SECTION IV - FINDINGS (para 3-10, AR 15-6)

The (investigating officer) (board), having carefully considered the evidence, finds:

This investigation has not found the BN [redacted] team to be negligent or their actions outside of established BN Procedures with regards to the shooting of a Local National on 15 November 2005. On the evening of 15 November 2005, Delta Company, 3/7 Infantry was conducting a pre-planned large TCP in the North-bound lane of RTE [redacted] between [redacted] and [redacted]. The purpose of this TCP was to intercept AIF IED cells and their contraband that had been operating consistently in this area. Prior to establishing the TCP the BN [redacted] ([redacted]) were emplaced at [redacted], on the roof top of a duplex on the east side of RTE [redacted], to support and over watch the TCP. Their task was to observe vehicles in the TCP and report or action on any suspicious behavior consistent with AIF activity. The TPT team was also on site with a speaker truck to broadcast instructions to local nationals in the search area. Their task was to drive up and down the cordoned area and instruct the local nationals not to leave, to turn off their vehicles, get out of their vehicles, and wait to be searched. According to the TPT team leader they made several passes, broadcasting loudly in Arabic.

At approximately 1830 the [redacted] element observed suspicious activity near the rear of the cordoned search area. SGT [redacted] and SGT [redacted] watched a man, [redacted], emerge from a black 4 door car, squat down around the car, re-enter the car and again exit the car. The second time [redacted] exited the car he walked toward the median of the road and was met by two male drivers of other vehicles. The three males talked for several minutes before [redacted] unaccompanied, walked 30 meters to the rear of the vehicles with an unidentified object. As [redacted] neared an old IED crater on the east side of the road, he paused, placed or tossed an unknown and unidentifiable object into the crater. SGT [redacted], SGT [redacted], and SPC [redacted] all witnessed [redacted] place an object into the crater. Next [redacted] returned to his vehicle, as did the other two males he was earlier talking to enter their respective vehicles, and they attempted to drive over the median curb and get into traffic traveling south. Unable to establish communications with CPT [redacted], SGT [redacted] ordered SGT [redacted] and SPC [redacted] to fire disabling shots at the vehicles until an element from the cordon could action on the vehicles. After a total of 4 disabling shots- 3 by SGT [redacted] and 1 by SPC [redacted], the two white cars stopped, [redacted], driving the black car, continued west towards the median. SGT [redacted] fired 3 shots and SPC [redacted] fired 1 shot at [redacted] car to disable it, but the vehicle did not stop. As the car jumped up onto the curb and began to enter the southern lane, SGT [redacted] ordered SPC [redacted] to fire through the windshield at the driver. With this single shot the car stopped all shots were taken from appx. 120 meters with a [redacted] and [redacted] [redacted], using [redacted] and [redacted].

Once these shots were fired CPT [redacted] along with Soldiers from White Platoon arrived at the scene. CPT [redacted] and a Platoon Medic assessed [redacted] as KIA/DOW, and a female passenger in one of the white vehicles, [redacted], as WIA from window fragments. Both Local National casualties were taken to [redacted] Hospital by Iraqi Police. EOD assets were contacted, dispatched, and they determined that the object that Mr. [redacted] emplaced was in fact not an IED, but an empty rice bag.

SECTION V - RECOMMENDATIONS (para 3-11, AR 15-6)

In view of the above findings, the (investigating officer) (board) recommends:

It is the recommendation of this investigating officer that no actions be taken against any of the [redacted] team members. All Soldiers involved acted in accordance with prescribed ROE and escalation of force procedures, which allow the use of deadly force to prevent harm to friendly Soldiers and civilians. The team had good observation of the area with both thermal and night vision optics. The actions of Mr. [redacted] were suspicious and consistent with AIF TTP's on emplacing IED's. SGT [redacted] assessed that Mr. [redacted] had an IED, and was emplacing it to avoid being caught by coalition forces in the TCP, and was then attempting to flee the area. Other local nationals in the vicinity of this activity followed the instructions of CF and the TPT team- they stopped, exited, and opened their vehicles and then stood by to be searched. Although the death of Mr. [redacted] is unfortunate, and his family should be compensated in accordance with the BN SOP, the Soldiers involved in his death were acting within standard operating procedures of the company and battalion. As always when deadly force is used, regardless of the situation, TTP's, ROE, and escalation of force should be reviewed and trained. This training should be conducted at the platoon and squad level, to ensure the continuation of their proper use. Had the object Mr. [redacted] emplaced in the IED crater been an IED, and he be allowed to flee the area, casualties from both American Soldiers and Iraqi civilians would have been imminent.

