SUBJECT: CID Report of Investigation: 0760-03-CID259-61229

This is an "Operation Iraqi Freedom" investigation.

About 0900, 25 Nov 03, this office received notification from LTC JORDAN of an attempted murder of U.S. soldiers within the isolation area, Baghdad Correctional Facility, Abu Ghruyeb, Iraq.

Investigation established probable cause to believe Detainee AL-SHIEKH committed the offenses of Attempted Murder, Conspiracy, Unlawful Possession of a Pistol and knives when he conspired with [REDACTED] and an unknown person to have a pistol and knives brought into the prison for his use in an escape attempt. Detainee AL-SHIEKH then took the pistol and attempted to murder U.S Forces within the prison in an attempt to escape coalition custody. b7C, b6-5

Investigation further established probable cause to believe [REDACTED] committed the offenses of Conspiracy, Accessory Before the Fact, Unlawful Possession of a Pistol and Knives when they conspired with Detainee AL-SHIEKH to bring a pistol and knives into the prison to aid in Detainee AL-SHIEKH escape. b7C, b6-5

About 0900, 25 Nov 03, SA [REDACTED] was notified by LTC Steven L. JORDAN, [REDACTED] CJTF-7 (C2) b7c, b6, b5
Abu Ghryeb Prison Complex, Abu Ghryeb, Iraq, of an attempted murder of U.S. soldiers within the isolation area, Baghdad Correctional Facility, Abu Ghryeb, Iraq. b7c, b6, b2

About 1000, 25 Nov 03, SA [REDACTED] interviewed LTC JORDAN who stated approximately 1830, 24 Nov 03, he went into the area of the Baghdad Correctional Facility (BCF) that houses the high risk security detainees. LTC JORDAN was informed by SSG Ivan L. FREDERICK II, [REDACTED] 372nd Military Police Company, Cumberland, MD (deployed to Iraq) that a detainee allegedly possessed a handgun as well as two knives. Further information was provided that another detainee may also possess a knife. The gun was reported to be within cell #35. This information coincided with early reports that some security detainees may attempt a mass escape and/or target U.S. military personnel with possible support of local Iraqi Security Police (ISP) forces assigned to the BCF from the period of 18-27 Nov 03. LTC JORDAN stated he accompanied the search team to Cell #35. When the search team reached cell #35, SSG FREDERICK II and SGT William A. CATHCART, [REDACTED] 372nd Military Police Company, Cumberland, MD (deployed to Iraq) went to the right side of the cell while LTC JORDAN, SSG Robert J. ELLIOTT, [REDACTED] 372nd Military Police Company, Cumberland, MD (deployed to Iraq), and SFC Shannon K. SNIDER, [REDACTED] 372nd Military Police Company, Cumberland, MD (deployed to Iraq) remained along the left side of the cell and along the tier wall. LTC JORDAN stated they continuously repeated for the detainee to place his hands through the cell door. LTC JORDAN stated the detainee was identified as Mr. Aneed S. AL-SHIEKH, NDORS # [REDACTED] (NFI). LTC JORDAN stated Mr. AL-SHIEKH initially asked why? Then responded, "no, I refuse". Mr. AL-SHIEKH then related, "I have no gun". LTC JORDAN stated after two non-lethal rounds were chambered into the shotgun, requests were continued to have Mr. AL-SHIEKH place his hands through the door. Mr. AL-SHIEKH continued to be non-compliant and then made a sudden movement towards the upper bunk of his cell, at which time b7c, b6, b5

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SGT CATHCART yelled out the movement. Mr. AL-SHIEKH produced a pistol and fired one round through the cell door bars at the search team, striking the south wall across the tier. The search team engaged Mr. AL-SHIEKH with two non-lethal rounds, which had no effect on him. Mr. AL-SHIEKH continued to fire rounds at the search team. The search team switched from non-lethal to lethal rounds and engaged Mr. AL-SHIEKH. During the entire time they were instructing him to throw down his weapon and place his hands through the bars. Mr. AL-SHIEKH fired approximately six to seven rounds, striking the south wall at least twice as well as once hitting SGT CATHCART's protective vest. Only when Mr. AL-SHIEKH ran out of ammunition did he voluntarily throw the weapon outside his cell. Once the weapon was safe, Mr. AL-SHIEKH was subdued and removed out to the tier walkway and secured. Medical personal responded and provided first aid, pending the arrival of a MEDEVAC. LTC JORDAN stated during the search of the Mr. AL-SHIEKH's cell two large bayonet type knives were discovered hidden in two MRE cardboard containers under the upper bunk pillow area. LTC JORDAN further provided this office with a copy of the Serious Incident Report (SIR) pertaining to this incident. (See SIR for details)

About 1400, 25 Nov 03, SA [REDACTED] interviewed SSG ELLIOTT who provided a sworn statement, wherein he stated he engaged Mr. AL-SHIEKH with non-lethal and lethal rounds, after being fired on. (See Sworn Statement for details)

About 1400, 25 Nov 03, SA [REDACTED] interviewed SSG FREDERICK II who provided a sworn statement, wherein he stated he engaged Mr. AL-SHIEKH with non-lethal and lethal rounds, after being fired on. (See Sworn Statement for details)

AGENT'S COMMENT: Coordination with LTC JORDAN and the Search Team involved, revealed only the listed evidence was recovered from the crime scene. A search of the area to include the other cells met with negative results for the remaining shell casings.

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refused to be restrained. He further related he stationed himself along the western edge of the cellblock, next to the MP office area. SGT WALLIN stated he heard numerous commands from the search team for the prisoner to come forward to be restrained, and then two shotgun blasts followed by a single pistol shot. SGT WALLIN related at the sound of the pistol shot he moved further into the MP office area. He then heard three to four more pistol shots and numerous shotgun rounds being fired. SGT WALLIN stated he could not see or hear the prisoner and his attention was on the Search Team Members. He further stated one of the MP's moved into position across from Cell #35 and started firing a pistol, which he believed incapacitated the prisoner. Once the prisoner's weapons were secured, the Search Team called the medics forward to begin medical aid. SGT WALLIN stated the prisoner had one 3" contusion in the center of his chest; multiple contusions along the left torso; an apparent bullet wound in the left leg behind the knee; numerous pellet type wounds in the left foot; and the right leg was "peppered" with pellet type wounds resulting in a fracture of the leg below the knee. SGT WALLIN stated the prisoner appeared to be going into shock and was administered oxygen. His wounds were dressed and bandaged and the prisoner was subsequently evacuated to the 28th Combat Support Hospital, Baghdad, Iraq.

