while conducting route clearance along Route [redacted] (north bound) our vehicle (lead vehicle) came across an elderly local national wandering aimlessly on the road. The suspicious individual suddenly turned and began walking straight towards our vehicle. We had to turn our wheel to avoid hitting him. Our gunner fired warning shots and hollered to stop waving him away. He continued past our vehicle. As he passed we noticed a yellow wire and a gold object in his hands. We radioed to vehicle 2 that he was headed in their direction. I told the driver to stop and to dismount in order to detain the individual. The local national continued to walk straight for vehicle 2. Despite repeated warnings he continued. CPL [redacted] a dismount from the second vehicle fired a three round burst at the feet of the local national. The local national stopped for a

a moment but continued walking towards CPL [REDACTED] CPL [REDACTED] fired a second three round burst. I did not see where he aimed but the local national fell to the ground. I called for the medic immediately. The medic came forward and pronounced the man dead. We flagged down some Iraqi Police. They secured the body and called for an ambulance as we put his body in a body bag. We asked a representative of the Ministry of Interior, Mr. [REDACTED] to count the money found on the local national, which turned out to be 12,000 dinar. We reported to higher and continued mission. A Iraqi civilian was standing on the side of the road. Spc. [REDACTED] said he had something in his hand. I dismounted with Spc. [REDACTED] and approached the Iraqi civilian. Inside of the circle was Cpt. [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and myself. The Iraqi civilian took two steps and did not stop when everyone said to stop. Spc. [REDACTED] shot his M 249 at two separate increments. The rounds flew off the ground and the man started bleeding, fell on the ground, and later died.

On 28 May 05 at approx. 2345 we, 1st Squad, stopped a Curfew violator at vic. grid [REDACTED]. I was the TC over [REDACTED] of the rear truck and after we were on site for approx 10-15 minutes when I saw two men, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] I was about to shoot for them to come closer so I could question them about breaking Curfew when I saw [REDACTED] raise his hand skyward and cock a pistol. He lowered the weapon to take aim when I heard the first shot. A second was fired before I could return fire. I began firing at [REDACTED] after a few (2-3) rounds SPC [REDACTED] began firing. I got a malfunction with my weapon (failure to extract) so I took a knee and began to correct it. SSG [REDACTED] asked for a sitrep, I told him we were taking fire from one man. [REDACTED] fired a few more rounds during the fight, SPC [REDACTED] was firing with his M249, SPC [REDACTED] was firing with his M240B. I called for more men so we could advance and the shooting stopped. Myself, SPC [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED], PVT [REDACTED] began to close the distance to where [REDACTED] retreated to, by this time we had been shot and no more Coalition shots were fired. I called for an interpreter and told him that they were to throw the weapon in the street. Continued on Back

My element was moving in a file down the street, I began to Fan out, my Soldiers followed so we had a "strong wall" as we got closer I identified we had an enemy down and we were still yelling for the weapon when a shot was fired at me. I didn't know it was aimed at me for a minute and I didn't see who fired it, I shouted "who fired that shot" and all of my Soldiers went quiet for a moment, I think it was SPC [REDACTED] but not sure who said "the little boy has the Gun." My Soldiers and I charged the gate to the home and entered and cleared the house. No shots fired. I handcuffed [REDACTED] in the "living room" we recovered the pistol (a.380) an AK-47 with one Magazine, 13 cell phones, a video camera, a VHS tape, a PC cputower. A while later (I have now^{gus} Idea what time) Iraqi Police arrived on the scene. Approx. 20-30 minutes after IP's arrived, [REDACTED] (Captin [REDACTED]) arrived on site. After his assesment we straitend up the home a bit then returned to FOB [REDACTED]

