b7F -1	[Redacted] explained how the term khawaraje came from early Islamic tradition. [Redacted] the Taliban are not khawaraje, the khawaraje are Arab fanatics. Some of the Arabs in Camp Delta are khawaraje [Redacted] is not sure who they are. [Redacted] will advise U.S. officials if he is 100% sure that certain persons are khawaraje. According to [Redacted] God and the Prophet Mohammad do not like the khawaraje.		
	The Camp Delta detainee uprising which occurred on or about 19-20 July 2002, was started when one detainee claimed that a guard dropped a Koran. In actuality the detainee dropped the Koran and then blamed the guard. Many other detainees reacted to this claim and this initiated the uprising.
