- 3. Amount of claim and filing date: Claimant filed a claim in the amount of \$8,000 on 28 Jan 06.
- 4. Chapter the claim was considered under and a brief description of the incident or of the issues raised by the claimant on reconsideration: Foreign Claims Act and Chapter 10, AR 27-20; claim filed for compensation for the death of her husband.
- 5. Facts: The claimant alleges that US Forces wronfully killed her husband..
- 6. Opinion: In order to form a basis for a claim under the FCA, the incident in question must have arisen outside the Unites States. In addition, the incident must be caused by either non-combat activities of the Unites States Armed Forces or by negligent or wrongful acts of military members or civilian employees of the Armed Forces. There is no evidence submitted to prove that negligence or wrongful act by the Coalition Forces was the cause of the incident.
- 7. <u>Recommended Action</u>: This claim is not payable under the FCA for the above mentioned reasons. Consequently this claim for \$8,000 is denied.


