 In addition to my statement on the same DTG as this, I would like to add the following. I questioned the detainee with an interpreter named [REDACTED] attached to the 108th MP's. During his conversation with the detainee, he said that the detainee said that they (he and the killed LNT) had received a call from their boss, while they were still at the Reuters office downtown, that there was an IED at the location where the IP's were ambushed. He also stated that the detainee said that it took them 20 minutes to get to the scene from their office downtown. This information led me to believe that they had a tip that the ambush would happen and failed to notify Coalition Forces. This being the case, my unit detained him and turned him over to CPT [REDACTED] and SSG [REDACTED] of 1st Battalion, 256 BCT. Nothing Else Follows.

 At 2030 hours on 28 August 2005 I was contacted by [REDACTED] to interrogate an Iraqi male named [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had been detained [REDACTED] while filming [REDACTED] during an ambush by AIF. The driver of [REDACTED] car had been shot and Huda was detained, along with his video camera, which commander had mistaken for an RPG at the time of the incident. During the interrogation [REDACTED] appeared calm and collected. [REDACTED] explained that he is a photographer who works for a man named [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] has worked for [REDACTED] for the last year. However, the day of capture was [REDACTED] first day of working in Baghdad. Approximately one hour before [REDACTED] arrived on the scene, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to go to the scene of a car which had been attacked. [REDACTED] gave [REDACTED] a video camera and told him to go with a driver named [REDACTED] where the car, which was involved in the incident, was located.

and [redacted] drove in a white four door Daewoo to the scene of the incident where there had been stopped by the IP. [redacted] showed the car near another car driven by photojournalists and waited. After several minutes, shouting broke out and [redacted] ducked down in the passenger seat. [redacted] started to back up the car while getting the video camera up on the dashboard. However, according to the capturing unit, [redacted] was clearly seen by multiple personnel hanging out of the passenger window with the camera pointed at the capturing unit while the driver backed the car up. Additionally, [redacted] found out about the incident approximately one hour prior to his detention. However, the capturing unit [redacted] [redacted] [redacted] only 20 minutes after the incident which [redacted] was supposedly briefed on. This would mean that [redacted] somehow knew about the incident (ambush) 40 minutes before it happened. Finally, after being confronted with the fact that he was seen with the camera hanging out of the window, [redacted] became flustered and stated that he could remember what he was doing.

Subject: Reuters soundman killed in Baghdad, police blame US (11:16 Eastern Daylight Time)

BAGHDAD, Aug 28 (Reuters) - A Reuters Television soundman was shot dead in Baghdad on Sunday and a cameraman with him was wounded and then detained by U.S. soldiers.

Iraqi police said they had been shot by U.S. forces. A U.S. military spokesman said the incident was being investigated.

[REDACTED] 35, was hit by a shot to the face and at least four to the chest as he drove to check a report from police sources of an incident involving police and gunmen in the [REDACTED] district, in the west of the city.

"A team from Reuters news agency was on assignment to cover the killing of two policemen in [REDACTED] U.S. forces opened fire on the team from Reuters and killed [REDACTED] who was shot in the head, and wounded [REDACTED] an Interior Ministry official quoted the police incident report as saying.

"I heard shooting, looked up and saw an [REDACTED] American [REDACTED] the roof of the shopping centre," cameraman [REDACTED] who was wounded in the back, told colleagues who arrived at the scene.

The only known eyewitness, he was later detained by U.S. troops and was still in custody six hours later despite Reuters' requests that he be freed to receive medical attention. His precise whereabouts were not clear.

Two Iraqi colleagues who arrived on the scene minutes after the shooting were also briefly detained, then released.

"They treated us like dogs. They made us, including [REDACTED] who was wounded and asking for water, sit in the sun on the road," Reuters Television soundman [REDACTED] said.

Asked to comment on the incident, U.S. spokesman Lieutenant Colonel [REDACTED] said it was being investigated.

A U.S. statement said: "Task Force Baghdad units responded to a terrorist attack on an Iraqi Police convoy around 11:20 a.m. (0720 GMT) Aug. 28 in central Baghdad, which killed and wounded several Iraqi Police.

"One civilian was killed and another was wounded by small-arms fire during the attack ... After discovering an abandoned car with explosives material, weapons and a cell phone, units began searching the area for the terror suspects who were believed to have fled on foot."

REUTERS DEEPLY SADDENED

Reuters Global Managing Editor [REDACTED] said: "This tragic incident must immediately be investigated thoroughly and impartially."

"A brave journalist has lost his life and another has been wounded and detained when their only actions were as professionals reporting the facts and images of the war. We are deeply saddened at this loss."

Iraqis complain of frequent killings of civilians by U.S. forces, most of which go unreported and uninvestigated. American commanders say their troops are trained to be vigilant against suicide bombers and to avoid firing on civilians.

Reuters correspondent [REDACTED], who arrived at the scene about an hour after the shooting, said the soundman's body was still in the driver's seat, the face covered by a cloth.

Entry and exit wounds could be seen on the face indicating shots from the victim's right. There were several bullet holes in the windscreen and at least four wounds in the chest.

His U.S. military and Reuters press cards, clipped to his shirt, were soaked in blood. In one, there were two bullet holes.

To the right of the scene, a U.S. soldier, apparently a sniper, was posted on the roof of a shopping centre. A British security adviser working for Reuters said it seemed likely that high-velocity rounds had been fired at the car from roughly the direction of that building.

The car, an ordinary, white four-door passenger vehicle, was heading down an offramp, about 200 metres from a main road.

- John was going N. on [REDACTED] an overpass.

U.S. armoured vehicles blocked off the scene. After a brief inspection of the car, they allowed Reuters staff and the dead man's family to have it towed away. One soldier said there were no suspicious items in the car. Colleagues and relatives were handed a military body bag to remove the corpse.

A U.S. officer said: "They drove into fighting."

As [REDACTED] tearful relatives inspected the body at the scene, a U.S. soldier said: "Don't bother. It's not worth it." *- Soldiering [REDACTED] other Reuters' employees. He [REDACTED] the body covered [REDACTED] of respect. No one [REDACTED] themselves as relatives.*

A few other soldiers joked among themselves just a few feet (metres) from the body. *Soldiers were all gaily [REDACTED] employed pulling security*
[REDACTED] was a jovial character loved by colleagues with whom he had worked for two years. He leaves a 7-year-old daughter and his wife, who is four months pregnant.

Two Reuters cameramen have been killed by U.S. troops in Iraq since the U.S. invasion in 2003. A third was shot dead by a [REDACTED] in Ramadi last November in circumstances for which Reuters is still seeking an explanation from U.S. forces.

Reuters' cameraman in the city of Ramadi [REDACTED] was arrested by U.S. forces three weeks ago and is being held without charge in Abu Ghraib prison. U.S. military officials say he will face a judicial hearing as soon as Monday but have still given no access to the journalist or said what he is accused of.
