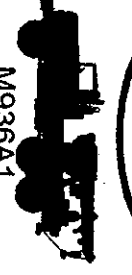

9. I, ██████, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On 12 NOV 05, 1/C/1-184 IN conducted a Cordon and Search of ██████ at ██████ at appx 2000 hours. I was present on the Operation as a C2/Cordon element. The OPORD for the brief included specific instructions for the establishment of blocking positions, including wire, signs and illumination, as per BDE and CO SOP. 1PLT found ██████ and ██████ in the residence. The Platoon completed the search at approximately 2100 hours on 12 NOV 05. As the Platoon exited to FOB ██████, the Company CP notified me that the TF TOC had a report of a blue Kia Sephia VBIED being constructed at a "garage" vic ██████. Company elements were actioned to the area earlier on 12 NOV 05 to look for a blue Kia Sephia reportedly being constructed as a VBIED. Company patrols searched the area for approximately 2 hours and did not locate the blue Kia. When the TF TOC asked 1PLT to search the garage at 2100 on 12 NOV 05, I called the TOC at approximately 2105 hours and asked the TF TOC to confirm the report. I spoke with TF S-2 CPT ██████, who told me a Division SIGINT report intercepted a cell phone transmission from the garage. The SIGINT intercept indicated a blue Kia Sephia was being constructed as a VBIED at the garage, possibly for use on 13 NOV 05. I told the TF TOC 1/C/1-184 would move to the garage compound and search it. At approximately 2110, two Squads from 1PLT dismounted southeast of the garage and began approaching it. Two M2A2 Bradley IFV's provided overwatch for the dismounted movement. The initial description of the target was a grid coordinate only. As the dismounted personnel approached the grid, they identified the target as a large walled compound. The compound is roughly square, approximately 200 meters on each side. At approximately 2120 hours, 1PLT dismounted personnel found the entry gate on the northwest corner of the compound. They entered the compound at approximately 2124 and began the search. I emplaced the remaining vehicles in a tight cordon around the compound. The nearby streets ran immediately adjacent to the compound. I emplaced the cordon with an eye to secure the target from nearby traffic, and to be able to immediately evacuate the dismounted personnel in the event the VBIED was found. My vehicle was on the midpoint of the west wall, blocking an east/west street that ended on the west wall of the compound. Based on radio traffic, I had a generally good picture of the location of CO vehicles. One Bradley IFV (████████) remained at the entry gate of the compound as overwatch of the search element. Within approximately 5 minutes of entering the compound, the Platoon Leader reported finding multiple AK-47's and personnel inside. Based on this, and the fact we heard several sustained SAF engagements from this general area while on our previous Cordon, I began to assign more credibility to the VBIED report. I purposely kept the cordon close to the compound to be able to immediately evacuate the dismounted personnel, or support them in the event of a VBIED detonation. The 1/C/1-184 Platoon Leader requested additional personnel to search the compound due to its size. The available dismounted personnel were all inside the compound. The remaining personnel were directly engaged in providing local security around Cordon positions. Three of the PLT M114's on the operation were left with minimal crews to enable them to be used as CASEVAC vehicles. I directed my 2nd Platoon, which was in sector on a patrol, to come to the compound and provide dismounted personnel to assist the search. At my cordon position, we emplaced cones and chemlights approximately 75 meters to our west to block the road and provide early warning to motorists. I saw the crew of C11, at the northwest corner of the cordon, begin to place chemlights on ██████ Road and RTE ██████ to warn LN drivers of the cordon. A Bradley IFV (████████) was parked near C11 on ██████ Road facing west to block eastbound traffic. At this time, to my knowledge, eastbound traffic on RTE ██████ was stopped at ██████ Bridge approximately 300 meters west of the Cordon. The traffic was halted by use of vehicle- and weapon-mounted spotlights. At approximately 2140, the 2/C/1-184 patrol arrived and began to dismount personnel to assist in the search of the compound. My intent was to use the 2PLT vehicles on RTE ██████ to block eastbound and westbound traffic. At approximately 2145, before the 2PLT vehicles could be moved onto RTE ██████, I heard 4 spaced single shots. A white sedan then entered my view near the northwest corner of the compound, travelling east on RTE ██████. I heard the Bradley coax machine gun fire a burst, then heard at least one more machine gun fire burst. The bursts were all short in duration. The firing lasted perhaps 10 seconds in total. Once the vehicle came to a stop on RTE ██████ just north of the garage compound, CO elements searched the vehicle and reported it was clear of explosives. I reported the Escalation of Force to the TF TOC. The CO 1SG went to the vehicle, and reported there were two LN casualties, one of which was litter urgent. I directed the CO 1SG and PLT CASEVAC element to immediately evacuate the injured local nationals. I went up to the LN vehicle. PLT MEDICS were treating two local national males. One of the males was unresponsive, and the MEDICS eventually began CPR. The subject, later identified as ██████, eventually died. The other local national, ██████, was subsequently evacuated to 86th CSH. I took several photographs of the vehicle.

