[Redacted] When asked what [Redacted] he himself understood [Redacted] stated that even though he can conduct basic conversations in [Redacted] he is unable to read it. When asked why he spends so much time with [Redacted] Koran in his cell, [Redacted] responded that he essentially is just looking at the words but is unable to comprehend them. [Redacted] said he was not familiar himself with the content of the Koran other than what he had been told by others. Additionally, [Redacted] did not know the Koran has been published in [Redacted] English and several other languages. When asked if he would like to receive a copy of the Koran in [Redacted] [Redacted] became excited at the possibility

[Redacted] said he did not know him personally, but was aware of his case because it had garnered so much media attention. [Redacted] said he was not familiar with Ramzi Yousef.