I WAS IN THE BACK PULLING SECURITY TOWARDS THE WEST AND A ROAD TOWARDS THE NORTH. TWO PEOPLE CAME RUSHING OUT A HOUSE, ONE W/ A PISTOL AND ANOTHER GUY TRYIN TO STOP HIM. THE GUY W/ A PISTOL CHARGED THE PISTOL AND SHOT TWICE IN THE AIR, THEN SGT [REDACTED] FIRED A COUPLE OF SHOTS TOWARDS HIM THEN I FIRED ONE SHOT, THEN HE ~~SAID~~ (THE SUSPECT) ~~FIRED~~ POINTED HIS PISTOL TOWARDS ME AND ~~HE~~ FIRED TWO SHOTS SO I RETURN FIRE. During a routine patrol, at about 1145, we were stopped along [REDACTED] Street. Our vehicles were facing East, the last vehicle was parked at the end of a street running North to South. I was starting to head back to my vehicle, a HMMV in a 3 vehicle convoy, when I heard gunfire coming from the North. The rounds were coming toward us from the North-South Street (Unknown Street Name). From my position I could not see the shooter but I saw a round impact a few meters from my position. I pulled back the charging handle on my M249 and commenced to firing 75 rounds to suppress the shooter's fire. Once all the firing died down we moved down the street. We heard a woman screaming then we saw her standing in the street. Next to her we saw the body of the shooter and I watched as members of my Squad entered the house. I stayed outside and pulled security.

SECTION IV - FINDINGS (para 3-10, AR 15-6)

The ~~investigating officer~~ (board), having carefully considered the evidence, finds:

That on 21 May 2005, an IED was discovered on Route [REDACTED] by a patrol of B/2-156 IN. Once the IED was discovered, B/2-156 IN called for EOD to report to the site and detonate the IED. A/1088 EN under the command of SPC [REDACTED] escorted EOD to the site. Outer security was established by B/2-156 IN. Once arriving at the IED site, A/1088 EN coordinated with CPT [REDACTED] (OIC on the ground). Adjustments were made to the Outer Cordon and EOD moved in to disarm or blow the IED. The area began to receive mortar fire close to the location of the inner and outer cordon of the IED site. Next, soldiers of A/1088 noticed a white car traveling back and forth (East-West) on the Service Road, north of Route [REDACTED]. A/1088 EN soldiers contacted B/1-156 IN (CPT [REDACTED]) about this suspicious activity. CPT [REDACTED] repositioned a M1114 in the median of the road to observe (and possibly react) to this threat. The white car passes again, and the soldiers in the M1114 began chase of this vehicle moving East on the Service Road of Route [REDACTED]. Once the chase began 2 additional events occurred; 1) a Green sedan pulled between 2 buildings facing the soldiers of both A/1088 and B/1-156 IN and began to fire - hitting SGT [REDACTED] in the neck (seriously injuring him). 2) Two additional vehicles pulled close to the firing vehicle. Some occupants of both of these vehicles exited the vehicles and ran toward the building behind the firing vehicle. At this point, soldiers of A/1088 EN began to return fire on the Green sedan. B/2-156 IN did not have a clear shot to the Green LN sedan (Shooter). The statements of SGT [REDACTED], 2LT [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED], and SGT [REDACTED] of A/1088 EN (Exhibit III) verify this series of events. During this exchange of fire, the 2 other Local National vehicles were hit - killing one passenger and injuring two others. It is very important to note that both LN vehicles were hit both by fire from A/1088 and the Green LN vehicle (Shooter). It is impossible to determine who actually shot the LNs in question due to bullet damage to both sides of the vehicle. SGT [REDACTED] was MEDEVAC'ed via air. The 3 Local Nationals that were hit were attended by B/2-156 IN personnel and Iraqi Police, who escorted the injured to the LN hospital. It is evident through my interviews of the soldiers involved from A/1088 EN and CPT [REDACTED] (Exhibit IV) of B/2-156 IN that proper ROE, policies and guidelines were established when setting the cordon (inner and outer) when establishing the IED recovery site. It is also my findings that A/1088 EN acted IAW established and published ROE when returning fire. It is unfortunate that 2 LN vehicles were caught in the middle of this fire - but this fire was necessary as the units has taken casualties and absolutely had the need to defend themselves. Furthermore, as stated previously, there was bullet damage on both sides of the damaged 2 LN vehicles making it impossible to determine who actually injured the occupants and damaged the vehicles. A series of sketches of this incident are included (Exhibit V).

