<p>I, [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:</p> <p>ON OR ABOUT 08 0930 MAR 06 I WAS LEADING A DISMOUNTED TEAM IN A MEET AND GREAT VICINITY OBJ COPPER. WE MEET THE SHIEK OF THE AREA AND DISCUSSED THE AREA WITH HIM AND HIS SON. OUR MOUNTED ELEMENT WAS SETTING UP A TCP AT OBJ COPPER [REDACTED] WHILE TALKING WITH THE SHIEK SMALL ARMS FIRE WAS AUDIBLE FROM THE TCP LOCATION FOLLOWED BY A BLAST. WE MOVED FROM THE HOUSE TO THE TCP LOCATION TO GET A SPOT REPORT OF TWO MEN FLEEING EAST AND TWO MEN FLEEING WEST FROM A CAR THAT ENGAGED OUR MOUNTED ELEMENT. WE BEGAN PURSUIT OF THE MEN FLEEING EAST FOR THEY HAD ALREADY PASSED OUR LOCATION BEFORE AN ACCURATE SITREP COULD BE TRANSMITTED. THE TWO MEN WERE WEARING BLACK MAN DRESSES AND HAD WEAPONS. WE BEGAN MOVING EAST AND AS WE CROSSED FARMERS THEY WOULD POINT THE TWO MEN OUT TO US. WE GAINED VISUAL CONTACT. AND MY TEAM MOVED UP TO GET ON LINE AS THE OTHER TEAM LAYED DOWN FIRE. WE DID THIS FOR ABOUT 200 METERS. WHILE FIRE AND MANUEVERING LOCALS WOULD CONTINUE TO POINT OUT THE MEN. WE LOST CONTACT AND AFTER SCANNING A MAN FLAGGED US DOWN TO LEAD US TO WHERE A MAN WAS SHOT BELOW HIS RIGHT PECTORAL. HE WAS SURROUNDED BY HIS FAMILY AND WE INSTRUCTED THEM TO GIVE US ROOM SO OUR MEDIC CAN RENDURE AID. WE CALLED IN THE 9 LINE MEDEVAC AND PREPPED THE MAN FOR FURTHER TREATMENT. WHILE PROVIDING TREATMENT THE OTHER MEN OF THE HOUSE SAID THEY SAW TWO MEN FLEEING TO THE SOUTH EAST. 



crossing to south at grid [REDACTED]







The purpose of this statement is to outline the interviews that I conducted on 12 March 06 with CPT [REDACTED], SSG [REDACTED] and SGT [REDACTED] in regards to the incident on 08 March 06 in which a local national Iraqi was killed after Shadow was engaged by enemy fire and IED.

CPT [REDACTED] informed me that when the dark blue Daewoo approached his mounted TCP, overwatching the canal crossing, it refused to follow the orders of the TCP and stop to be searched. The mounted element performed escalation of force and was fired upon as soon as they fired their warning shot. The car was 200m away from the checkpoint when it fired upon Shadow's forces on the south side of the bridge. After the men fired, the 4 men split into sections of two. One section ran east while one ran west. As they were running away they detonated a defensive IED 80m from Shadow's mounted element. CPT [REDACTED] came out of the Shaik's house and gathered his platoon to chase the fleeing men. He sent his mounted squad to chase the men who ran west and took his dismounted squad along with a terp to chase the other two men to the southeast. As they were moving through the farm land they asked the locals if they saw the men, and many responded that they did running with weapons. Based on intel from the locals they regained contact with the fleeing men. The men were 600m away from Shadow's dismounted element and the two men crouched down and then got up to continue fleeing. At that time, CPT [REDACTED] had his squad conduct bounding overwatch and ordered his squad to fire on the fleeing men. The squad bounded over 2 canals and fired when they were within 400m of the enemy. As Shadow continued their bound, they were flagged down by a family who was surrounding a man who was hot in the field. The men were thankful to Shadow for helping to protect them and one man who may have been related to the man who was shot gave CPT [REDACTED] a kiss to thank him. Shadow's medic treated the man and called in for an air med-evac. The med-evac showed up an hour later and picked up the man who later died. Shadow x-sprayed the man, Ali Hussein Anaad, who came up negative for any explosive residue. The man at the time was wearing a dishdasha which matched that of the fleeing 2 enemy individuals. Shadow fired roughly 50-60 5.56mm rounds during the entire engagement. CPT LeMaire told me that even when the family came to pick up the body, they were thankful to him.