Once the prisoner's weapons were secured, the Search Team called the medics forward to begin medical aid. SPC ██████████ stated 67

the prisoner had one 3" contusion in the center of his chest; multiple contusions along the left torso; an apparent bullet wound in the left leg behind the knee; numerous pellet type wounds in the left foot; and the right leg was "peppered" with pellet type wounds resulting in a fracture of the leg below the knee. SPC [REDACTED] b7C stated the prisoner appeared to be going into shock and was administered oxygen and his wounds dressed and bandaged and the prisoner was subsequently evacuated to the 28th Combat Support Hospital, Baghdad, Iraq.///LAST ENTRY///

THE M.P.'S ON DUTY WERE ALSO ASSISTED BY PERSONNEL FROM MI AND MEDICS WERE STANDING BY. WE BEGAN HANDCUFFING INMATES TO THE DOOR OF THEIR CELLS BECAUSE WE DIDN'T KNOW WHO ELSE MIGHT HAVE A WEAPON. Characteristics of Scene: The Isolation area is located in the southeast corner of the Baghdad Correctional Facility. The building was white in color, metal and concrete construction. The concrete construction is reinforced with metal type rods to strength the structure to prevent escape of the house detainees. The building's primary function was to house detainee's and criminals, which were policed up during Operation Iraqi Freedom. The Isolation Area was surrounded by a fence and there was an outer perimeter wall used as to secure the entire facility. Wing 1A was located in the northeast section of the Isolation Area, and contained approximately 25 cells covering the upper and lower tiers. Cell #35 was located on the second tier approximately 1/4 of the way down the northern side of the tier.

Condition of Scene: Cell #35 was constructed on concrete type material that was reinforced with metal bars. The walls were white and tan in color. The room was approximately 9'10" long by 7'5" wide and 9'2" high. The cell contained one metal type construction bunk bed located on the east wall. The bunk bed was approximately 6' long by 2'8" wide and 4' high. The bed was flush against the east wall and 4" from the south wall and 4.5" from the north wall. The bunk bed did not contain any mattresses. There was a red in color substance, which appeared to be blood on portions of the bed. The east wall contained a hole from a suspected shotgun round. The hole was approximately 3'4" from the floor closest to the northeast corner. Located in the northeast corner of the cell was a toilet, which was built into the floor. The toilet was constructed of a ceramic type material. The toilet was not measured as it was smashed. Located in the north wall was a window, which was constructed on concrete and reinforced bars. The north wall contained numerous hole and gouge marks from suspected shotgun and bullet fragments. There was a window located approximately 8" from the northwest corner of the room. The window was approximately 4'5" from the floor. The window frame was approximately 1'7" by 3'3". The spaces in the window were approximately 3" by 8".

Located on the north wall were gouge marks, suspected to be from bullet fragments. The entry/exit way was approximately 1'10" wide by 6'5" high. The door was a metal type construction with spaces in the bars to allow detainees to place their hands through. The door had a locking mechanism on the outside and was secured with a padlock. Located to the right of the door in the southwest corner of the cell was gouge marks from suspected rounds hitting the wall. The metal frame further had gouge marks where the paint had been chipped off from the bullets striking it. The floor of the cell was concrete type construction and was covered with a dried, red in color substance suspected to be blood. The suspected blood covered the majority of the floor. The toilet in the northeast corner of the cell was shatter and pieces were spread across the floor. Adjacent to the north, east, and southwest walls were portions of the concrete, which had been chipped away from suspected gunfire.

Located on the tier opposite from Cell #35 was what appeared to be a gouge mark in the concrete. The gouge mark was located in a concrete type constructed wall with reinforced metal bars. The wall was white and tan in color and separates Cell # 41 and 42. The gouge mark was approximately 8'1" from the base of the wall and approximately 5'2" from the top corner of Cell #42's door and 7'5" from the bottom corner of Cell #42's door. The distance from the gouge to Cell #35 was approximately 18'.

Environmental Conditions: At the time of the crime scene examination, the temperature outside was approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit and approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit inside. The skies were clear and the ground and pavement were dry.

Factors Pertinent to Entry/Exit: Access to the Wing 1A could be gained from the hallway via a stairwell, which was located in the northern end of the Isolation Area. There was a metal cage door, which controlled access to Wing 1A, and a secondary door which controlled access to the upper tier.

