SECTION IV - FINDINGS (para 3-10, AR 15-6)

The (investigating officer) (board), having carefully considered the evidence, finds:

On 14 October 2005 at approximately 1610, Rock Blue platoon arrived at [REDACTED] School [REDACTED], to conduct a polling site assessment. The three M114s were positioned 30 meters apart with 100-200 meters of visual standoff range to the front and rear of the patrol (Exhibits A,C). At 1640, SFC [REDACTED] the platoon sergeant, just completed handing out concertina wire to the polling site guards when he heard several shots fired by one of his HMMWVs (Exhibit C). Three vehicles were speeding towards the patrol when the lead vehicle in the patrol began to use visual signals in an attempt to have them reduce their speed or stop (Exhibit D,E,F). The lead vehicle in the patrol A35, driven by SGT [REDACTED] with PFC [REDACTED] as gunner, initially fired 3-5 warning shots at the blue car when it came within 75-100 meters of the patrol (Exhibit C,F). The blue car continued to approach the convoy when PFC [REDACTED] proceeded to engage it with 10-15 rounds into its hood and grill. After being engaged the blue car stopped moving. The green car, which was the second vehicle, swerved around the blue car and was subsequently engaged with 10-15 rounds for coming too close to the patrol (Exhibit C). The green car began to spin out of control after being engaged finally coming to rest approximately 75 meters away. The last car in the speeding convoy, a gray car, witnessed what occurred and immediately stopped and drove away from the area. After the vehicles came to a stop, SFC [REDACTED] immediately secured the site and conducted a search of the vehicles. The driver of the blue car was wounded in the head. The platoon rendered aid and evacuated the man to FOB [REDACTED] in A15. The driver of the green car was fatally wounded in the head. When SFC [REDACTED] realized the man was dead he did not touch anything else in the vehicle and reported to [REDACTED] the events that had taken place. SFC [REDACTED] requested both US and IP assistance to collect the body and control a growing local national crowd. The IPs arrived at the scene within 30 minutes and took control of the body and the vehicle. Rock Blue platoon continued on to FOB [REDACTED] to link up with A15.

SECTION V - RECOMMENDATIONS (para 3-11, AR 15-6)


In view of the above findings, the (investigating officer) (board) recommends:

Rock Blue platoon properly followed the ROE. It was unfortunate that a local national was killed in the incident, but all rules were followed in accordance with the ROE. In the future, I would recommend that all platoons place a visual marker at least 50 meters in front of the patrol when they are set up in a security halt, regardless of the duration. For this case, I recommend that no disciplinary actions be taken against SFC [REDACTED], SGT [REDACTED], SGT [REDACTED] and PFC [REDACTED]. These four soldiers utilized the proper escalation of force and decisively engaged the vehicles as a last resort. I recommend that no further action is necessary.

