Dear Secretary of State Rice:

As counsel for Mr. Khaled El-Masri, a German citizen who was "rendered" by agents of the United States from Macedonia to a CIA-controlled prison in Afghanistan, we write to seek clarification regarding statements that you reportedly made to German Chancellor Angela Merkel regarding Mr. El-Masri's case.

It has been widely reported that during a meeting with Chancellor Merkel on December 6, 2005, you acknowledged that Mr. El-Masri's seizure and detention had been a mistake. Thereafter, U.S. officials are reported to have insisted that you never made such an admission. Today, in a news conference, Chancellor Merkel reaffirmed that you did indeed discuss Mr. El-Masri's case and that you did acknowledge to her that Mr. El-Masri's "rendition" had been a mistake on the part of the CIA.

In light of the confusion that now surrounds this important issue, we write to request clarification of the following matters:

- 1. In your meeting with Chancellor Merkel, did you discuss Mr. El-Masri's case?
- 2. If you did discuss Mr. El-Masri's case, did you acknowledge that Mr. El-Masri had been in U.S. custody in Afghanistan from January until May of 2004?
- 3. If you did discuss Mr. El-Masri's case, did you acknowledge that Mr. El-Masri's "rendition" was a result of CIA errors?
- 4. Finally, did you offer the German government an official apology on behalf of the United States government for the unlawful abduction and detention of Mr. El-Masri?
