SECTION IV - FINDINGS (para 3-10, AR 15-6)

The (investigating officer) (board), having carefully considered the evidence, finds:

BLUF: On 04 Oct 2005, a patrol from C/4-64 AR engaged a local national's Black Opel with both warning and disabling shots, which resulted, in one local national being wounded and another killed.

On the morning of 4 October, 2005, a patrol from C/4-64 departed Fob Falcon at 0819. This patrol consisted of four M2 Bradley Fighting Vehicles, twenty-six soldiers and an interpreter. The patrol's assigned mission number was #4851 (see exhibit 2). Patrol 4851 had a task of route interdiction and the establishment of flash traffic control points (TCP) (see exhibit 1, 9). The patrol's designated route included Route [REDACTED], Route [REDACTED] and Route [REDACTED].

The patrol had established a flash TCP at [REDACTED]. Traffic on Route [REDACTED] (at the flash TCP) began to back-up due to detailed vehicle inspections. At approximately 1125 a.m. the stationary patrol observed a Black Opel break rank, conduct a U-turn, and speed away - northbound on Route [REDACTED] (see exhibit 1, 9).

SSG [REDACTED] directed SSG [REDACTED] to pursue the evading Black Opel. Because of its small size and maneuverability, the Black Opel was able to increase the distance between the pursuing Bradley. As the Black Opel encroached onto [REDACTED], it [the Black Opel] made another suspicious U-turn. The Black Opel was once again southbound on Route [REDACTED]. SSG [REDACTED] northbound Bradley made visual contact with the Black Opel. SSG [REDACTED] fired three-warning shots from M4 to get the evasive vehicle to stop (see exhibit 5). A passenger riding in the back seat (right rear) brandished an AK-47 from the right rear window of the Black Opel (see exhibit 5). Fearing for their safety, SSG [REDACTED] directed SPC [REDACTED] to engage the Black Opel with the coax.

SPC [REDACTED] fired two burst from the gunner's coax. The Black Opel came to a stop just east of the barricaded road at [REDACTED] (see exhibit 9). The driver and left-rear passenger exited the Black Opel and ran to a series of buildings east of the barricaded road (see exhibits 5, 6). SSG [REDACTED] pursued the fleeing vehicle occupants (dismounted - by himself) for approximately seventy five meters (see exhibit #5, 7). SSG [REDACTED] lost sight of the fleeing vehicle occupants and terminated his foot pursuit.

Upon his return to the Bradley, SSG [REDACTED] observed the platoon leader, 1LT [REDACTED] had arrived and that the platoon medic was providing medical treatment for one of the remaining Black Opel passengers. Mr. [REDACTED] was wounded in the buttocks. The elderly man, Mr. [REDACTED] was KIA.

In view of the above findings, the (investigating officer) (board) recommends:

Giving pursuit to a vehicle just because the vehicle makes a U-turn, although suspicious, is not necessarily reasonable. Warning shots are not used on fleeing vehicles. The purpose for escalated force by SSG [REDACTED] is questionable. Recommend the patrol conduct vignette based training to sharpen judgement calls on "what constitutes grounds for pursuit of a vehicle. Additionally, the patrol must attempt to locate the family of the wounded/killed local nationals to offer condolence payment.

LINE 6: Summary of incident: Patrol # 4851 had a TCP set up at [REDACTED], a car moving south was waiting in line at the TCP. The car then made a U-turn and sped north toward [REDACTED], and ignored all hand signals by SSG [REDACTED]. The vehicle stopped and again turned around at [REDACTED]. The vehicle then approached the Bradley head-on, and by-passed two Jersey barriers, while trying to evade the Bradley. SSG (P) [REDACTED] fired 3 warning shots with his M-16A2, and the vehicle continued to attempt to speed away by turning down a side road. SSG (P) [REDACTED] noticed an AK-47 being pointed out of the rear right window. He then ordered his gunner (SGT [REDACTED]) to engage the car with the M240C coax machine gun; killing a 90 year old male that was in the front passenger seat and injuring an 18 year old male (buttocks wound) that was in the right side back seat. The vehicle was searched and found one AK-74 (SN # [REDACTED]) at the feet of the 18 year old passenger. The casualties were a 90 year old male (KIA) and a male 18 years (Priority) casualty. The driver and one of the rear passengers exited the vehicle and ran before SSG (P) [REDACTED] could exit the Bradley. The names of the individuals are (KIA) [REDACTED] and (WIA) [REDACTED].