LINE 6: SUMMARY OF INCIDENT: Unit (D-6) was stationary on Rte. [REDACTED] conducting TCP facing north. Unit had deployed cones and concertina wire as standoff kit. Unit had a group of vehicles inside cordon conducting search of vehicles. [REDACTED] were emplaced on the eastern side of Rte [REDACTED] @ [REDACTED]. A vehicle (Dark Blue 4dr Kia sedan) was stopped with two other vehicles to the south of the TCP. Sniper element reported driver exited the vehicle and moved to the rear of the vehicle and began to act suspiciously. His specific actions were masked by the vehicle. L/N then returned to vehicle and waited with other stopped vehicles. This information was radioed to the unit conducting the TCP. They acknowledged and said they would search the vehicle thoroughly when they reached the TCP. A few minutes later driver then re-exited vehicle. Driver and two other personnel from trail vehicles (white sedans) began to move to the median of Irish and conversed for a few minutes. First person from the dark blue sedan then moved south approximately and moved to an old IED crater site on the eastern side of the south bound lane. After standing around observing the checkpoint driver was seen dropping something in the crater site. Other two personnel began walking to crater site when they saw original person moving back to his vehicle. [REDACTED] element attempted to call unit on the ground to advise the [REDACTED] were unable to establish coms at this time. Driver and two personnel then began moving back to vehicles still waiting to be called forward to TCP. All personnel re-entered the vehicles. At this time all three vehicles began backing up and attempting to turn out of traffic and began moving to drive over the median and merge into south bound traffic. When [REDACTED] saw this begin to take place they engaged the two white sedans (vehicles 2 and 3). After the rounds hit the vehicles both white sedans stopped. Lead sedan continued moving trying to drive over median. Vehicle was engaged with disabling rounds into the vehicle. The vehicle continued moving and the snipers incapacitated the driver by shooting through the windshield. At this point all three vehicles were stopped. Unit then began moving to the vehicles to assess the casualties. Driver was removed from lead vehicle and was found to be KIA. [REDACTED] had regained commo with unit on ground at this time. Driver of lead vehicle was removed from vehicle and found to be KIA. Other vehicles were searched by ground unit and found 1x L/N woman WIA hit in shoulder. IP forces on scene took both shot personnel to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] were [REDACTED] at this time due to having [REDACTED] their position. When ground unit had finished assessing scene they collapsed cordon and returned to FOB. There was no IED found in IED crater where L/N was seen dropping bag. White Burlap bag was found at site but bag was empty. Unit believes this was dry run by enemy and to verify [REDACTED] were emplaced. Ground unit is providing sworn statements as well regarding incidents. 3-7 IN will provide updates as received from company. Company will also be going to [REDACTED] to question woman who was shot.

9. I, [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

At approximately 1730 hours Delta Company established a traffic control point between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] were placed in a position to overwatch vehicles as they waited to be searched. Engagement criteria was given to SGT [REDACTED] the [REDACTED] leader. The guidance allowed for engagement of enemy vehicles and or personnel if suspicious activity is observed which the [REDACTED] Team leader feels is consistent with past IED emplacement activity along Route [REDACTED]. Escalation of force consistent with the ROE was to be followed. The [REDACTED] broadcast a message to the Iraqi's in the search lane which stated that they should remain in their vehicles, not attempt to exit the search lane, and that deadly force was authorized. At approximately 1900 hours the [REDACTED] Team observed suspicious activity consistent with the engagement criteria. A warning shot was fired at a dark sedan attempting to exit the search lane. The occupant was observed removing an item from the trunk of his car and placing the item in an IED crater. The Iraqi got back in his car and as he attempted to exit the lane the warning shot was fired. The vehicle continued to attempt to exit the lane. At this point shots were fired to disable the vehicle. The vehicle accelerated and continued to flee. At this point the [REDACTED] fired at the windshield killing the driver. At this point a silver sedan attempted to back out of the search lane. One shot was fired into the hood disabling the vehicle. I arrived on the scene approximately five minutes after the last shot was fired. The potential IED site was secured and all civilian personnel were removed from the area for their safety. I removed the Iraqi male who was shot from his vehicle and attempted to determine if he was alive. Due to the extent of his injuries it was my opinion that he was dead. A medic was summoned and Iraqi Police were called. At this time the male driver of the silver car informed me that his wife was injured. A medic examined her and determined that she had a small entry wound in her shoulder with no exit wound. The wound was not bleeding and appeared to be caused by glass fragments. The woman was transported to the hospital in an Iraqi Ambulance. The Iraqi Police explained to the woman's husband why his vehicle had been shot and he was given a claims card. I asked the Iraqi male why he chose to put himself in danger by disregarding the message that the TPT had broadcast. He admitted that he did hear the TPT but chose to attempt to exit the search lane anyway. The [REDACTED] conducted a search of the IED crater and did not locate any additional explosives. All remaining vehicles in the search lane were searched and we returned to the FOB [REDACTED].

