounds either punctured the fuel tank, or ignited something else in the trunk/back of the car. Shortly after the car started burning, several small explosions occurred, alarming us enough to pull all the vehicles back from the vehicle about 150 meters. Several pops issued from the vehicle, and I moved forward to link up with [REDACTED] to find out what had led to the vehicle getting engaged. [REDACTED] told me the vehicle had been stopped, [REDACTED] and the Interpreter Z moved forward yelling at the driver to get out of the vehicle (driver had gotten back into the vehicle) when a passenger ran out of the passenger side of the vehicle and disappeared into the palmetto trees. The driver had then started to turn the vehicle around, [REDACTED] and the Interpreter Z started shouting more for the driver to stop. When the driver didn't heed the yelling, [REDACTED] shot a non-lethal M203 round at the vehicle, impacting on the side of the door as the vehicle was turning. I stopped asking [REDACTED] questions at that time, thinking I had the majority of the information since I had seen [REDACTED] and the Interpreter dive out of the way, the warning shots from [REDACTED], and the lethal shots from [REDACTED]. I didn't learn until later that [REDACTED] had fired a total of four warning shots with his M4. I then got on the radio and notified Renegade TOC (FM 930) of what I knew had occurred. They asked if I needed IP assistance and I told them yes, and notified them that I needed a fire truck on site (once I finished the report to Renegade main (about 0545), the smaller explosions occurred). The fire truck arrived around 0600, and the patrol waited until the fire was extinguished before moving forward to secure the area. At this time, approximately 0615, we started taking pictures of the vehicle and collateral damage to buildings in the surrounding area from ricochets. Once we completed gathering pictures, we started issuing claims cards to the family (lives in Muhalla 812, street 4, building 8) and neighbors on street 5 that caught some of the ricochets. After we finished issuing claims cards, the IPs showed up and said that they would take care of the car and remains. I asked if they wanted to talk to us about what happened, and they said no. I then contacted Renegade main and informed them that the IPs were on site and taking care of the situation. The patrol then departed the site and returned to FOB Falcon. I wasn't linked up with the lead elements of the patrol when the driver took off his turban and made the hand gestures. Once I returned to FOB Falcon, I went to the 0800 BUB and informed the BN Commander of the situation.