On or about 1125 on the 04 OCT my section was conducting a flash TCP on [REDACTED]. SSG [REDACTED], the NCOIC on the ground, alerted me of a car turning around after seeing the TCP and racing away, refusing to go through the TCP. He proceeded north on [REDACTED] and my Bradley went in pursuit of the car. As we approached the bend at the northern part of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] the vehicle slowed down. The vehicle turned around towards us then speed down a narrow dirt path, avoiding 2 concrete blocks. As the vehicle was turning on to no name road I saw what looked to be an AK-47. We then speed up to stop the vehicle and I shot a warning shot with my M4, the vehicle paid no response. As the vehicle did not respond to the warning shots and the weapon still visible, I ordered my gunner (SGT [REDACTED]) to fire at the vehicle. He fired a burst and the vehicle didn't stop, it began to turn into a town, he fired again. As we moved to the town I saw the car stopped with 2 men running away down the street. I speed down the road and lost them as they ran into a yard. I had no soldiers with me to search the house so I called 1LT [REDACTED], my platoon leader, and he brought his section up to me. After calling for backup, I jumped down off my Bradley and looked in the car. I saw the 18 year older with a wounded buttock and an AK-47 next to him. I took the man out of the car and began treating his wounds. 1LT [REDACTED] came up with his dismounts and the medic and we secured the area. The medic began treating the man with a bullet in his buttocks. 1LT [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] and the IA came to bring the wounded to the hospital and the 90 year old dead man to the morgue.

I, SGT [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On or about 1125 hrs. on 4OCT05 my platoon was conducting a flash TCP on [REDACTED]. SSG [REDACTED] was the NCOIC on the ground, and myself and SSG [REDACTED] were on our BFV pulling security for the infantry running the TCP. SSG [REDACTED] yelled to SSG [REDACTED] that a black Daewoo saw the TCP and turned around and took off in the opposite direction at a high rate of speed. We then began chasing the vehicle heading north on [REDACTED]. We finally got close to them before the bend in the road where it appeared the car was stopping for us. The vehicle once stopped noticed the Iraqi checkpoint and decided to avoid it driving back towards us and east onto no name road, avoiding two concrete barriers to get down the road. At that time, SSG [REDACTED] told me that he saw what appeared to be an AK-47 pointing out of a window. This is when SSG [REDACTED] began firing several warning shots to get the car to stop. The car ignored the warning shots and continued at a high rate of speed. He then gave me the order to fire on the car with the coax. And fire I did. I fired a burst and the vehicle remained in motion; so I fired another burst into the vehicle. At the same time they were making a left turn into the village where the car came to an immediate halt. When we came around the corner we noticed two people fleeing from the car. SSG [REDACTED] attempted to locate the two men, but could not. After returning from his foot pursuit, he began giving first aid to the wounded individuals while I remained on the vehicle pulling security. I called on the radio for the rest of the platoon to come to our location and secure the sector.

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

I, [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On the 4th of October my platoon was conducting flash tactical check points (TCP) to suppress enemy movement to the International Zone. At approximately 1100, my platoon sergeant (SSG [REDACTED]) and his section split from the platoon to set up TCP's on [REDACTED]. After about a half and hour I heard shots in the distance and radioed SSG [REDACTED]. SGT [REDACTED] (SSG [REDACTED] gunner) said that he had perused a vehicle that had run away from the TCP with a weapon and wounded some Iraqi's. My section then went to aid the situation. As I pulled up to SSG [REDACTED] he and the platoon medic were treating the wounded man who had suffered a shot in the buttock and hand. I immediately called [REDACTED] to get a medivac and update them on the situation at hand. I then pulled SSG [REDACTED] aside to find out information on what happened. SSG [REDACTED] then went on to tell me that a vehicle turned around trying to avoid the TCP and he chased him. The vehicle was racing away from SSG [REDACTED] but forced to slow up as it hit [REDACTED] on [REDACTED]. This caused SSG [REDACTED] to slow down. When the vehicle saw the CP it turned around and drove towards the Bradley but instead of stopping the vehicle drove by 2 concrete barriers down no name road. SSG [REDACTED] saw an AK-47 out the window as they drove by and fired a warning shot with his M4 for the vehicle to stop. The vehicle didn't even hesitate and kept barreling down the narrow dirt road. He again fired a warning shot and no response again. As he saw the AK-47 sticking out the window he ordered his gunner (SGT [REDACTED]) to fire at the vehicle. The vehicle then took another left into a small village and stopped. As SSG [REDACTED] approached the turn he saw the 2 other passengers running away. SSG [REDACTED] followed the men on foot for about 75 meters and lost them. SGT [REDACTED] then called me to update me on the situation and we moved up. SSG [REDACTED] then went back to the car and began treating the wounded. After my discussion with SSG [REDACTED] I went back to see the wounded who doc was handling. I then went to the vehicle to find out that there was an AK-47 with a loaded magazine in the back seat of the car. SGT [REDACTED] had searched the vehicle finding the loaded AK-47 on fire. After this Warlord and his IA's took the wounded man to the hospital and the dead man to the morgue. I then informed [REDACTED] on what happened again.



[REDACTED] WE RESPONDED TO THE SCENE OF A SHOOTING INCIDENT INVOLVING BRADLEY B-14, AND A BLACK DAEWOO 4 DOOR, BLACK IN COLOR, WITH ONE PASSENGER IN THE FRONT RIGHT SEAT AND ANOTHER MALE IRAQI NATIONAL LYING ON THE GROUND APPROX 30 FT AWAY FROM THE VEHICLE.