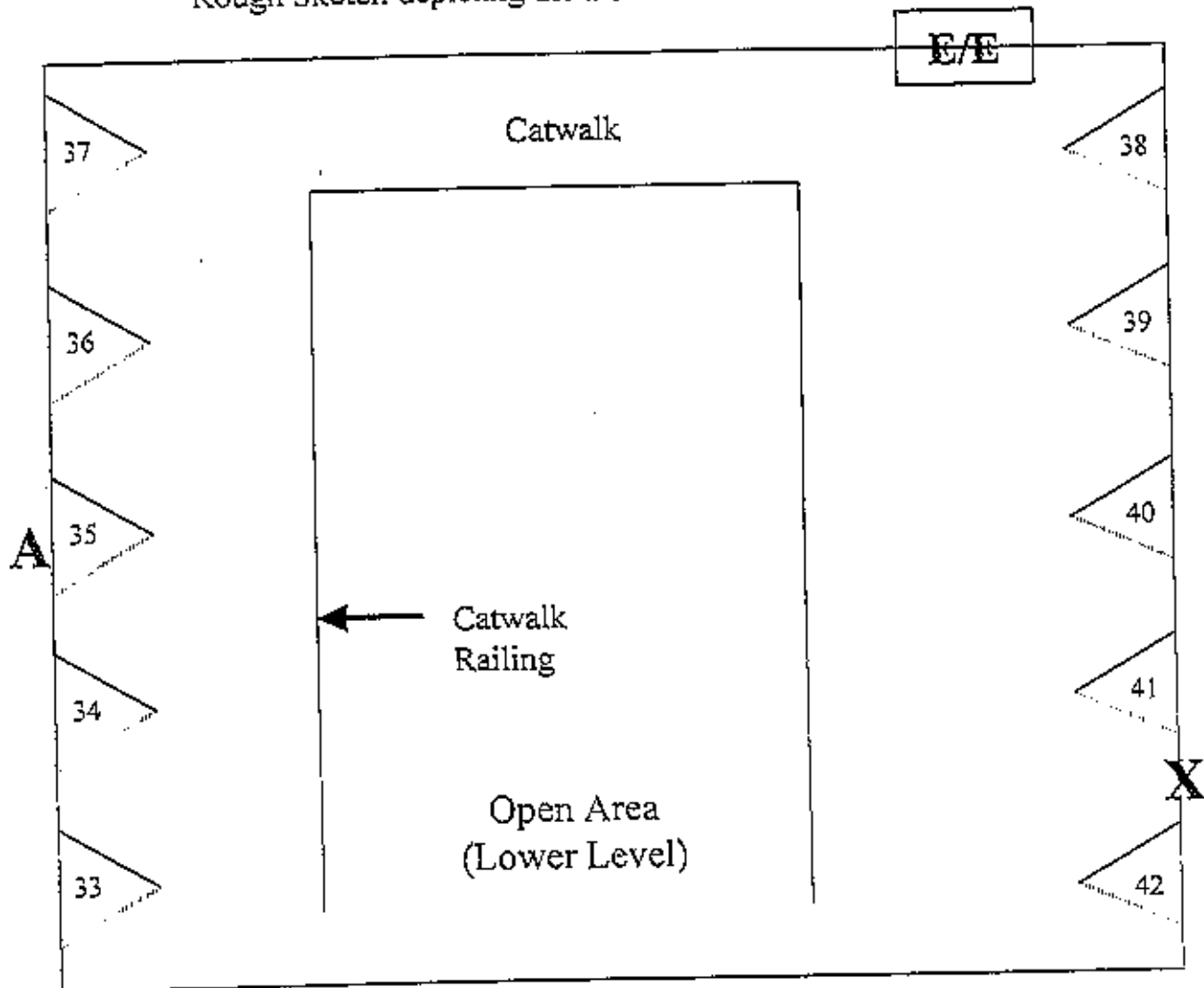

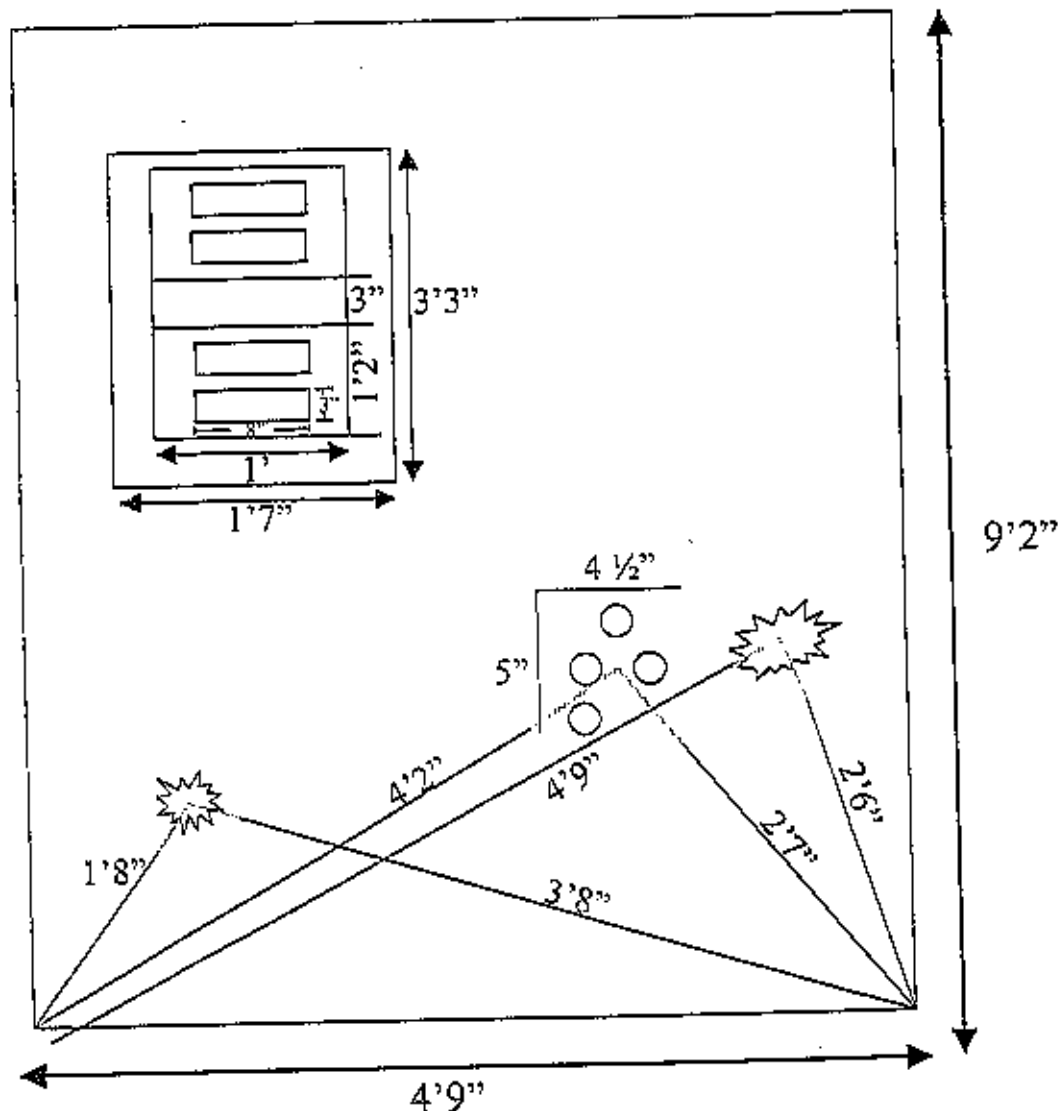

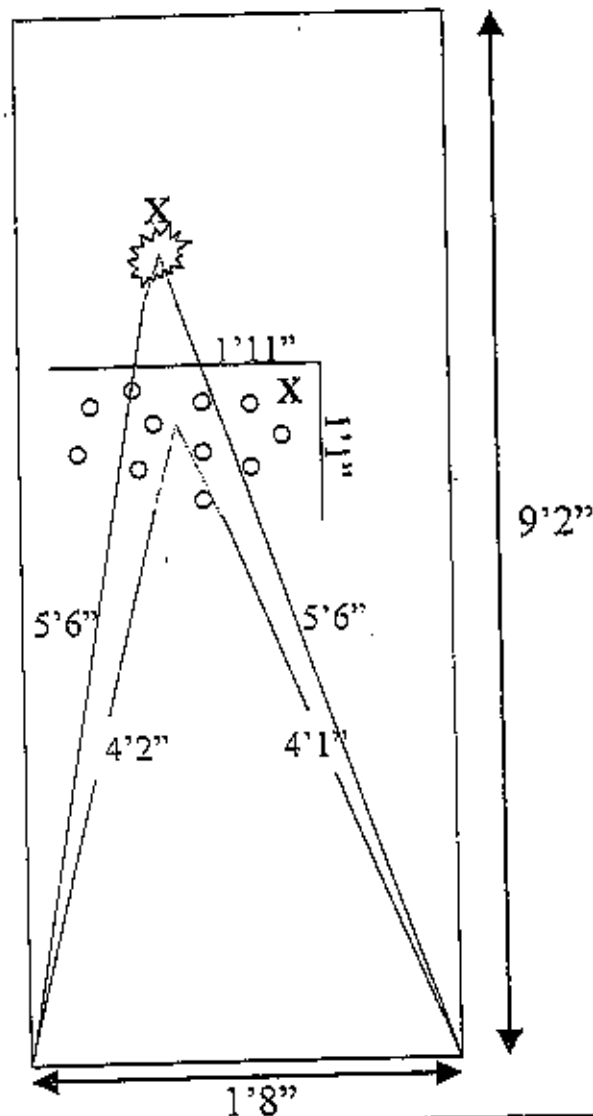

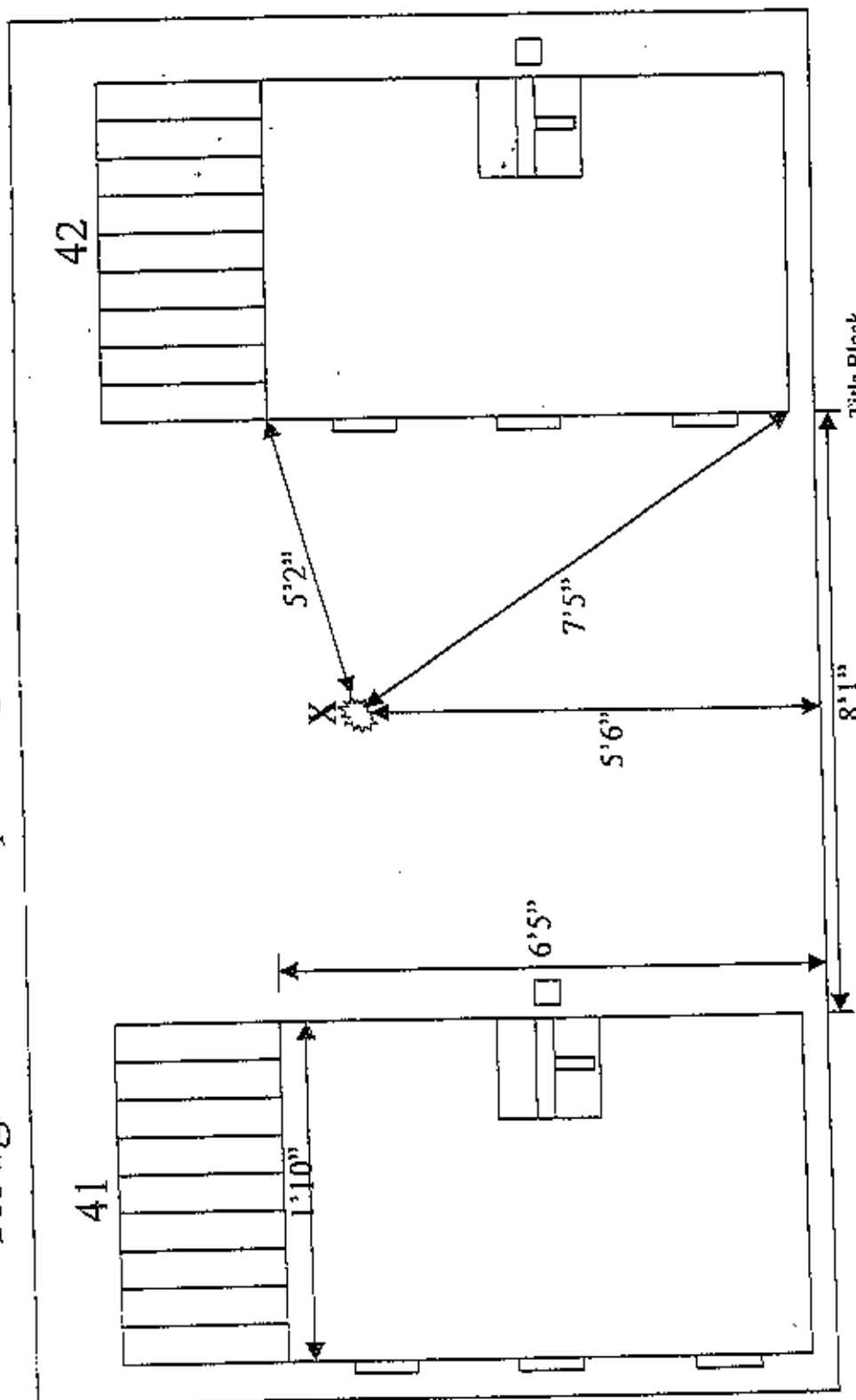

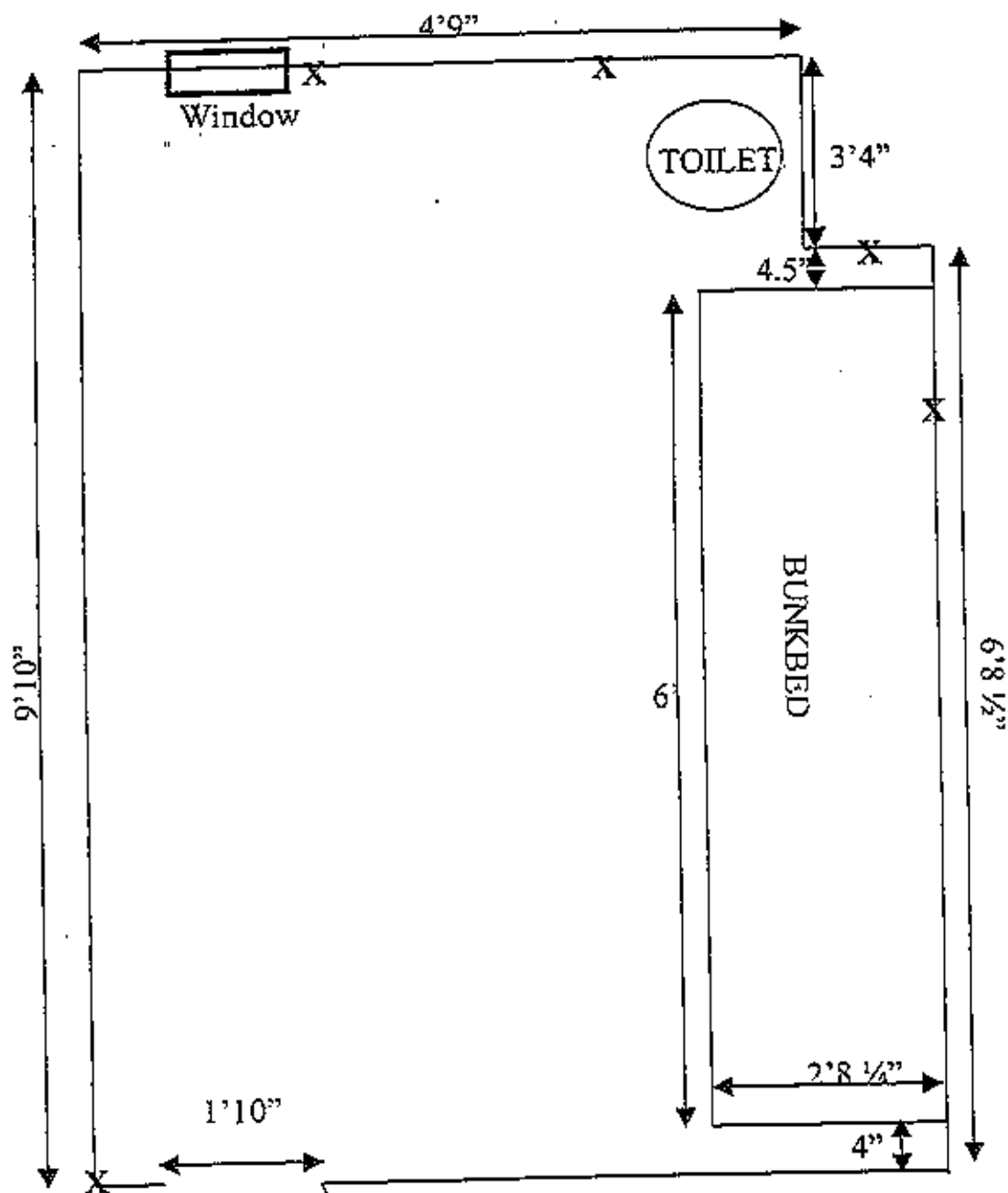

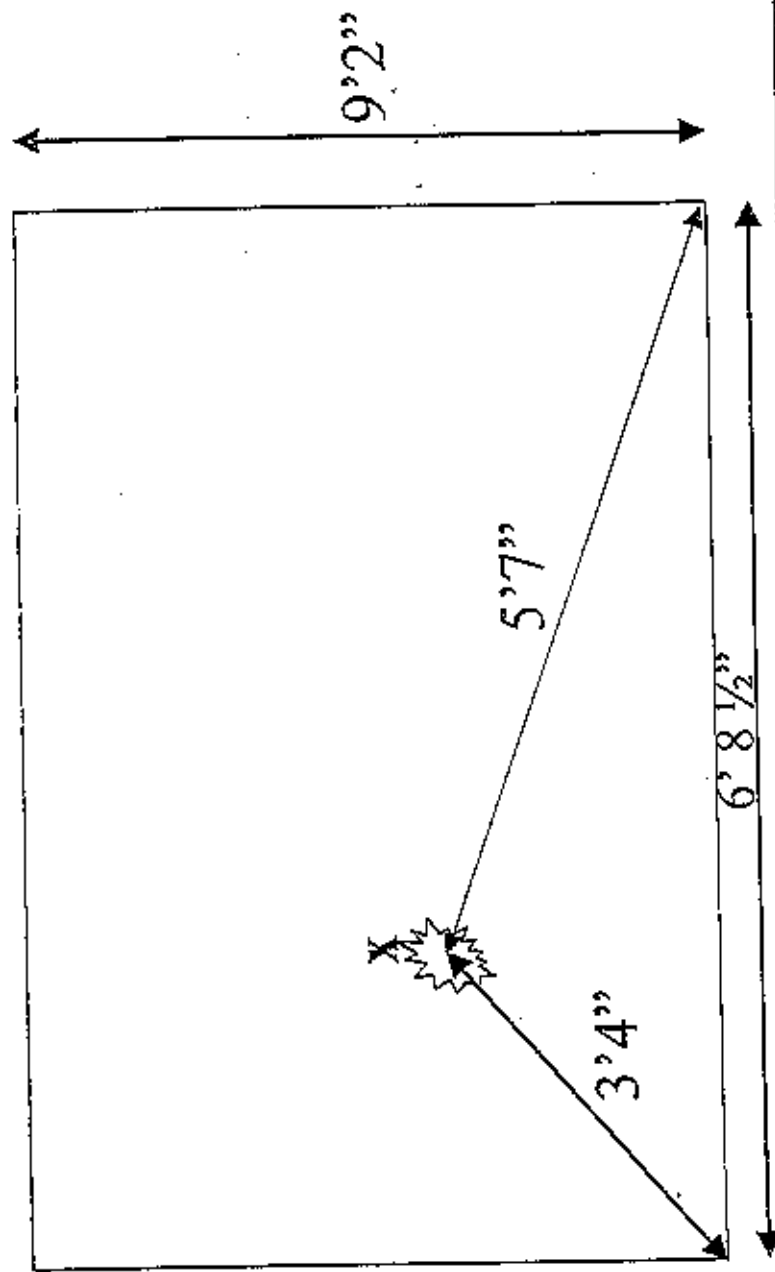

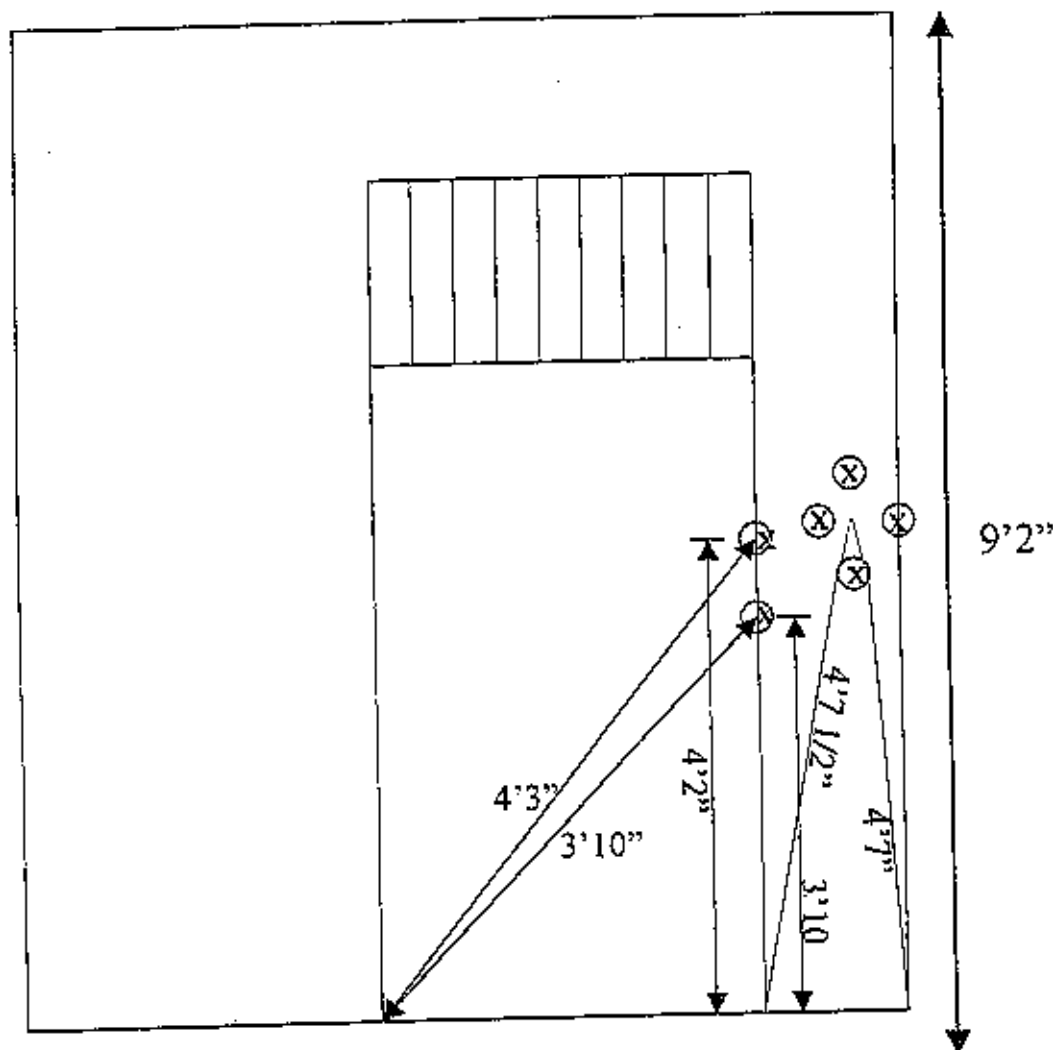

AL-SHIEKH showed him a pistol and knife while he was cleaning the walkway around the cells in the Hard Site area. Detainee [REDACTED] further described the pistol as being black, with brown handgrips with a star in the center of the handgrips. Detainee [REDACTED] stated that Detainee AL-SHIEKH allegedly was able to obtain the weapons through two Iraqi policemen that work as guards at the Baghdad Correctional Facility, who smuggled the weapons into the prison inside the inner tube of a spare tire and tossed the weapons to Detainee AL-SHIEKH. Detainee [REDACTED] stated the main Iraqi Policeman who allegedly smuggled the weapons into the prison was well known to him as he was a main Fedayeen trainer and he had trained under him on many occasions prior to his capture. Detainee [REDACTED] related that this individual was known as [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] and described him as being approximately 5'11", very strong, similar to a body builder, with short black hair, no facial hair, olive color complexion with no distinguishing marks or tattoos. Detainee [REDACTED] related that Mr. [REDACTED] lived adjacent to Tobje Prison, which was a prison used to house juvenile offenders.

About 1230, 29 Nov 03, SA [REDACTED] with the assistance of Mr. [REDACTED] Translator, Titan Industries, interviewed Detainee [REDACTED]. Detainee # [REDACTED] NDRS # [REDACTED]. Detainee [REDACTED] related on 20 Nov 03, Detainee AL-SHIEKH asked him if he would participate in an attack on the prison guards in an attempt to kill American forces and possibly escape. Detainee [REDACTED] stated he would participate, but wanted to know when the weapons arrived. Detainee [REDACTED] stated on either 23 or 24 Nov 03, Detainee AL-SHIEKH shouted to him "Today is the day of the operation", which meant Detainee AL-SHIEKH had possession of the weapons. Detainee [REDACTED] stated he shouted back to Detainee AL-SHIEKH "let's wait until tomorrow" as a ruse in order to report to the guards that Detainee AL-SHIEKH was in possession of weapons. 