Basis for Investigation: About 1300, 29 Apr 04, this office was notified by 22nd Military Police (MP) Battalion (BN), Baghdad, IZ of an alleged detainee abuse of Ms. NFI). Ms. 764, 1564 1ê4 100H R4,64. reported she was arrested from her residence and transported via helicopter to an unknown interrogation center. She was detained for approximately 5 days. During her detention, she was abused, which resulted in two broken fingers, black eye and made to crawl around on all-fours as a "large man rode" on her, calling her an animal. Ms. \mathcal{H}_{1} by \mathcal{H}_{1} escribed the unknown subjects as 1) a fat white male, approximately 6'3", 125 kilos, 30 years old, black hair, brown eyes, who spoke Arabic (NFI). The second subject was described as a white female, 25 year old, blond hair, who did not speak Arabic (NFI). Both subjects wore military uniforms with name patches (NFI). Ms. 1641664 also received a receipt for property seized and damaged at the time of her arrest. The receipt indicated \$3,600.00 (7,550,000.00 Iraqi Dinars) and jewelry were seized and the doors and windows of her residence, which entitled her to compensation. The receipt also stated she could retrieve her property after 14 Oct 03.

About 1240, 5 May 04, SA 16-1 pw-1 and SA 16-1 160! I interviewed Ms. 764, 1764 with 1LT 700 mb 3 Major Crime Unit (MCU), Iraqi Police Department, Baghdad, IZ serving as the interpreter. Ms. 764. 164 she was taken from her home around 0000, 11 Aug 03. She related she took some valum and other medications and went to bed. She was woken by glass breaking near her bed and she noticed ten individuals on her roof and another twenty individuals in the residence. She tried to tell them she was a friend, but they did not understand her. She related the individuals searched her house and used dogs during the search. One individual asked her for money and she gave him \$60.00, which she receives monthly for retirement, and he placed it in his pocket. She also gave the individuals 500,000 Dinar she still had left from 1,000,000 Dinar she received when her husband died. She further related the individuals took five rings off her hand. The individuals were wearing desert camouflage and had American flags on their arm, but she could not further identify the individuals. Ms. 767 1 related a man explained to her they were looking for her son and her husband and she told him they were both deceased. She was then told they were going to bring her to the "CIA" and placed a bag on her head and tightened the ropes and then placed her in a vehicle. She was in the vehicle for approximately ten minutes and was transferred to a helicopter, which flew for around twenty minutes. She was then taken off the helicopter and escorted to an unknown building where her hands were placed behind her back and handcuffed, the bag was removed from her head, and she was placed in a corner of the room. She was then placed in a one meter by two meter bathroom for approximately five days and was given no food or water. Ms. 7¢ 4 Rike Flated during this time other detainees were brought in to her room and asked to identify her, which they could not. She stated she begged for food or water and was given nothing. After five days, they placed a bag on her head and placed her in a vehicle for an unknown time. When she was removed from the vehicle the bag was removed from her head and she saw a man wearing a brown t-shirt. She described the man as about 2001bs, 78" tall.

Caucasian, clean shaven, black hair, and spoke some Arabic. The man took her to a room where there was a man in white robes being questioned. The man was then disrobed and asked to identify Ms. 784 which he could not. She was then taken to a long room and the tall man poured water on the floor in the room. The tall man instructed her to swim on the floor from one side to the other, turned music on really loud, and left the room. Ms. 74/964stated there was an interpreter in the room she could only describe as a male Lebanese. She related while she was on the ground the interpreter asked her questions about the location of military leaders and troop movements. She stated she was on the floor for about two hours. The tall man then returned and was upset because she was not swimming and stepped on her hand and applied pressure. He then stood her up and placed a bag on her head and told her to walk back and forth in the room. As she walked, the man pushed things in her way and made her fall several times. The man then removed the bag from her head and forced her on the ground on her stomach. He straddled her and placed ropes in her mouth and across her eyes and attempted to ride her like a horse. Ms. 724/664 related the tall man had a stick at this time and was striking her with it in the buttocks. She further stated he placed the stick in her anus while she was on the ground. Ms. 7641664 stated she heard laughing from within the room during these incidents. She described the room as large with cables and ropes on the walls and a metal bed frame located in the room. She also saw what she believed were electric cables. After the tall man assaulted her, she requested a doctor because she could not walk. The doctor treated her injuries and was accompanied by three other individuals she could not identify. Ms. 2007 104 704/bb4 ted she was in this unknown location for about five days and this type of treatment occurred daily while she was there. She stated the tall man would touch her in her private areas and tell her he liked to have sex with old women. She noticed a Caucasian female with blond hair and blue eyes and wore a desert camouflage uniform with an American flag was present during some of the abuse. Ms. 704/664 stated she was removed from this location when she was placed in a helicopter and moved to another unknown location. She was taken into a room with a desk and asked questions about her life and she related she was a schoolteacher. She related she was given a polygraph in reference to her history and they told her she was telling the truth. Ms. 104/1664 ated about 0300 the same night the tall man from the previous location came to her room and moved her to a room with two other Iraqi women. The women were sisters of a high leader in the Ba'ath party known as $7^{\prime\prime} \approx 6^{\prime\prime}$ The tall man then released a dog in the room and the dog attacked one of the other Iraqi women. The tall man then took Ms. 1641164 way and placed her in a room with 163 bb3 າເປັນ ອາnd asked to identify him. She stated he was a famous man always on the television. Mr. ルショから 3 was then asked to identify Ms. アペッカ64 which he could not. Ms. 704, 164 related she was placed back in her room and stayed there for approximately ten days and then placed on a bus with ten other women and taken to AL-SALHEI Police Station, Baghdad, IZ and released. Ms. 1764, 1964 stated she was never reimbursed for the damage caused during her apprehension and she never received her property or identification cards, which were seized. She related she was familiar with Ms. 70 4 1 1964 Pecial Envoy

