Sorry I wasn't able to respond sooner, it was a busy day. Here is the response to the two items.

1. I met with our legal advisor late today and we have come to agreement on the final draft of the partner agency agreement. I am planning on sending it to [REDACTED] to get his review to make sure that we did not cut out too much from the original draft. If it looks good then I will be sharing it with the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office for their review and signature.
2. We had our governing board meeting and as I suspected we will not be participating in the eGuardian push. We will continue to share SAR reporting tied to terrorism directly with our Minneapolis FBI office and the JTTF and will input qualifying SARs to the NSI Shared Space. The board recognized the sensitivity in our state to direct input in federal data systems of Minnesota law enforcement data as illustrated in the struggle going on currently with participation in NDEX and this is not an appropriate time to go beyond our original promise for NSI participation.

I think that is it for now. Searching the shared space and inputting qualifying SARs is part of our regular operations. We are continuing to promote the Line Officer Training and we anticipate further additions to our stats this month. Hope that you had a good holiday too, we survived but recuperation took place the weekend after. Let me know if you have any questions.

1. Status of extending opportunity to your partnering agencies for direct access to the shared spaces portal
2. eGuardian push issue:

December 20, 2011 - We are not in a position right now to support the eGuardian push. This is a policy issue for our fusion center and is a potential change in how we sold the concept to both our governing board and our

privacy committee. I have a governing board meeting this afternoon where one of the items on the agenda is this issue. I am not at all convinced that we will be participating in this initiative. I will know more after today's meeting.

Your NSI Team Dashboard stats always look very good. Please know that it is beneficial to the NSI program to continue to load SAR's to the shared spaces, to continue to query the shared spaces portal as a matter of routine indices checks and to encourage the viewing of the Line Officer Video and report training stats through the NSI website at <http://nsi.ncirc.gov/>.
