I, SFC [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

ON 19 APR 05 AT OR ABOUT 2930 hrs WE MOVED FROM [REDACTED] HEADED NORTH ON RT# [REDACTED] TOWARDS [REDACTED] AT [REDACTED]. AS WE MOVED NORTH MY BATTERY WAS BEHIND THE EAST SIDE OF [REDACTED] TO INCLUDE AREA OF MOSQUE. A MAN APPROACH AS AS HE WAS WALKING DOWN THE SOUTH BOUND LANE, TO SOME LANE WE WERE HEADED NORTH IN. AS OUR HEADLIGHTS CAUGHT HIM SO WE COULD SEE HIM, HE WALKED INTO THE PATH OF THE TANK AND TOWARD THE TANK. I AS TANK COMMANDER ASKED MY DRIVER TO SLOW DOWN AND HE DID. MY LOADER TRIED TO PUSH THE MAN TO THE SIDE OF THE ROAD AND YEELLED FOR HIM TO GET OUT OF THE WAY. THE MAN CONTINUED TO APPROACH AND WOULD NOT YIELD. WE COULD NOT SEE WHAT THE MAN HAD IN HIS HAND AS IT WAS CLINCHED CLOSED AND HE HELD IT TO HIS CHEST. MY IMMEDIATE REACTION WAS THAT THE MAN MAY HAVE A SUICIDE VEST ON, HIS UPPER BODY APPEARED TO BE PULSED BUT I COULD NOT BE SURE. AS THE MAN APPROACHED THE TANK AND WAS PROBABLY 10 TO 15 METERS AWAY I COMMANDED MY DRIVER TO BACK UP WHICH HE DID. THE MAN CONTINUED TO WALK IN OUR DIRECTION. BEFORE WE MOVED MY LOADER SFC [REDACTED] YELLED IN BOTH ENGLISH AND ARABIC TO STOP OR I WILL SHOOT. TWICE IN ARABIC AND ONCE IN ENGLISH. AS WE BACKED THE MAN CONTINUED AND I AUTHORIZED WARNING SHOTS. THE SHOTS LANDED ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE MANS FEET. THESE SHOTS DID NOT PHASE THE MAN, WE WERE CONCERNED THAT HE WAS WALKING US INTO AN IED OR AMBUSH. THE FIRST WARNING SHOT WAS FIRED; WE OBSERVED HIS REACTION, HE JUST CONTINUED TOWARD US. A FEW SECONDS LATER THE SECOND WARNING SHOT WAS FIRED. THIS MADE THE MAN WALK FASTER AND AGAIN RIGHT INTO THE PATH OF OUR TANK. STILL BACKING UP AND TRYING TO KEEP MY TANK ON THE ROAD AND EYES OUT FOR AN IED OR AMBUSH. WE CAUGHT A GLIMPSE OF THE MAN ACTING AS IF HE WERE GOING TO THROW SOMETHING AS HE MOVED HIS CLINCHED HAND AND MOVED IT IN A THROWING MOTION. WHEN I SAY WE I MEAN MYSELF AND THE TC, SGT [REDACTED] AND

 The Gunner, SPC [redacted] as the Leader and PFC [redacted] as my driver. At THIS TIME my Gunner SGT [redacted] who watched the entire incident in his Thermal sights announced that he was going to throw something, that someone was ordered by my leader and at that time SPC [redacted] fired 3 shots, 1 Ammer shot at the CHEST AND TWO PINK ROUNDS WHICH HIT NOTHING. The man after being shot continued to walk toward the tank for about 5 seconds until he went to the ground. At that time I moved the tank back about 50 meters so we would have stand off. My Gunner continued to scan the area for more bad guys and I called [redacted] for assistance. The man got up and walked to the side of the road and went down again. I called a 9-line medic as [redacted] secure the rest of the area and medic applied 1st Aid To The Man. He was Air Evaced shortly after. END OF STATEMENT

I, [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On the 19th of April 2005, approx 2345 hrs, tank w/ bumper # D24 was heading north on MSR [REDACTED], heading to the refuel site, at [REDACTED]. SFC [REDACTED] was TCing, SFC [REDACTED], myself, was the loader, Sgt [REDACTED] as gunner, and PVT [REDACTED] as driver. The gunner noticed several people through the thermal viewing system underneath the bridge and around the mosque. As we came closer, the gunner lost sight of the three men. As we are still heading North, we see a man on the side of the road leading southbound. We stop the tank in the middle of the street, and both the TC and myself told the driver to backup. He starts backing up slowly, but the man starts walking in the middle of the street, toward us! He is very close at this point, about 25-35 meters. I scream "Angoff! Angoff! Tara comeek!" He doesn't respond and just keeps walking toward us, as we back up.