UPDATE: 1200L: 2-8 SCOUTS WERE DOING A MEET AND GREET WHEN A BLACK 4 DOOR SEDAN PULLED UP AND FIRED UPON THEM. 4 X IN SURGENTS DISMOUNTED THE VEHICLE. 2X INSURGENTS FLED TO THE EAST AND 2X INSURGENTS FLED TO THE WEST ON FOOT. TWO INSURGENTS THAT FLED TO THE WEST GOT IN A PICKUP TRUCK AND PROCEEDED SOUTH. THE SCOUTS FIRED AT THE 2X INSURGENTS THAT FLED TO THE EAST, HAT IS WHEN THE LN WAS SHOT IN THE CHEST BY US FORCES. REPORTS INDICATE THE LN WAS MISTAKENLY IDENTIFIED AS AN INSURGENT. SCOUTS SECURED THE BLACK 4 DOOR SEDAN AND SECURED 1X RPK, 1X AK47, 10X MAGAZINES, 500 RPK RDS AND 1 HAND GRENADE FOUND IN THE CAR. AS THE INSURGENTS WERE FLEEING THEY DROPPED AN IED COMPOSED OF 2X 130MM RDS. 1X RD DETONATED AND EOD IS ON SITE TO RECOVER THE OTHER 1X 130MM RD.

UPDATE: 1300L: THE SINGLE MEDEVACED, LOCAL NATIONAL WAS NOT AN INSURGENT AS WAS INITIALLY REPORTED. THE LATEST REPORT IS THAT HE WAS MISTAKEN AS AN INSURGENT BECAUSE HE WAS WEARING SIMILAR STYLE CLOTHING AS ONE OF THE FLEEING INSURGENTS. THE SCOUT PATROL LEADER DID NOT SEND AN ESCORT WITH THE WIA. A MORE DETAILED REPORT WILL FOLLOW PENDING DEBRIEF FROM SCOUT'S PATROL.

UPDATE: 1335L: SCOUTS WITH ASSISTANCE FROM EOD AND WIT TEAM HAVE EXPLOITED THE BLACK SEDAN. EOD RENDERED THE VEHICLE INOPERABLE. THE ENGINE WAS DESTROYED INITIALLY IN THE SMALL ARMS ATTACK. SCOUTS ARE ENROUTE TO FOB KALSU AND EOD IS ENROUTE TO MORTAR IMPACT SITE IN DIYARAH.

UPDATE 1607: EOD CONDUCTED POST BLAST ANALYSIS FOUND TWO BLAST SEATS.

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B. Summary of incident:

Summary of incident: At 080930L Mar, 2-8 IN Scouts were conducting a meet and greet operation in the vicinity of the bridge at [REDACTED] 9 when a black 4-door sedan pulled up to a hasty checkpoint the Scouts had established at the bridge. The vehicle matched the description of a known insurgent vehicle that occasionally transited the bridge. Scouts on the scene signaled for the vehicle to stop. The vehicle initially attempted to avoid the checkpoint by trying to turn around. The gunner of the Scout HWMV at the checkpoint charged his weapon and pointed it at the vehicle. Upon seeing this, the vehicle stopped trying to turn around and began rapidly backing up. The Scouts fired a single round into the radiator and engine block of the vehicle which dumped the radiator fluid and locked up the engine. Several seconds later, four individuals rapidly exited the vehicle. Two headed east and two went west. They were armed with weapons including a PKC, pistol, and AK-47. They fired all three weapons to attempt to suppress the gunner and then began running to get away. At the same time, an IED detonated approximately 100 meters to the northwest of the Scout position. The IED was buried in the ground at the entrance to the bridge and

