On 11/25/2002 [redacted] b6 -2,3,4
 [redacted] was interviewed at Camp b7C -2,3,4
 Delta, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba. The interview was conducted by b7D -1
 FBI Task Force Officer Det. [redacted] was b7F -1
 [redacted] The results of the
 interview are as follows:

[redacted] was asked if any changes had occurred in
 the detainee camp over the weekend. He said that he was b6 -3,4
 given a paper by the guards indicating that there would be b7C -3,4
 four basic classes of detainees with regard to b7D -1
 privilege/discipline issues. An isolation unit would be b7F -1
 utilized for serious violators of camp regulations. All
 rewards and punishment are to be based on camp behavior and
 cooperation with investigators. Rewards that may be given to
 detainees include cold water and the ability to store food
 in their cells. [redacted] sees these new rules as a positive
 step in soliciting the cooperation of the detainees.

[redacted] said he experienced punishment at the b6 -3,4
 camp on one prior occasion about [redacted] months ago. He, along b7C -3,4
 with numerous other inmates, [redacted] b7D -1
 [redacted] b7F -1
 He was placed in the isolation unit [redacted]
 [redacted] He now regrets his actions in the [redacted]
 incident and says that participating with the other
 detainees in the water [redacted] was a mistake.

The interviewer probed [Redacted] on his guilt or innocence based on the facts of his detainment. It was mentioned that if [Redacted] was truly innocent, he should have no hesitation answering any questions posed by interviewers. If, on the other hand, [Redacted] was guilty of some crime, [Redacted] should admit his mistake(s) and move ahead with his life in the hopes of one day being released from custody. [Redacted] volunteered that he has not been overly enthusiastic about being interviewed during Ramadan. With 10 days of Ramadan left, [Redacted] [Redacted] promised that he would be willing to answer any questions that this interviewer poses to him, without an "R.T.N." response, after Ramadan ends. [Redacted] was told that no promises could be made to him at this time with regard to when he is called for his next interview.

[Redacted] was asked if he ever thought he would be going home. He asked the interviewer if he wanted the truth and then said that the other detainees [Redacted] and this helps to keep him strong. He was never as religious as he is now. He has been heavily influenced by the other detainees around him.

[Redacted] was reminded of his answer to a question posed during his previous interview relating to if he had ever met USAMA BIN LADEN. When the interviewer told him that he (the interviewer) would like to meet and interview UBL, [Redacted] smiled broadly and seemed genuinely pleased and intrigued. He then asked the interviewer if he would also like to meet [Redacted]. [Redacted] was asked again if he had ever met UBL. While not directly answering it, [Redacted] replied that it would not be unusual for someone to have met UBL. He denied that anyone from the Middle East having met UBL would achieve celebrity status considering the vast amounts of sympathizers and followers they both have.
