Once the Watch receives an alert message on a subject vehicle, the Watch Officer will view the license plate image and confirm the number and state. Upon confirmation, the law enforcement officer who placed the alert will immediately be contacted and provided with the location, direction of travel, and corresponding LEA point of contact information. Subsequently, the Case Agent/Requesting Officer can coordinate enforcement activities.