consisted of 2x130mm rounds, land mine with an LRCT. The IED was presumably detonated as a diversion to allow the four insurgents to escape. The Scout Platoon elements on site immediately returned fire and began pursuit. The two individuals who ran to the west crossed to a parallel road where they jumped into a white pick-up truck and proceeded south.

A dismounted section of the Scout platoon continued to pursue the two men who moved east for almost a kilometer through a series of farm fields and canals. The men traded gunfire with the Scouts several time during the pursuit. The Scouts attempted to close the distance by conducting bounding overwatch with one element suppressing the men with fire while the other element bounded forward. Both individuals had short hair, medium build and were wearing dark colored dishdashas. At one point in the pursuit, the scouts lost visual contact with the fleeing insurgents for a period of about 60 seconds. Assisted by local civilians who were pointing to where the insurgents ran, the scouts regained visual contact with a single individual with short hair, medium build, and wearing a black dishdasha running away from them through the same field where they had last seen the insurgents. SGT [REDACTED] identified the individual in his ACOG site on his M4, confirmed that the individual met the description, location and the behavior of the man he had been pursuing and exchanging fire with. SGT [REDACTED] then fired a single shot with his M4 at a range of 450 meters striking the man in the torso. The man dropped to the ground immediately upon being struck.

A local family that had been watching the engagement immediately approached the Scouts and told them that the man they had shot was not one of the insurgents- that the insurgents had continued to run further to the southeast. This was the first and only indication that the scouts may have engaged the wrong running man. The Scout PL, CPT [REDACTED] immediately called for a MEDEVAC. The individual was evacuated to the 10th CSH where he was pronounced DOA. Prior to MEDEVAC the man was tested with X-spray with negative results.

2-8IN is currently assisting the family in the recovery of the remains at 10th CSH and will continue to investigate this under Article 15-6. The family was already aware that Coalition Forces typically provide a significant solatia payment for accidental shootings and has inquired about this payment. As of this report, we are unable to conclusively determine whether or not the man killed was one of the original insurgents or a local national who was running at the wrong place and time. We are collecting forensic evidence from the weapons seized and have asked the family to provide us with evidence to indicate the dead man's association with them. The Article 15-6 investigating officer will review all of the evidence and make a recommendation regarding payment of solatia based on the preponderance of the evidence.

I, [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

I needed to investigate further into the incident with the Scout Platoon on 08 March 2006. I spoke with CPT [REDACTED] SGT [REDACTED]s, and SSC [REDACTED] on 24 March 06. They told me about previous incidents that happened at the checkpoint at the bridge in the Obeidi region. There were two previous occasions where a vehicle approached the checkpoint and acted in the same manner that the black vehicle did on the 8th of March. During the first incident a vehicle approached the checkpoint, refused to pull up to the checkpoint, backed up at a high rate of speed and nearly ran over one of the scout soldiers. The vehicle escaped the first time. The second incident was with a similiar vehicle. The vehicle pulled up to the checkpoint, tried to turn around, and sped off away from the checkpoint. The Scouts this time had a secondary position to stop the vehicle and attempted to stop it. The vehicle opened fire on the scouts and escaped. The black vehicle on the 8th of March acted in the same manner as the two previous incidents.

I was also informed that at the time of the contact with the two fleeing men, SGT [REDACTED] saw the man in the brown dishdasha running and put him in his weapon's sight and positively identified him before firing. He also told me that the same man that he saw running was the man that they found wounded on the ground.

I asked the scouts if they saw any evidence of any farm equipment or things that would show that the man who was shot was farming. They said that in the field he was found there was nothing at all to indicate that he was farming.
