This memorandum lists the circumstances surrounding an Escalation of Force incident occurring on or about 191235. ULO5, involving elements of 1⁵ Plateon, Alpha Company, 4th Baltalion, 84th Armor Regiment resulting in one local national KIA: and one local national WIA, in Baghdad, Iraq.

On or about 191235JUL05, two M1114s (bumper numbers A11 and A12) from 1st Platons, Alpha

2. FACTS:

Company, 4th Battalion, 64th Armor Regiment, were traveling from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Exercise), to the Hotel (Exercise), in order to change guards or observation posts (GP) atop the buildings. While traveling sastbound on Exercise (vic. Hotel 9 . In order to change quards on permanent mute the unit frequently travels, a large volume of traffic formed to the front of the convoy (approximately 40 vehicles), at the intersection of the Road and the Street. The lead M1114 (A12) stopped short of the traffic, approximately 35 maters the traff M1114 (A12) stopped approximately 15-20 maters behind A12, and the rest of the traffic, on the Road remained approximately 100-150 maters behind A11. While the convoy was stopped, a white 1961 Toyota Gorella (older, lead-looking male driving in the vabicle, furned right from an apartment complex parking lot behind the convoy. The vehicle then, traveled around traffic, and approached A11 from the rear, in the left lane (which was open) grassing all the cars which were stopped behind the convoy. Once the vehicle passed which was open a property of the passed which was provided by the stopped weblicles, traveling approximately 25-30 mph. The glinner in the rear M1114 (PFC began to should the white vehicle loud enough for the passengers in the M1114 to hear him, and use hand and arm signals in attempts to stop the vehicle. The vehicle continued to approach the convoy, not appearing to slow down. Once the vehicle was approximately stricted meters behind the convoy, PPC pointed the M2408 machine gun, mounted on ATT at the approaching vehicle, not making an silentatio preme areapon. Pro also had his individual weapon, a M249, in the vehicle. The vehicle appeared to maintain a constant speed, continuing to approach the convoy. When the vehicle was approximately 40 to 50 meters away, PFC seems fired a 3-5 round burst into the ground in front of the vehicle from the M2408. The vehicle did not appear to alternot to stop. Approximately 2-5 seconds teter. When the approaching values was about 20 to 25 meters away, PEC (1986) fired a second burst of approximately 5-10 rounds into the humper of the vehicle, walking the way up the hood, into the driverside windshield, striking the driver multiple times in the head, chest, and arm. PFC states stated he believed the vehicle behind them was a Vehicle Born Improvised Explosive Device (VBIED), and it was continuing to approach. The lead M1114 moved approximately 15 meters forward, and the trail M1114 moved up to approximately 2 to 3 meters behind

the lead. The suspect vehicle continued to roll forward, coming to rest at the rear right-hand side of AT1.

PFC ensuring his convoy's safe, used each step in the escalation of force. He stated that he took upon his own accord fring the warning and disabling shots towards the oncoming vehicle. However, the choice of weapons to fire was an issue. PFC M240B Machine Gun, mounted on the Juriet of the M1114 and had his Individual weapon, a M249 Squad Automatic type appointed so with him and the Justie Loug to the large volume of traffic to the convoy's front and fear the use of eather weapon could cause excess collateral damage in the AO. By using the M240B, disabled the potential threat, but also injured and partially damaged an innocent bystander's Wehice while he was waiting in traffic. 4) Using the proper Escalation of Force is the most important key for vehicle guinners to know and understand. PFC **terms** stated during his interview, warning shots are fired into the ground in Iront of the weblicle, in order to minimize collateral damage, while also ensuring the driver is able to see and hear the rounds fired. When interviewing PFC (lead vehicle's gunner), he stated warning shots are fired into the air, not the ground. By firing warning shots into the air, specifically into a highly dense area; as an otreet, excess damages and more injures could occur. Even though, PFC was yelling and fired warning shots in front of the webiole, the driver of the white car may not have heard anything, because when the IPs removed the victim from his car, a hearing aid fell off the driver into the Gar (Enclosure G, 🗪 5) The investigating officer has interviewed all necessary individuals involved and has determined although the result of the incident was tragic, PFC acted in accordance with the correct Rules of Engagement, in effect, and used proper judgment in eliminating the potential threat. However, his decision in choice of weapons is questionable, if he had used the M249 (his individual weapon) due to the highly dense area of traffic, collateral damage could have been minimized. 4. RECOMMENDATIONS: A. In view of all the evidence presented, PFC and all other individuals' actions were assignatified and in accordance with the MNS I-ROE, and no adverse action should result of this investigation. However, a few training and equipment issues must be addressed. BasWhile interviewing all secessary administratively although each soldier's understanding in the second sol the use of Escalation of Force (EOF) stem from a similar basis, each soldier gave a variation of EOF. Unit commanders need to reemphasize the use of EOF, and train soldiers on when and where warning shots are fired, and how to properly eliminate a threat, while still attempting to minimize collateral damage. Soldiers must remain cognizant of their surroundings and understand the consequences of stray rounds. G. Even though PFC could have minimized the damage on the bystander's vehicle by using the M249, versus the M240B, gunners should have a M16/M4 readily available in order to fire needed warning shots. The M240B and M249, machine guns have a rapid rate of fire, and soldiers can assidentally fire excess rounds, causing additional damage not required. Commanders should review their weapon distribution plan and consider issuing rifles to gunners, instead of M2A9s. 
