MEMORANDUM OF OPINION

SUBJECT: Claim of [REDACTED] 06-IA8-306

1. **Identifying Data:** [REDACTED]
2. **Date and place the incident occurred giving rise to the claim:** The claim occurred on September 15, 2006 in Ishaki, Iraq.
3. **Amount of claim and date it was filed:** Claimant filed a claim for \$4,373 on 19 Feb. 2006.
4. **Jurisdiction:** This request is presented for consideration under the provisions of the Foreign Claims Act, 10 USC Section 2734, as implemented by Chapter 10, Army Regulation 27-20. This claim was properly filed in a timely manner.
5. **Facts:** The Claimant alleges that CF shot and killed his son, [REDACTED], while he was driving from Ishaki to Balad. A SIGACTS investigation revealed no escalations of force involving a vehicle in which the Claimant alleges the deceased was driving.
6. **Opinion:** "Under AR 27-20, paragraph 10-3, liability under the FCA may be based on acts or omissions of U.S. soldiers or civilian employees of a U.S. military department only if they are considered negligent or wrongful." Here, there is no credible evidence that this event actually occurred.
7. **Recommendation:** The claim is denied.

SUBJECT: Claimant Denial
