Truck four's gunner shifted ~~at~~ to cover the field while I covered the rear. I heard shouting to get the car to stop followed with warning shots. Following the escalation procedures, I heard the 50 cal (^{truck}) and 240 (truck 1) open fire on the hostile car. I looked back quickly to see the car on fire and then I heard "popping" sounds from the burning (possible ammo).

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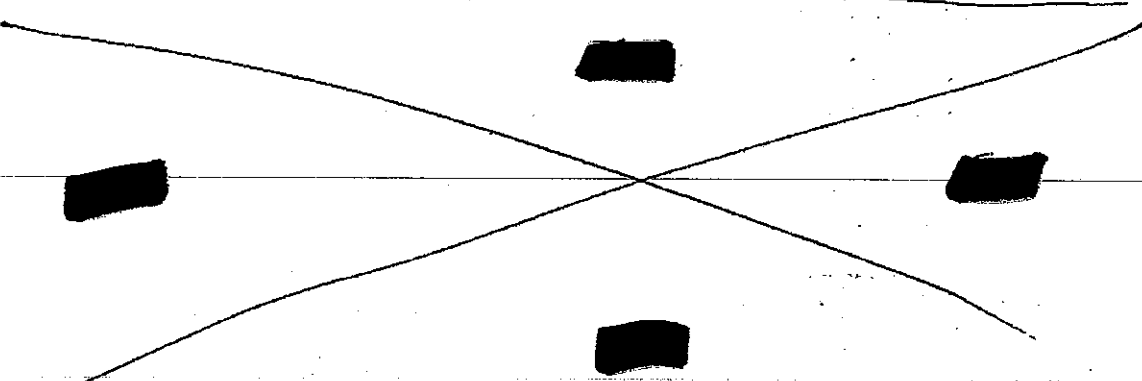

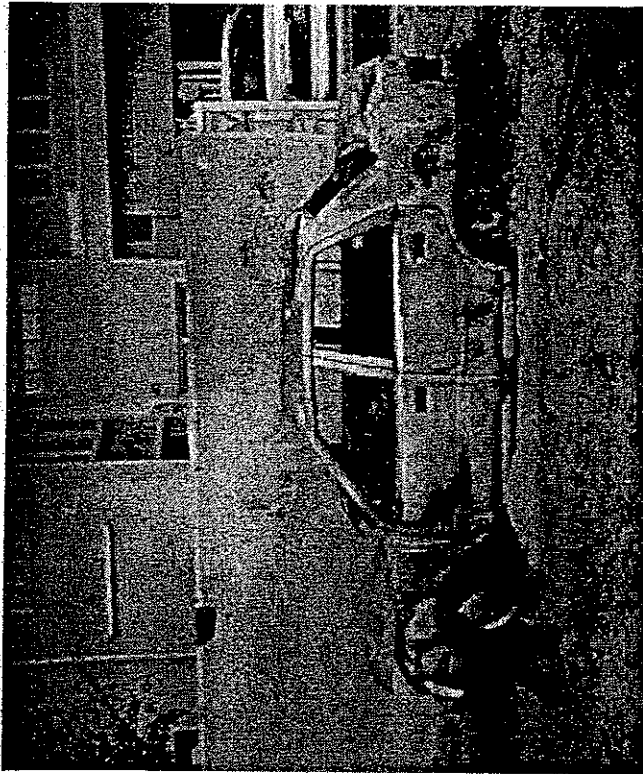

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: Sitting on south [REDACTED] access road, [REDACTED], Easy 3-6s patrol 50SC552L960 was talking on radio to higher to find out about IP's firing on a Mosque. While stopped and pulling security, the patrol noticed a car out before curfew ended in Muhalla 810/812. The patrol then went to investigate. There was a road block in the street that was being moved by the male driver of the car. The driver saw the American patrol and got back in the car. While the driver was getting in, the passenger got out and ran away to the east in the Palmetto trees. At that time, [REDACTED] and the interpreter were getting out to communicate with the driver (the person that jumped out of the car and headed East to the palmetto trees disappeared). The driver began conducting a 3 point turn, while the patrol and the interpreter were yelling at him to stop and get out of the car. While the car was turning, the gunner in the lead truck fired a non lethal M203 sponge round at the car, and the sponge round struck the door panel of the car. The driver then finished his three point turn in the street and stopped, facing North (same direction of the patrol). [REDACTED] fired two warning shots with his M4 into an open field left of the car (West), and the driver stopped. [REDACTED] and the interpreter then began to move up towards the car yelling at the driver to get out of the car. At that time, the driver removed his Hummel, looked out of the driver side window, did some type of hand gesture with his hand (similar to the Catholic sign of the cross), and put the car in reverse, backing up towards [REDACTED] and the interpreter. SSG Reece then fired a second pair of warning shots to the left of the vehicle towards an empty field (West). [REDACTED] and the interpreter then quickly got out of the way before the vehicle could strike them. [REDACTED] seeing [REDACTED] and the interpreter dive out of the way, fired a warning shot burst into the empty field left of the vehicle (West) with his M240B on one of the lead vehicles. The vehicle continued to back up towards the patrol, and approached within 7-10 meters from the patrol. The lead two vehicles then engaged the car with the M240B and M2 mounted on the vehicles. The driver then put the car into drive and moved forward about 5 feet before being mortally wounded, and the car burst into flames (believe a tracer round pierced the gas tank). After the car burst into flames, there were two secondary explosions that caused the patrol to pull back from the car, believing the car had HME or some other explosive that was going to cause the car to explode. After the secondary explosion, there were a dozen to two dozen smaller explosions, pops, and whistles that could have been rounds cooking off. A local fire truck then showed up and began putting out the fire. After the fire was extinguished, the patrol moved up, secured the area, and began to assess the collateral damage to ensure that there were no other casualties and issue claims cards. The patrol then began to question the family of the individual in the car. The family stated that the individual worked in a battery store, but the neighbors stated he worked in the MOO. The family also denied the presence of the second person in the vehicle. The IPs then showed up and started talking to the family and neighbors. The IPs didn't want any American assistance. The patrol then handed the situation over to the IPs, and returned to FOB Falcon.