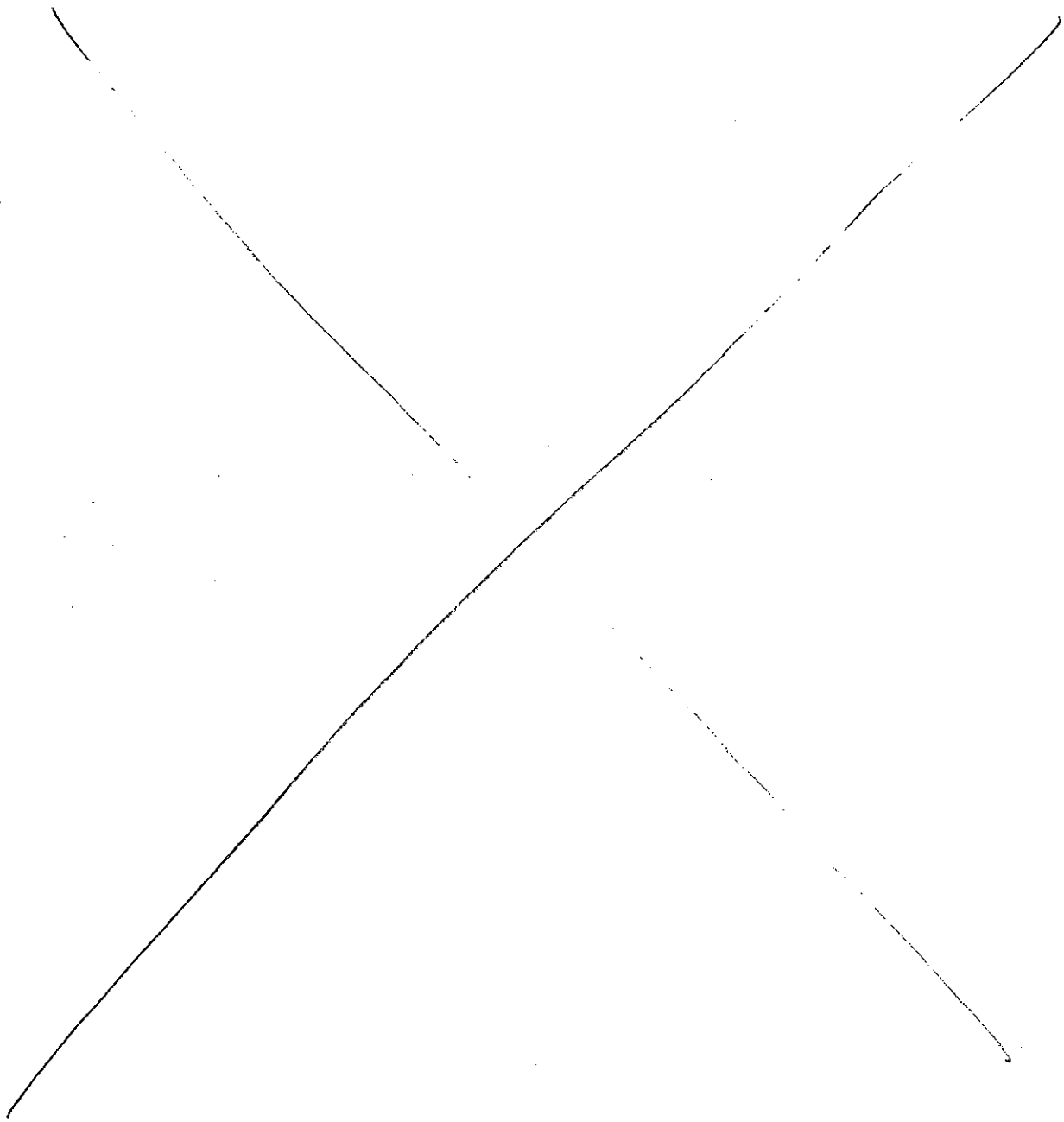

I then repositioned the Bradley IFVs onto RTE [REDACTED] to block eastbound and westbound traffic. Three 1PLT vehicles had left with the CASEVAC. I directed the 2PLT vehicles be used to secure the north and east side of the Cordon. I directed my CO QRF to come to the compound and secure the south side of the Cordon. An element from 3/C/1-184 arrived shortly thereafter and secured the south side of the garage compound. The operation at the garage compound eventually netted 7 AK 47's. We detained 5 personnel from the compound. At approximately 2330, we broke down the cordon around the garage compound and left the objective.

I, SERGEANT [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

at approximately 2140 in the vicinity of grid [REDACTED] on eastbound [REDACTED], I shot four warning shots at an Iraqi vehicle from my assigned weapon, an M4 A4. Minutes prior to that, our element had completed a raid and had been tasked with a follow on mission from battalion. This follow on mission had brought our element to the aforementioned grid, where dismounts were entering, clearing, and searching the target area. Specialist [REDACTED] and I dismounted from our vehicle, C 11, to begin setting up a cordon. He placed chemlights to the west of a Bradley that was at the 'T' of an intersection on [REDACTED] on both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], while I was placing chemlights to the east of the track on the same streets. Specialist [REDACTED] then fired a warning shot at an approaching vehicle and has detailed that in his own sworn statement. The Bradley crew had thrown some high-visibility bright orange chemlights onto [REDACTED] and I knew that we had some