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and blindfolded him, and transported him to an interrogation room to obtain further details with the use of a translator, during which time he provided Detainee AL-SHIEKH's name and what weapons he had in his possession. Detainee [REDACTED] stated he was in the interrogation room during the time of the incident, and that he heard shouting and weapons being discharged, but he was unable to see anything. Detainee [REDACTED] further stated he did not know how Detainee AL-SHIEKH was able to obtain the weapons or who else may have been involved.

AGENTS COMMENT: Detainee [REDACTED] was apprehended at the same time as Detainee AL-SHIEKH, but has consistently denied he was involved in any attacks on Coalition Forces and that he was merely driving Detainee AL-SHIEKH and his companions. Detainee [REDACTED] could not explain why Detainee AL-SHIEKH would believe that he would participate in an attack on the guards, but stated Detainee AL-SHIEKH knows no one else in the Hard Site area, and wanted another person to participate in the attack, so he asked him.

I was informed by the shift NCOIC (SSG Frederick) that another detainee (informant one) had recently approached the MP element and was indicating the possibility of a security detainee possessing a handgun as well as possibly two knives. I immediately spoke to this detainee who corroborated what SSG Frederick had stated. Additional information from this detainee was that another detainee might also possess a knife. The gun and two knives were reportedly in cell #35. This information coincided with early detainee debriefing reports and other intelligence reports that an unknown number of security detainees may attempt a mass escape and/or attempt to kill U.S. military at the Abu Ghraib facility. Additional concern was highlighted that