Around 1730 Sgt [redacted], SPC [redacted] SPC [redacted] + myself set in an [redacted] position, A two story house east of route [redacted]
Around 18:00 Delta established there cordon + began searching cars.
Around 18:30 [redacted] I spotted a Iraqi National exit his car and walk to the rear of his car, I told Sgt [redacted] + we got eyes on we both seen the man kneel down behind the car but from our position we could not see what he was doing. The man then got back in the car. A couple minutes later he exited the car again along with 2 other men all getting out of seperate cars. All 3 of them walked about 30 meters behind the cars over to the east curb right at a place of an earlier IED had been set off. The man that was closest to the hole, the same man that earlier was kneeling behind his black car, dropped something in the hole then all three of the men got back in there cars, All 3 of the men started [redacted] back out of the Cordon. Sgt [redacted] was trying to get comms with higher for guidance, After nothing he told us to disable the vehicle. I shot 3 rounds at the white car. Then the car stopped. I then got eyes on the black car at that time the car was not stopping so I fired 2 shots at the black car.

At that time also SPC [redacted] shot one round, the black car then started going forward I fired another round. SGT [redacted] then told SPC [redacted] to take the man down as the car was going for the median, then the car stopped, SGT [redacted] called up a sit rep and then the soldiers on the ground went to the rear of the cordon to assess the situation.

To clarify when all 3 of the men where out of there cars it was the man from the black car that was at the IED hole the other [redacted] men did not go all the way to the hole but they did all talk behind the cars, Nothing else follows

I, [REDACTED], WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On 15 Nov 2005, @ approx. 1915 in VC Grid [REDACTED] I was on mission with my team consisting of SGT [REDACTED] SPC [REDACTED], and SPC [REDACTED]. We were set up in an [REDACTED] position on top of a local national duplex on the east side of RT [REDACTED] while Dew conducted a cordon and search of the north bound lane traffic. At the time I had SPC [REDACTED] watching to the north, SGT [REDACTED] watching to the south, SPC [REDACTED] watching the traffic in the center and myself scanning anything that was brought to my attention. SGT [REDACTED] indicated he had to the rear of the traffic a local national had gotten out of his vehicle and had moved to the rear of it. I began to scan the area with my PAS13 thermal sight. I witnessed the individual squatting on the opposite side of the vehicle from us and appeared to be doing something under the vehicle. The vehicle was a black car, unknown make, with 4 doors. At that time I called in a SITREP to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] of what I saw and was [REDACTED] back to continue to monitor and they would conduct a more thorough search of the vehicle once it got to the [REDACTED] check point. Approximately 7 minutes later I witnessed the local national exit the vehicle again and move over to the median of the road. After the drivers of 2 other vehicles at the rear, [REDACTED] both white 4 door cars of unknown make, exited their cars and moved over to the median as well. All 3 local nationals appeared to be conversing for a couple of minutes. Then the local national from the first black vehicle moved away and began to walk along the curb on the east side lane, back approx 30m from his vehicle and stopped next to [REDACTED] a former IED site. I was watching him on my thermal, SGT [REDACTED] was watching him through an [REDACTED] with a [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] was watching with a [REDACTED] .50cal [REDACTED] when all 3 of us witnessed him toss an unknown object in the center. The other 2 individuals who he was talking with earlier moved about half way to where he was when he started walking back to his car. At that time I began to try and get [REDACTED] cons with [REDACTED] to seek guidance on the situation. While that was going on all 3 local nationals got back in their cars and began to back up from the rest of the traffic. The black car was first, followed by the 2 white

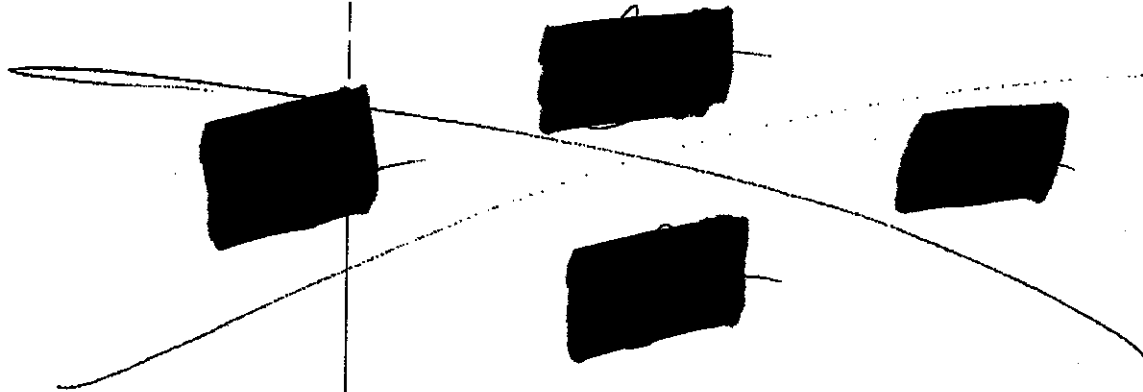

I ordered SGT [REDACTED] and SPC [REDACTED] to fire disabling shots in the vehicles with their [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. After the first couple of shots the 2 white vehicles stopped while the black vehicle continued to back up. 2 more shots were fired and failed to halt the last car. I then ordered SPC [REDACTED] to fire to fire another round through the windshield at the driver as he was trying to jump the median. After SPC [REDACTED] fired this last round the vehicle finally halted. The driver did not get out. At that time I finally established cons with [REDACTED] who informed me he was coming to assess the situation. Nothing else follows.
