* More thoughts on Maqaleh v. Gates

Having read through the opinion in more detail, I want to clarify a few things and to highlight a few additional points.

1. Maqaleh extends habeas only to non-Afghan detainees captured outside Afghanistan who are then brought to Bagram. The decision turns on factors that are specific to Bagram and the detention review procedures used there, and hence does not directly control the result for detentions in other contexts.

2. The decision emphasizes that the result might have differed had there been a more robust detention screening process (though it is worth bearing in mind that the combination of CSRT plus DTA review was deemed inadequate as to GTMO, so presumably this would not simply be a matter of adopting the CSRT rules alone at Bagram). Notably, Judge Bates states that his is not deciding that this subset of Bagram detainees ought to have access to counsel.

3. The opinion emphasizes that the right to habeas review need not attach immediately, but rather only after a reasonable period.

4. As to the one Afghan petition in this set, Judge Bates did not actually grant the government's motion to dismiss, even though he did conclude that Boumediene did not apply to him. Instead, Judge Bates called for further briefing on the argument that the jurisdiction-stripping language of the Military Commissions Act might "usurp Article III authority" in violation of United States v. Klein, an 1871 decision holding that Congress may not "prescribe rules of decision to the Judicial Department of the government in cases pending before it." So watch for more action on this topic, possibly

under the caption *Wazir v. Gates* (No. 06-1697).

5. Geography and the problem of national boundaries in the context of transnational conflicts: because the opinion places considerable weight on geography insofar as it suggests that habeas might not apply for persons captured in Afghanistan and then held at Bagram, the question arises whether and how any such zone of exemption ought to be defined with reference to the Afghan/Pakistan border region. This could be a point to watch for in other cases.