the detainees may receive support by the CPA hired local Iraqi Security Police (ISP) forces assigned to the BCF. Support was to be possible weapons provided and/or to assist in creating a diversion to allow security detainees and Iraqi convicts (both housed in the prison facility but in separate wings) from the period of 18-27 Nov 03. I referenced the personnel data on the detainee in cell #35 and immediately recognized him as a Syrian who was detained with three other Syrians and an Iraqi. He is part of an element smuggled into Iraq who admittedly was targeting Coalition convoys with coordinated ambushes of cell phone detonated IEDs and small arms fire. The Syrian, AL-SHIEKH, Ameen Mohammed Sami (ISN [REDACTED]) and other Syrian males traveled to Iraq to participate in a Jihad against U.S./Coalition forces. I then continued to solicit as much data as possible from informant one through one of our indigenous translators as I instructed the MPs to prepare to conduct search the cells on the 2nd tier, then we would do the first tier where the other weapon (a knife) was to be in cell #4. I also looked at the other prisoners on either side of cell #35 and cells across the tier. I noticed that one of the security detainees was also a suspected Fedayeen member as was AL-SHIEKH. The team to search the Syrian cell was composed of myself (LTC Jordan), SFC Snider, SSG Frederick, SSG Elliott, and SGT Cathcart. I was armed with a M-16 and 9mm, with SSG Elliott armed with a 12-gauge shotgun and 9mm, and SFC Snider armed with a 12-gauge shotgun as well. SFC [REDACTED] and SSG [REDACTED] provided covering observation from the western portion of the tier armed with M-16s. My direction was to have the MPs have AL-SHIEKH be secured and a search conducted of his cell and if nothing was discovered to conduct several other random searches, as not to tip-off the detainees as to our possible source. When the MPs and I reached the cell #35, SSG Fredrick and SGT Cathcart went to the right side (if facing the cell door) while SSG Elliott, I and SFC Snider remained along the left side of the cell