About 1400, 5 May 04, SA 7C1, E61 pordinated with 1LT 70 50 50 50 who stated he would retrieve Ms. 70 H 130 4 medical records, which documented her treatment upon being released from apprehension and provide it to this office. 1LT 70 160 3 covided documentation he received from the British Military Police located in the Coalition Provisional Authority (CPA), Baghdad, IZ.

About 1530, 5 May 04, SA 701/1001 and SA 701, 1001 eviewed documents which revealed photographs of Ms. 704/1504 esidence, a copy of Ms. 704/1504 capture tag with serial number and listed her as 703, 603 ith a handwritten number above as A15134; a claims form describing the apprehension and amount owed to Ms. 704/1004 as \$3,600.00; DA Form 4137, which could not be read; DA From 4137 seizing 22848 Iraqi Dinar with a sequence number as from HHC, 115th MP BN, Camp Cropper. (See documents and photographs for details)

About 1500, 13 May 04, SA 121 be/ seeived information pertaining to Ms. 124, 1064 detention at Camp Cropper from LTC 125, 1665 Deputy Commander, 89th MP BDE, Victory Base. The information contained various biographical data and apprehension information, which confirmed the information on her capture tag. The information listed the unit of capture as TF20 and was in processed into Camp Cropper on 20 Aug 03. (See e-mail for details)

About 0900, 14 May 04, SA 701 1061 received copies of documents which pertain to Ms. 1041 1069 's detention at Camp Cropper. The documents consisted of a DA From 4137, which listed the receiving activity as HHC, 115th MP BN; data base form listing Ms 724, 1664 DD Form 2708, Receipt for Inmate or Detained Person. (See documents for details)

About 1000, 14 May 04, SA 701, bbl/ viewed the provided documents which reflected Ms. 704, bbl/ was received from TF20 by 115th MP BN on 20 Aug 03. Listed her inmate name as She was released to 770th MP Co on 27 Aug 03 with nine other detainees. The DA Form 4137 provided listed property taken on 20 Aug 03 by SPC 115th MP BN (NFI) and then listed SPC 103, bb 3, HHC, 115th MP BN, releasing the property to an unidentifiable signature on 27 Aug 03. No rings or cash was listed on the DA Form 4137.

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED MS. TO WAS APPREHENDED ON 11 AUG 03 AND DETAINED AT AN UNKNOWN LOCATION. WHEN MS. 704,564 VAS APPREHENDED, SHE ALLEGED THE INDIVIDUALS CONFISCATED HER MONEY AND JEWLERLY AND HAS NOT RETURNED IT. FURTHER INVESTIGATION REVEALED MS. TO SELECT WAS ANALY SODOMIZED, IDECENTLY ASSUALTED, AND PHYSICALLY ASSAULTED WHILE SHE WAS DETAINED AT THE UNKNOWN LOCATION BY AN UNKNOWN WHITE MALE.

ON 5 MAY 04, MS. 70 MAS INTERVIEWED AND STATED SHE WAS APPREHENDED BY COALITION FORCES SHE BELIEVED TO BE AMERICANS AND DURING THE APPREHENSION THE INDIVIDUALS CONFISCATED HER MONEY AND JEWELRY AND HAS NOT RETURNED HER MONEY OR PROPERTY. MS. 74,64 F FURTHER STATED SHE WAS MISTREATED BY HER CAPTORS WHEN THEY DEPRIVED HER OF FOOD AND WATER FOR A FIVE DAY PERIOD, AND AN UNKNOWN MALE PHYSICALLY ABUSED HER ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS, ANALY SODOMIZED, AND INDECENTLY ASSAULTED HER.

EFFORTS ARE ON GOING TO VERIFY THE LOCATION MS. 764, 66 4 WAS DETAINED, AND THE STATUS OF HER REFUND. FURTHER EFFORTS ARE ON GOING TO LOCATE, IDENTIFY, AND INTERVIEW INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN THE APPREHENSION AND DETENTION OF MS. 764, 664

INVESTIGATION CONTINUES BY USACIDC.

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



My HVD staff is doing all they can to find anything and everything related to this case. We have found a record of her being held at the Camp Cropper Corps Holding Area. We are searching through stacks of documents in an attempt to find her belongings.

There is no one at the HVD who has any knowledge of the 115th MP Bn. They are long gone. In fact, no one at the HVD has been there longer than early February 2004.

Let me finish conducting our data call and search for her property then we can discuss the circumstances under which you might need access to the HVD.

Whoever took her statement did not do such a great job of having her express her thought to assist in determining where her alleged abuse took place. If the doctor actually treated her, then there should be medical records. If her claim of abuse actually occurred, then I suspect it occurred where she was taken captive and not necessarily at the Camp Cropper HVD. I'm running the gates to determine if the Camp Cropper she refers to is the same as we're using for the HVD.

Expect to have closure on our data search and the whereabouts of her belongings within a day or so. I'll contact you then.
