




11. (U//<del>FOUO)</del>-When adjudicating, if you come across a (b) (3) (A) that was not available when the analyst originally submitted the targeting, you can update the foreignness. However, ensure that you copy and paste the original foreignness that was used into the (b) (3) (A) field.



Also, if you as the adjudicator want to update or change the foreignness in any way please be sure to discuss with the targeting analyst to ensure that you both are on the same page. Especially if you are not familiar with the target. The analyst may have used that specific foreignness explanation for a reason and you need to understand what they were thinking when they constructed the explanation. If you do change the foreignness please ensure that you copy and paste the original foreignness that was used into the field as in the example above.
