BDO Targeted Conversation

- BDO (BTC) Targeted Conversation focuses on training targeted questioning and identification to assist in identifying high risk individuals.
- BTC Proof of Concept (PoC) began March 5, 2014 and will end approximately April 28, 2014 at which time TSA will evaluate results and future plans.
 - BTC is derived from current casual conversation protocols: (b)(3):49 U.S.C. § 114(r)

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- Increases BDO engagement opportunities and affords the BDOs a way to maintain proficiency in areas of engagement, active listening and questioning techniques.
- Focuses on the traveling public and airport employees by conducting plays at the screening checkpoint (TDC location) and direct access points (DAP).
- Strengthens the FSD's airport security posture by conducting targeted conversation on passengers and airport employees, therefore introducing an additional layer of security.
- Puts greater emphasis on passenger engagement and verbal cues than traditional SPOT operations.
- Questions are presented in a customer-friendly manner and not confrontational



BDO Targeted Conversation

- As of March 19th approximately 873 passengers and 289 employees have been through the BTC process
- BTC has been actively conducted at the checkpoint approximately a total of 43.25 hours at the checkpoint and approximately 13.75 hours at the DAP
- BDOs received 3 compliments from passengers in regards to their professionalism during BTC. Additionally, 1 passenger filled out a comment card noting courtesy and efficiency of the BTC process
- Next Steps:
 - OSC will test proof of concept; Measures include:
 - Process Time
 - Throughput
 - BTC Interaction
 - Effectiveness
 - BDO Feedback
 - Assessment results will provide metrics to inform BTC deployment decisions



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
