INVESTIGATIVE SUMMARY:

"This is an Operation Enduring Investigation"

This investigation was initiated upon notification by the Military Police Traffic Accident Investigations, Bagram AirField, APO AE 09354, of a traffic accident fatality.

Investigation failed to establish probable cause to believe [REDACTED] [REDACTED] B Company, 168th Infantry Regiment, Bagram AirField, APO AE 09354, committed the offense of Negligent Homicide as initially alleged.

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Further investigation revealed [REDACTED] was towing a military vehicle and traveling within convoy speed, following [REDACTED] units Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), and was driving in a safe manner appropriate for the area. [REDACTED] was traveling in when an unidentified local national, without warning, turned into the path of the vehicle [REDACTED] was driving. [REDACTED] turned the vehicle sharply to the right to avoid hitting the local national. The right mirror of the vehicle struck the local national causing him to go in-between the two vehicles and the vehicle being towed ran over the local national causing him injuries, which subsequently led to his death.
