You have submitted a claim seeking compensation for damages allegedly caused by U.S. Forces. I have thoroughly reviewed your claim pursuant to the Foreign Claims Act (FCA), Title 10, United States Code §2734, Army Regulation 27-20, and Department of the Army Pamphlet 27-162 Claims Procedures.

Allow me to express my sympathy for your loss, however, in accordance with the cited references and after investigating your claim, I find that your claim is **not compensable** for the following reason: Could not find evidence that US forces were responsible. Accordingly, your claim must be denied.

Any such request must be based on new or additional evidence and should be forwarded to this office.