and along the tier wall. SGT Cathcart and SSG Elliott repeatedly requested that the detainee show his hands and place his hands through the cell door. SFC Snider and I continued to cover the detainee cells across the tier in case more than one weapon had been smuggled into the facility and an ambush was planned. I would estimate that request was made 3-4 times. AL-SHIEKH initially asked why? Then he responded, "no, I refuse". He then also stated "I have no gun". Note: no soldier present at anytime queried the subject about any type of weapon. I stepped into the cell door area and also demanded that the detainee show his hands and place his hands through the door. Upon this request to the assailant to provide his hands through the detention cell door and his non-compliance, I authorized SSG Elliott to remove his shotgun from safe after he indicated he had two non-lethal rounds in the chamber. Again SGT Cathcart and SSG Elliott demanded that the detainee comply to move forward and place his hands through the door. The subject continued to be non-compliant and then made a sudden movement towards the upper bunk of his cell and SGT Cathcart yelled out indicating such movement. The subject pulled an automatic pistol and fired one round through the cell door bars at the search team, striking the south wall across the tier. I immediately authorized SSG Elliott to engage the subject, which he did by firing two non-lethal shotgun rounds at the subject. AL-SHIEKH appeared to have been hit and as SSG Elliott, SGT Cathcart, and I moved to the cell door the suspect fired two more rounds at us. At this time SGT Elliott engaged with lethal shotgun rounds. While the shots were being fired, as well as in between periods, SSG Fredrick and SGT Cathcart demanded that the weapon be thrown out and his hands placed through the cell door. AL-SHIEKH would fire a round and the search team engaged with 12 gauge shotgun and 9mm fire. I would estimate that AL-SHIEKH fired an estimated 7-9 rounds. The team did not use M16 fire due to the closed constraints of the cell and possible ricochet. Only when