in our vehicle, and they were much easier to see than the older chemlights we had policed up from our cordon position at the previous raid, so I had Specialist [REDACTED] bring the box to me as I stayed on [REDACTED], in front of the Bradley. I took half of the chemlights, he took the other half, and I opened mine. I began tossing them out onto [REDACTED]. As I was setting up the cordon, throwing the chemlights out onto the road, a vehicle approached with its headlights on. Presumably in acknowledgement of our developing cordon position, traffic had stopped underneath and to the west of [REDACTED] Bridge, which was approximately one hundred fifty meters to my west, but this vehicle moved passed that traffic to approach our position. I flashed the vehicle with my Surefire flashlight. The vehicle advanced. I maintained a steady beam with my flashlight, motioning the vehicle to back up. The vehicle advanced. I aimed my weapon at the vehicle and actually shined my flashlight on my weapon to show the approaching vehicle that I was pointing my weapon to him. The vehicle advanced to approximately seventy-five meters ahead of me when I shot my first warning shot. I was moving down off of [REDACTED] as the vehicle moved to the median of the freeway, away from me, but kept heading eastward, I fired two more warning shots in front of the vehicle as it approached and then a final warning shot into the vehicle's body as it was nearly parallel to me. After that, the T/C of the Bradley behind me shot a round into the vehicle, as it was still advancing. The vehicle moved east on [REDACTED] passing all of our personnel and vehicles set on [REDACTED] until it was lit up by [REDACTED] platoon's QRF element, when it was immobilized.