On the 21st of May of 2005, we were attacked with mortars and were on the receiving end of small arms fire/machine gun fire. We, being Charlie team of 2nd Platoon of A Co 1088 ENGR BN. We were on an EOD mission. I, SGT [REDACTED] was a gunner for the rear gun truck. After we arrived on site we were attacked by mortars. Two mortars were fired right over our heads. Afterwards, my comrades and I noticed suspicious activity from the local nationals. SGT [REDACTED], SPC [REDACTED], and CPL [REDACTED], who were all passengers in the rear gun truck, were dismounted at the time. They noticed a two door white car that kept making the block over and over again. The white car was reported to higher. The outer cordon waited for the car to pass back so that they can go after it. The white car passed back. The gun truck waiting for it took off to go after it. Once they got on the street in front of our position, three cars pulled up real close to them. I then aimed at the car (orange and white car) that was closest to the frontlines. The car didn't back up. We then received gun fire from the very same alley the car was stopped in front of. I could hear the rounds land close to me, so I got down. I then stood up and returned fire with my M-16 A-4. I engaged the very same car I was aimed at before I got down, who I believed to be the trigger men. SGT [REDACTED] was shot. SPC [REDACTED] dragged SGT [REDACTED] to cover in back of my gun truck. A Medevac was called.

While on an BOD escort mission, we noticed a white 2 door car with a dent in the driver side rear quarterpanel that had passed our location three times earlier. We coordinated with 1269th, who was our outer cordon security, to provide a chase vehicle if the car appeared again. The car appeared and we informed the chase vehicle of it's location. They proceeded north from [REDACTED] to the northside service road and turned east on said road. When they passed the first alley after the turn, I heard automatic weapons fire coming from the north and bullet impacts near my feet. I was standing to the west of [REDACTED] and took cover on the southside of the same vehicle. I saw dust and smoke coming from the alley and returned suppressive fire down the alley. I fired approximately twenty rounds, looked to my right and saw SGT [REDACTED] lying on his back. I yelled for SPC [REDACTED] to recover SGT [REDACTED]. He proceeded to recover SGT [REDACTED] by pulling him from SGT [REDACTED] right shoulder and I pulled SGT [REDACTED] by the left arm. We pulled SGT [REDACTED] behind [REDACTED] and I yelled at SPC [REDACTED] to get my aid bag out of [REDACTED]. When I looked at SGT [REDACTED] again, SPC [REDACTED] was attending to him. I asked where SGT [REDACTED] was hit and SPC [REDACTED] told me in the neck. I uncovered the wound and applied direct pressure with my right hand while SPC [REDACTED] procured a kerlix roll to bandage the wound. SPC [REDACTED] then began an IV in the Left antecubital space of SGT [REDACTED] and I instructed SPC [REDACTED] to provide direct pressure on the wound. I instructed SPC [REDACTED] to prepare an IV bag while I prepped SGT [REDACTED] right arm for an IV. I initiated an 18g IV in the Right antecubital space of SGT [REDACTED] and received the line from SPC [REDACTED]. The vein blew when I connected the bag and I initiated another IV in the same location, one vein distal. I secured the site with tape and secured SPC [REDACTED]s site also. I then instructed SPC [REDACTED] to begin cutting away SGT [REDACTED]s clothing to check for further injuries to his torso and upper body. We log rolled SGT [REDACTED] onto a litter, secured his C-spine with three aid bags, and taped his head down onto the stretcher. We removed his boots and exposed his legs for further evaluation and secured his hands and legs to the litter. Dustoff had been called and landed approximately 30 seconds after we completed primary treatment. SPC [REDACTED] held direct pressure on my instruction the entire time and I briefed the dustoff medics on the neck wound and the treatment rendered. Dustoff departed moments later and I picked up SGT [REDACTED] weapon and ACH, turning said items over to the A CO TOC when we arrived back after mission completion. Nothing else follows.
