The Motion to Compel did not request oral argument and was not filed with a 23 motion to expedite. At approximately 4:30 p.m., PST, on Friday, January 20, 2017, 24 Defendants filed a Motion to Expedite (ECF No. 56), seeking expedited consideration of 25 the Motion to Compel and seeking oral argument on the Motion to Compel. Generally, absent good cause for a later filing, a motion to expedite should be filed on the same date 27

as the substantive motion.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Motion to Expedite (ECF No. 56) is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**.
- 2. The Government shall file a Response to the Motion to Compel (ECF No. 54) no later than **January 31, 2017**.
 - 3. Defendants' Reply brief, if any, shall be filed no later than **February 6, 2017**.
- 4. The court will hear telephonic oral argument on the Motion to Compel on **February 14, 2017, at 10:00 a.m., PST.** The court's judicial assistant will contact the parties to provide call-in instructions and to obtain the name of lead counsel for the call.

IT IS SO ORDERED. The Clerk is hereby directed to enter this Order and furnish copies to counsel.