1. TACTICAL RISK ASSESSMENTS CONDUCTED FOR EVERY MISSION IS CRITICAL TO OUR SUCCESS AND KEY TO FORCE PROTECTION.
2. SOLDIERS WILL KNOW THE ROE (RULES OF ENGAGEMENT) AND THE LEVELS ESCALATION OF FORCE LEVELS. SOLDIERS WILL CARRY A COPY OF THESE ITEMS THE MNC-I ROE CARD AND THE RULES FOR USE OF FORCE CARD ON THEM AT ALL TIMES.
3. DETAINEE ABUSE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. THIS INCLUDES AT THE POINT OF CAPTURE. ALL DETAINEE'S WILL BE GIVEN HUMANE TREATMENT...NO EXCEPTION.
4. STANDARDS AND DISCIPLINE WILL ALWAYS BE ENFORCED.
5. SOLDIERS WILL STAY IN THE PROPER PRESCRIBED UNIFORM.
6. SENSITIVE ITEMS WILL BE TIED DOWN, ACCOUNTED FOR AND PROPER REPORTS WILL BE SENT TO THE CHAIN OF COMMAND.
7. SOLDIERS WILL MAINTAIN PROPER WEAPON ORIENTATION AND MUZZLE AWARENESS.
8. WEAPONS WILL BE CLEARED PROPERLY WHEN ENTERING A SECURE FOB AND CLEANED DAILY.

14. PATROLS / CONVOYS WILL CONDUCT AN AIR AND A GROUND COMMO CHECK PRIOR TO DEPARTING A FOB AND DURING A PATROL...EVERY 30 MINUTES OR AS MISSION DICTATES...AND PRODUCE A POST-MISSION REPORT.
15. GENERAL ORDERS AND POLICIES WILL BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES.
16. ALWAYS ACCOUNT FOR YOUR BUDDY! NO SOLDIER GOES ANYWHERE, ON OR OFF THE FOB, ALONE. NOBODY GETS LEFT BEHIND.
17. OPSEC IS A MUST.....NO SENDING E-MAILS WITH CLASSIFIED OR SENSITIVE INFORMATION.
18. CASUALTY NOTIFICATION IS DONE BY THE PROPER CHAIN OF COMMAND NOT FROM SOLDIERS ON THE BATTLEFIELD.
19. LIVE THE WARRIOR ETHOS.
20. NO 4TH ID GRAFFITI WILL BE DISPLAYED ON ANYTHING.
21. SEXUAL MISCONDUCT WILL BE REPORTED TO THE CHAIN OF COMMAND AND THOROUGHLY INVESTIGATED BY CID OR MILITARY POLICE INVESTIGATORS.

COMMANDING GENERAL'S "COMBAT" GUIDANCE - OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM
(Revised 15 Oct 05; changes underlined)

1. We must stay focused on the mission and not lose sight of our purpose. Be aggressive and defeat enemy forces by killing or capturing non-compliant forces in accordance with the ROE. We will do this with overwhelming firepower when necessary and use all our tools. Our goal is to do the mission with zero friendly casualties.
2. Everything we do is a combat operation, especially convoy operations. I expect the right planning, preparation, and detailed rehearsals with every mission.
3. We must continue to win the hearts and minds of the Iraqi people and continue to stress the importance of Iraqis taking ownership of their country. Be courteous and friendly but forceful. Remain visible.
4. We must work closely with our Iraqi counterparts. We want the Iraqi's to work their own security. This will require tactical patience to allow them to accept responsibility for their security. Our Military Transition Teams (MITT) are key to our success.
5. Stay focused on protecting the force at all times. Stay protected by staying alert, wearing Kevlar helmet, body armor with SAPI plates, protective eyewear, and seat belts during convoy operations. We give the enemy the advantage when we take short cuts. Bad habits get worse in combat. Complacency kills. Never relax until the mission is done and we are back home.
6. Every leader will maintain a record of lessons learned and a leader book/job book.
7. Every soldier will be an expert with their assigned weapon. I expect marksmanship training to continue on every weapon system.
8. We will perform maintenance by the book. We will not take short cuts. We must sustain and maintain all our equipment.
9. Property accountability is leader business and we will maintain proper accountability at all times. Commanders must inspect their equipment. No Commander (Including Rear Detachment Commanders) will change Command without inventories and all adjustment paperwork completed.
10. I expect the division to maintain the training and sustainment of all digital systems.
11. I expect leaders to keep their soldiers and families informed daily on a regular basis.
12. I want a proactive lesson learned program and I want our tactics, techniques, and procedures updated and shared throughout the division. Ironhorse Net is our tool for this.
13. We will continue to standardize all tactical SOPs and our tactics, techniques and procedures.
14. Emphasize the use of battle drills...small unit and staff.
15. We will use aviation with every combat operation.
16. AARs will be conducted, recorded, and filed after every operation and will be shared so we can get better and learn from our experiences.
17. We must know and understand the Iraqi civilian leadership and respect their culture. We must work with them throughout our deployment. Remember, this is a sovereign government now.
18. Know the enemy situation...know the terrain...know your vulnerabilities.
19. Take care of each other. Every soldier needs a battle buddy. No one is left behind.
