DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: About 2015, 10 Jun 04, this office was notified by 391st Military Police (MP) Battalion (BN), Baghdad Central Confinement Facility (BCCF), Abu Ghraib, Iraq (AGI), that Detainee Riyadh Mohammed Abd AL RAZAK, National Detainee Reporting System (NDRS) #151729, died as a result of a cardiac arrest.

About 2035, 10 Jun 04, SA [redacted] this office, interviewed COL (DR) [redacted] 801st Combat Support Hospital (CSH), BCCF, IZ who stated Detainee #151729 was brought to the emergency room at 1915, 10 Jun 04, with no signs of life after collapsing at Bison #5. Life-saving measures were initiated but Detainee #151729 failed to regain signs of life. DR [redacted] pronounced him dead at 1957, 10 Jun 04.

About 2040, 10 Jun 04, SA [redacted] this office, and SA [redacted] viewed the deceased. There were no signs of extraordinary injury or trauma to the body and no photograph of the body were exposed.

About 0900, 11 Jun 04, SA [redacted] obtained the dossier of Detainee AL RAZAK from the 391st MP BN In processing area. (See Dossier)

About 0920, 11 Jun 04, Investigator [redacted] this office, obtained the death certificate pertaining to Detainee AL RAZAK from the 801st CSH, BCCF. (See Death Certificate)

About 0930, 11 Jun 04, Investigator [redacted] obtained the medical records pertaining to Detainee AL RAZAK. (See Medical Records)

About 1230, 11 Jun 04, SA [redacted] interviewed SGT [redacted] 391st MP BN, Bison #4 NCO, who stated she was on duty at about 1900, 10 Jun 04, when Detainee AL RAZAK was brought to the front gate of Bison #4. She stated that when the detainee was brought to the gate, the camp chief stated he was having a heart attack. She immediately called for medical aid. She observed that Detainee AL RAZAK's skin was a grayish color and he was gasping for air. She stated no pulse could be found so she started Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). She continued CPR until medical aid arrived. She stated the medics continued CPR, attempted to place an IV, and used a defibrillator on the detainee. She recalled that the detainee had previous heart problems and had arrived back from the hospital only a couple of days prior.

About 1250, 11 Jun 04, SA [redacted], with the assistance of Mr. [redacted], this office interviewed Detainee [redacted] Bison #4 Camp Chief, who stated at about 1900, 10 Jun 04, Detainee AL RAZAK was sitting in his tent, when his skin turned blue and he fell over. Detainee [redacted] and other detainees immediately brought AL RAZAK to the front gate. He said the guards and medics were giving medical aid, but he was already dead. [redacted] stated that he knew of AL RAZAK to have a previous heart condition. He said it was only

On 14 Oct 04, SA [REDACTED] received a copy of the Final Autopsy Report, #ME04-435, 22 Sep 04, which listed the cause of death as Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular Disease and the manner of death as Natural. (See Autopsy Report)

AGENT'S COMMENT: A crime scene examination was not conducted of the death scene due to officer safety concerns and operational limitations. The camp contained over 200 agitated detainees and an insufficient number of Military Police to move and guard the detainees, therefore the crime scene examination could not be conducted without placing the agents in harms way. No canvass interviews were conducted of the camp detainees. The more reliable and less hostile Camp Chief was interviewed. The remaining detainees were very hostile towards American investigators.

About 0920, 11 Jun 04, Investigator [redacted] this office, obtained the death certificate pertaining to Detainee AL RAZAK from the 801st CSH, BCCF. (See Certificate)

About 0930, 11 Jun 04, Investigator [redacted] obtained the medical records pertaining to Detainee AL RAZAK. (See Records)

About 1230, 11 Jun 04, SA [redacted] interviewed SGT [redacted] 391st MP BN, Bison #4 NCO, who stated she was on duty at about 1900, 10 Jun 04, when Detainee AL RAZAK was brought to the front gate of Bison #4. She stated that when the detainee was brought to the gate, the camp chief stated he was having a heart attack. She immediately called for medical aid. She observed that Detainee AL RAZAK's skin was a grayish color and he was gasping for air. She stated no pulse could be found so she started Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). She continued CPR until medical aid arrived. She stated the medics continued CPR, attempted to place an IV, and used a defibrillator on the detainee. She recalled that the detainee had previous heart problems and had arrived back from the hospital only a couple of days prior.

About 1250, 11 Jun 04, SA [redacted] with the assistance of Mr. [redacted] this office, interviewed Detainee [redacted] Bison #4 Camp Chief, who stated at about 1900, 10 Jun 04, Detainee AL RAZAK was sitting in his tent, when his skin turned blue and he fell over. Detainee [redacted] and other detainees immediately brought AL RAZAK to the front gate. He said the guards and medics were giving medical aid, but he was already dead. [redacted] stated that he knew of AL RAZAK to have a previous heart condition. He said it was only a couple of days since he returned from the hospital with medication for his heart. He said AL RAZAK was taking his medication.
