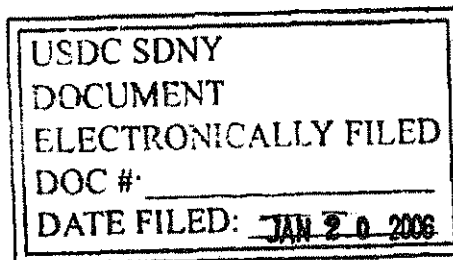


ORDER

Based on the parties' statements at the status conference held on January 17,
2006, it is hereby

ORDERED that defendant Department of State will process plaintiffs' March 16,
2005 Freedom of Information Act request and release all non-exempt documents to
plaintiffs by February 28, 2006; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that defendants Central Intelligence Agency and two
components of defendant Department of Homeland Security, the Bureau of Customs and
Border Protection and the Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services, will process
plaintiffs' March 16, 2005 Freedom of Information Act request and release all non-
exempt documents to plaintiffs by March 15, 2006; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the parties will confer and endeavor to agree on a schedule for the production of a *Vaughn* declaration from each agency, as well as a summary judgment briefing schedule, assuming there remains a dispute after defendants' document production is complete.