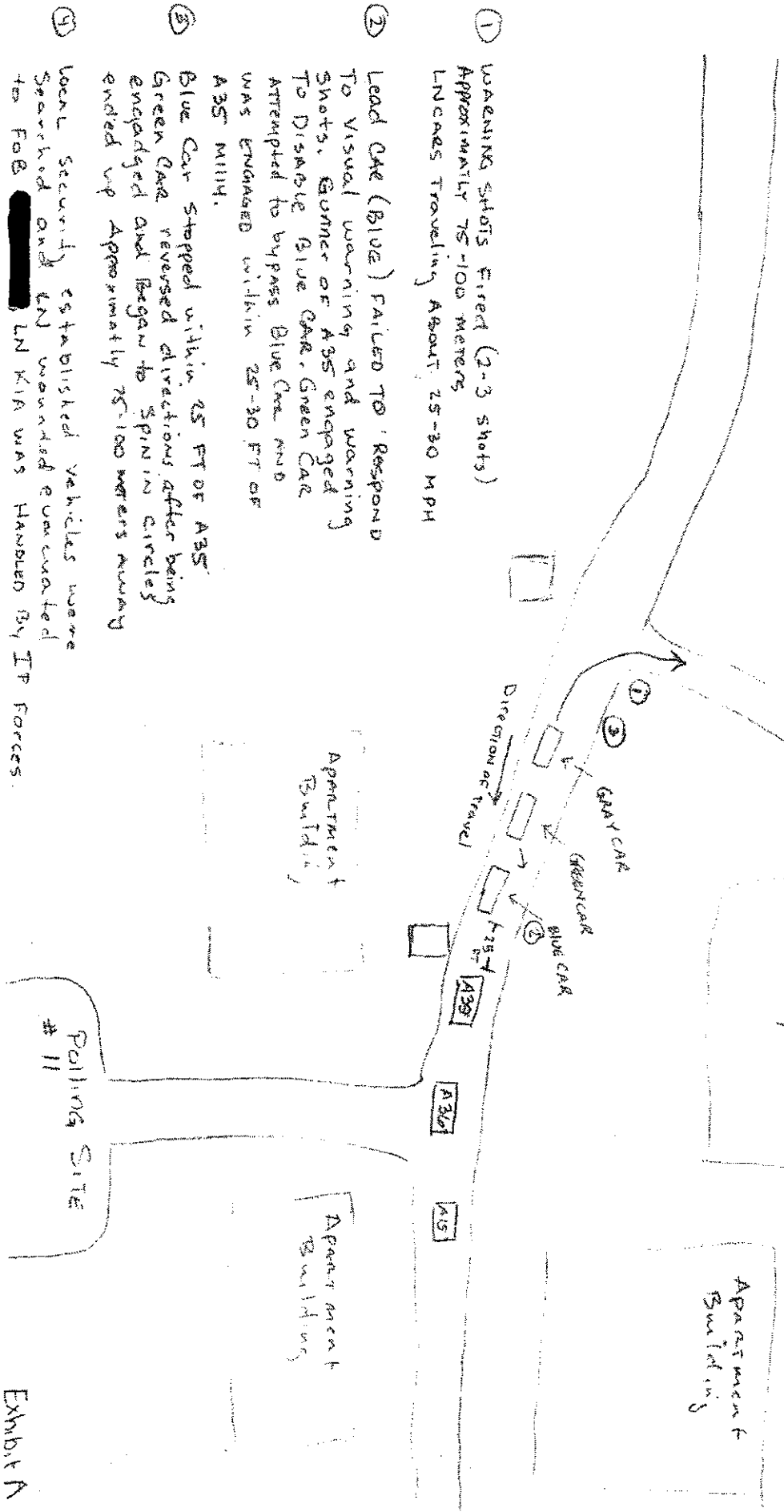

ON 14 OCTOBER 2005 AT APPROXIMATELY 1640 LOCAL TIME, WHILE CONDUCTING AN IRAQI POLLING SITE ASSESSMENT PATROL, PATROL'S 3 MILITARY VEHICLES WERE HALTED ON MAIN ROAD VICINITY [REDACTED]. TIME IN AREA HAD BEEN FOR NO MORE THAN 25-30 MINUTES. I HAD JUST COMPLETED MY DELIVERANCE OF CONCERTINA WIRE TO THE POLLING SITE GUARDS AND WAS RETURNING TO THE VEHICLE. WHEN I HEARD SEVERAL SHOTS FOLLOWED BY YELLING, I LOOKED TO THE DIRECTION OF THE COMOTION AND SAW THE BLUE CAR FOLLOWED BY TWO OTHER VEHICLES MOVING AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED DIRECTLY TOWARDS MY LEAD VEHICLE A35. THE GUNNER ON A35, PFC [REDACTED] HELD HIS FIRE UNTIL APPROXIMATELY 25-30 FEET IN FRONT OF HIM. HE ENGAGED THE BLUE CAR INTO THE HOOD AND GRILL. THE BLUE CAR THEN STOPPED. THE GREEN CAR DIRECTLY BEHIND ATTEMPTED TO SWERVE AROUND AND WAS ENGAGED. APPROXIMATELY 25-30 ROUNDS WERE FIRED IN ALL. THE GREEN CAR AFTER BEING HIT REVERSED DIRECTIONS AND STARTED TO DO CIRCLES UNTIL IT CAME TO REST APPROXIMATELY 75-METERS AWAY. On October 14, 2005, 3rd platoon Aco 1/64 conducted a recon of the polling sites in Zone 14 E. On 14 Oct 05, the recon was almost complete when two civilian vehicles came on us from the west at a high rate of speed. A 35 was the lead car. Sgt [REDACTED] was driving and [REDACTED] was the observer. The two civilian cars did not respond to warning shots, after which we used our 5.56mm rifles. At about 1620, PFC [REDACTED] had no choice but to engage both vehicles. The result was one civilian killed and one civilian wounded. Sgt [REDACTED] put the 35 in the rear of the civilian cars ended up about 10 meters from us. [REDACTED] nothing else followed. [REDACTED]