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AL-SHIEKH ran out of ammunition did he throw the weapon outside the cell. Once the weapon was safe, AL-SHIEKH was again ordered to place his hands through the cell door. He finally complied and placed his hands through the bottom rungs of the cell door where I placed my weapon on his head and ordered him not to move while SGT Cathcart and SGT Elliott secured his hands to the door. SFC Snider and SSG Frederick continued to cover the other cells, as did SPC [REDACTED] and SSG [REDACTED]. The cell door was opened and AL-SHIEKH was uncuffed from the door and moved out into the tier walkway and resecured to the tier railing and an unoccupied cell door. Medics already in the facility were summoned once the detainee was checked for other weapons or explosives. AL-SHIEKH appeared to have several wounds to his lower legs as well as a non-lethal round hit to his chest. Medics initiated 1st aid and requested a MEDEVAC and the MP Element did the MEDEVAC request. SFC Snider, SSG Frederick, SSG [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] maintained cover for the medics while I and the search team then conducted a search of the AL-SHIEKH's cell. The search produced two large bayonet type knives with removable compass handles concealed in two MRE cardboard containers. The knives were hidden under the upper bunk pillow area which is where AL-SHIEKH reached and removed the Chinese made 9mm weapon. Note: the subject was to have been debriefed at 2300 hours by MI interrogators and analyst staff to include moving AL-SHIEKH without MP escort due to minimal MP manning. Very few MI soldiers have the new protective vests and none have ballistic plates to stop small arms rounds. Had the search team not acted on the weapons information and responded as they did risking their lives, it is an almost certainty that three to four U.S. soldiers and civilian interrogators may have been killed or at least significantly injured by AL-SHIEKH. Subsequent questioning of the initial informant and another detainee informant indicate that the suspect stated last Thursday (20 November 03) that he would obtain weapons and was planning to kill U.S. personnel working the isolation tiers. Informant two indicates that he collected the gun and knives from AL-SHIEKH on Sunday and hid them in his mattress, as he is a former Fedayeen member and is a good source of Fedayeen information. He identified AL-SHIEKH as a Captain in the Fedayeen that he has known in Iraq for three years or so. However, informant two indicated that he returned the weapons to AL-SHIEKH on Monday stating that the MPs monitored his cell to closely. On Monday morning, AL-SHIEKH indicated to informant one that he had the weapons and that evening (24 November 2003) would be the time to strike and kill American soldiers. He was asking other detainees if they were with him. Note: informant two indicates that this weapon was used previously to kill an American officer in July 2003. Additionally, this informant has been approached about receiving another weapon from an unidentified ISP to be provided to another Fedayeen member to attack U.S. military members. Additional security measures are being employed within the isolation area. Informants then indicated that there might be at least one other cell with an armed detainee and possibly hand-grenades as well. Additional security forces were called to include three K9 teams and a complete search of the isolation area was made with no additional weapons located. However, informants indicate that ISP personnel may be bringing in three additional weapons on 25 November 2003 as well as the possible grenades. Note: this supports prior reporting of ISP's initiating a disturbance and assisting with a main attack on the BCF to free High Value Detainees (though those detainees are housed elsewhere). Informants stated that a bed sheet was tied around the weapons and the sheet was thrown up to the second tier cell window and secured by the subject. The only means to get that close is through an ISP checkpoint area outside the wing area. Later that evening (24 November 2003), and through the afternoon of 26 November 2003, MP and MI soldiers conducted a coordinated search all ISP personnel at the site and those reporting for work. Currently thirty-six (36) are being held for couriering messages between Iraqi prisoners and families, couriering narcotics and possible weapons (razor blades), and as members of the Fedayeen or the Iraqi Intelligence Service (IIS). The ISP's are being debriefed. This follows the earlier discoveries of a security detainee with 50 scalpel blades in his possession and three other ISP's with prisoner notes and substantial amounts of currency (U.S. and Iraqi).

Q. What is the name of the Detainee who provided the intel?

A. He is the detainee referred to as the [REDACTED], located in cell #1. He was arrested w/ AL-SHIEKH and 3 other Syrians.

Q. Did the detainee provide the name of the IP who provided the weapon to AL-SHIEKH?

A. No.

Q. When the shooting started, who fired first?

A. AL-SHIEKH fired one round.

Q. Was anyone other than SGT CATHCART struck by a round?

A. Not to my knowledge.

Q. How long did the incident last?

A. Approximately 10-15 minutes.

Q. Who witnessed the pistol first?

A. Unsure if anyone saw the weapon...just his movement from the cell interior towards the bunk bed and upper bed area were we believed he had the gun per informant information. His sudden movement to the bed was then followed up by a round being fired by AL-SHIEKH which I believe struck the wall across the tier.

Q. Describe the weapon the detainee used against the Search Team?

A. A 9mm pistol, believe the markings show it to be Chinese made. Fired 9mm small cased rounds.

Q. How many rounds were fired by the detainee?



At approximately 1800 hours on 24 November 2003, SSG _____ and I were asked to respond to a call over at the Isolation Cells because a prisoner wanted to talk to an MI representative. The both of us decided to go over there to assess the situation and see where to go afterwards. We first stopped off at the MP office over on Wing #4 to find out what was going on. Once we arrived we spoke with SSG Frederick and he told us that the prisoner had already been spoken with and that they had another situation on their hands. We asked him if there was anything we could do and he asked us if we could shoot, to which we replied yes. I then told him that I was also an Arabic linguist and could help out with any translations or other linguist needs. He then gave SSG _____ a shotgun and told us that it had been reported that a prisoner in Isolation had a pistol and that they were going to do a search of all the cells on that wing. He told us that LTC Jordan was already over there as well as some MPs. Once we went upstairs to the second floor of Isolation, I saw that they had already begun handcuffing prisoners' hands outside of their cells on the left hand side and myself, SSG _____ and an MP SFC went over to secure the prisoners on the right. The three of us were making our way down the right hand side of the cells when I noticed that there were some MPs over on the other side towards the end of the row yelling at a prisoner to put his hands where they could see them. I couldn't see the prisoner but could tell that he was not complying because the MPs were yelling at him again to put his hands where they could see them. As we made it down almost opposite of the cell where they were having problems, I heard an MP yell, "He's got a gun!" and then heard a shot. SSG _____ then told me to get out of there and we immediately began to run down the corridor out of the danger area. SSG _____ then went around to the other side, while I remained out of the way near the other stairwell because I had no weapon. I don't exactly remember exactly what happened next, but do remember hearing an exchange of fire between the MPs and the prisoner inside his cell. SSG _____ then passed over the shotgun to the MPs and rejoined me near the stairwell. During the incident I do remember seeing a shot come from the prisoner's cell that bounced off the opposite wall and made a spark. I don't remember how much further the exchange of fire went on, but did hear an MP call for the medics in order to take care of the prisoner because he had been shot. Once the medics arrived, they pulled the prisoner out of his cell and I went over to translate for them. The prisoner was conscious, but did not respond to any of my questions.