I tell the tank commander I am going to fire a warning shot. I take careful aim, and put a round about three feet to his left foot. He keeps walking, but seems to pickup his pace toward us. I fire another shot at his feet and he doesn't even flinch. He picks up his pace. The whole time this is happening, he has his right hand up, and his thumb extended, fist clenched. It looks as if he has a black object in his hand. I tell the TC, "He might be backing us on to an ambush or IED." At that point, we are still backing up, he is still approaching, and I hear the gunner yell, "he's throwing something!!" Before he gets the whole sentence out, I see him wind up like he has a baseball or something. We are only about ^{20 or} 25 meters away at this point, I did not want him to get the grenade off, so w/out hesitating, I very quickly aim centermass, and let off three shots. I saw him barely flinch, he stopped coming toward us, I put my M4 on safe. The man walks to the side of the road and collapses. I pickup my scan of the rear left, and my TC calls the 9-Line Medevac.

GENERAL RULES

1. On order, enemy military and paramilitary forces are declared hostile and may be attacked subject to the following restrictions:

- a. Positive identification (PID) is required prior to engagement. PID is a reasonable certainty that the proposed target is a legitimate military target. If no PID, contact your next higher commander for decision.
- b. Do not engage anyone who has surrendered or is out of battle due to sickness or wounds.
- c. Do not target or strike any of the following groups in self-defense to protect yourself, your unit, friendly forces, and designated persons or property under your control:
 - 1. Civilians
 - 2. Hospital, mosque, churches, shrines, schools, magazines, medical headquarters, and any other historical and cultural sites

d. Do not take any civilian populations or buildings under the control of the enemy as a military objective or as necessary for your self-defense. Military objectives include:

- a. Do not target enemy infrastructure projects, power, transportation, communication facilities, lines of communication, roads, highways, bridges, bridges, railways and harbors. Obsolete (unusable) storage facilities (depot) unless necessary for self-defense or if directed by your commander. If you must fire on these objects in single or hostile force, status and should not avoid destruction of these objects, if possible.



GENERAL RULES FOR USE OF FORCE

NOTHING IN THESE RULES LIMITS YOUR INHERENT AUTHORITY AND OBLIGATION TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE ACTION TO DEFEND YOURSELF, YOUR UNIT, AND OTHER US FORCES.

1. HOSTILE FORCES: US forces have been declared hostile.

2. HOSTILE ACTIVITIES: You may engage persons who commit hostile acts or show hostile intent with the minimum force necessary to counter the hostile act or demonstrate hostile intent and to protect US forces.

3. HOSTILE USE: An attack or other use of force against US forces or the assets of US forces is considered hostile. Hostile use of force includes the use of force against US forces or the assets of US forces.

4. You may use force, up to and including deadly force, against hostile forces.

5. In self-defense:

a. In defense of your unit, or other US forces, armaments, supplies, or property designated by your Commander as used to reduce security. (Protect other property wherever they deploy force.)

2. The use of force, including deadly force, is authorized to protect the following:

- Youself, your unit, and friendly forces
- Enemy Prisoners of War
- Civilians from crimes that are likely to cause death or serious bodily harm, such as murder or rape
- Designated pillars of infrastructure, such as personnel of the Red Cross/Cross-in-Red, UN, and UNICEF supported organizations

3. Treat all civilians and their property with respect and dignity. Do not seize civilian property, including vehicles, unless you have the permission of a commanding level commander and you give a receipt to the property's owner.

4. Debris of aircraft they acquire with attack in accomplishment or if required by self-defense.

REMEMBER

- Attack enemy forces and military bases, bases, airfields, and other military targets, if possible
- Carry out yourself with dignity and honor
- Comply with the Law of War. If you see a violation, report it.

These ROE will remain in effect until your commander orders you to transition to post-hostilities ROE.

CELOC RULES FOR USE OF FORCE

NOTHING IN THESE RULES LIMITS YOUR INHERENT AUTHORITY AND DISCRETION TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE ACTION TO DEFEND YOURSELF, YOUR UNIT, AND OTHER US FORCES.

4. ESCORT AIRCRAFT FORCES: When possible, use the following degrees of force against hostile aircraft:
a. **SHOULD** employ warning or "off" interceptors "COUCH" if:

- 1. **SHOULD** employ radar, search services, or other
- 2. **SHOULD** employ warning and interceptors in front of use of force
- 3. **SHOULD** for reserve the threat of destruction, only if you are in a position to destroy the aircraft.

(1) **NO** use of force: **NO** WARNING SHOTS, **NO** use of force (including friendly fire) or other actions that are not necessary for self-defense.

5. **ORANGE**: Conduct rules of war, rules of engagement with US forces with the minimum necessary force when self-defense is required, through the following steps in order:
a. Repeated warnings to "pull" or "stop" (unintended "shootdown")

b. Show of force, including but not limited to:
c. Escalation of force, or other restrictive use of force, as appropriate to the circumstances and proportional to the threat.

6. **DEFENSE**: You may stop, assist, assist, and detain persons as required to protect US forces. Soldiers will be turned over to the Military Police or Kinross Police ASAR.

7. These rules will remain in effect until your commander orders you to transition to post-hostilities ROE.