A: I saw SSG [REDACTED] go along the catwalk on the same side as the detainee to bring the shotgun towards where the MP's were shooting into the cell. He then slid the shotgun across the floor in order for the MP's to get it.

Q: Did you see anyone hit by any of the detainee's rounds?

A: I saw a round hit the wall across the tier and it sparked near where SGT CATHCART was standing. The round that I saw strike the wall was right next to where SGT CATHCART was standing and it hit right about his neck level but I don't think it hit him. At that time I heard SSG [REDACTED] say "I think someone got hit", but I didn't see anyone bleeding or anything like that.

Q: Did any other rounds the detainee fired strike near anyone else?

A: Not that I saw.

Q: At the time the shooting started, did you think the detainee was trying to kill you?

A: Honestly, I don't know. I think if he had the opportunity, he would have killed any American soldier.

Q: Is there anything you wish to add to this statement?

A: Those MP's saved my life and they did an outstanding job.

On 24 November 2003, about 1730 hours local time SFC [REDACTED] told me to go to the isolation cellblock for an interrogation. Before sending a Tiger Team I wanted to go and assess the situation to be able to give better guidance to my Team. At about 1800 hours SSG [REDACTED] and I went to the hard site to check in with the MPs on duty and in the hallway we ran into SSG Fredrick. I asked him for about the interrogation that they requested and he told me that at this time we couldn't conduct an interrogation, because they had a situation on their hands. I asked him if he needed any help and he told me that they could use the extra bodies and also told me that he had weapons we could use. All three of us went down to the isolation block, at that time there were some MPs and LTC Jordan already at the site and were concentrating on one cell. SSG [REDACTED] and I assisted one of the MPs in securing all the detainees on the opposite site, the MP was cuffing the detainees to the cells, SSG [REDACTED] was interpreting for him and I was providing security with a shotgun. During the entire time MPs were shouting at one of the detainees in the cellblock and he was shouting back, I was concentrating on the detainees that we were securing, so I was not paying attention to what they were shouting about. When I first came in the MPs were shouting at the same detainee to put his hands out of the cell so they can secure him. We had about four more cells left to secure before the first couple of shots were fired and since we were where right across the problem cell we all ducked and started running towards the center of the cell block. During this time shots were fired into the cell and out of the cell and one of the MPs came to me and took the second shotgun and started firing into the cell. I don't know if the shotguns ran out of ammo, but the detainee continued shooting and one of the MPs pulled his 9mm and started firing into the cell. Once the detainee ran out of ammo he yelled out something and threw away his weapon, I was further down so I couldn't hear what he yelled but all the shooting stopped and the detainee was secured. The MPs pulled the detainee out of the cell and searched it, they recovered two knives hidden in two MRE main course/accessory boxes. Once the MPs cleared the cell, the medics began first aid on the detainee; I went and asked if they needed a MEDEVAC and what category, medics told me he was an urgent patient. At that time I went to the 320th MP TOC and requested a MEDEVAC.

I, Ameer Sa'eed AL-SHEIKH, want to make the following Statement under oath:

In the name of Allah, the merciful:

I was standing by the window. I saw a young man who asked me, "Where are you from?" I told him I was Syrian. He asked me if I wanted him to call my family. I said, "Yes," and gave him the phone number. He called my family and he asked me if I wanted to get out of prison? I told him, "Yes." Cause in prison I'm under a lot of stresses and all the interrogators say, "I will never get out." He told me he will bring me a pistol when I find suitable time I should escape. Then the next day I should go to a restaurant in Fallujah at 10 o'clock in the morning. After 2-3 days he came back and told me he got me a gun and 2 knives and he will stop by after midnight and give them to me. And, I should have a rope ready by then. He came back at night and told me to throw the rope from the window, which I did. He tied the pistol and the knives to the rope and I pulled it up. Then the young man, gone. He was a young Iraqi man, dark skin, about 25 years old. After I pulled the gun up, I concealed it. Next night at about 9-10 o'clock I found the guards telling me, "Put your hands outside the cell because we need to search your cell because someone told us you have a weapon!" I told someone in prison that I have a pistol and if he wants to escape with me. And he said, "Yes." I asked the guards, "Who told you I have a pistol?" They screamed at me and saying, "We will kill you!" I took the gun out from underneath the pillow while I was talking to them. Then one of them started to shoot my chest. When I saw blood coming out of my chest, I thought I will die. I told them, "You killed me!" He said, "No!" But I didn't believe him because there was blood coming out of my chest by my heart. So I started to shoot. And I got hit by several bullets in my legs, my chest, my back. Then I felt dizzy and felt I'm dying or I'm losing consciousness. I told the guards. So they said, "Put your hands outside your cell." So I crawled to the floor and put my hands out. Some doctors treated my wounds and they transferred me to the hospital.

THE SEARCH TEAM FIRED NON-LETHAL SHOTGUN ROUNDS AT DETAINEE AL-SHIEKH, WHICH HAD NO EFFECT. DETAINEE AL-SHIEKH RESPONDED BY FIRING FIVE TO SIX ADDITIONAL ROUNDS, ONE OF WHICH STRUCK SGT CATHCART IN THE CHEST. SGT CATHCART WAS NOT INJURED DUE TO HIS PROTECTIVE VEST. THE SEARCH TEAM THEN ENGAGED DETAINEE AL-SHIEKH WITH LETHAL ROUNDS, STRIKING HIM TWICE IN THE LEGS. AL-SHIEKH RELINQUISHED HIS WEAPON AFTER HE HAD EXPENDED ALL HIS AMMUNITION. THE SEARCH TEAM SUBDUED AL-SHIEKH AND REMOVED HIM FROM THE TIER.

AL-SHIEKH WAS SUBSEQUENTLY TREATED BY MEDICAL PERSONNEL FOR A CONTUSION TO THE CHEST, AND GUNSHOT WOUNDS TO HIS LOWER EXTREMITES. DETAINEE AL-SHIEKH WAS FURTHER MEDEVACED TO THE 28TH CSH, BAGHDAD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (BIAP), IRAQ.

THE SEARCH TEAM CONDUCTED A SEARCH OF DETAINEE AL-SHIEKH'S CELL AND DISCOVERED TWO LARGE BAYONET TYPE KNIVES HIDDEN IN MRE CARDBOARD CONTAINERS, WHICH WERE LOCATED UNDER THE UPPER BUNK PILLOW AREA.
