Pursuant to Ohio Civil Rule 15(A), Plaintiffs Women's Med Group Professional Corporation and Planned Parenthood Southwest Ohio Region (collectively "Plaintiffs"), by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby move to amend their complaint to challenge parts of Ohio's licensing scheme for abortion-providing ambulatory surgical facilities under the newly adopted Right to Reproductive Freedom Amendment, Article I, Section 22 of the Ohio Constitution. The Amendment directs that the State "shall not, directly or indirectly, burden, penalize, prohibit, interfere with, or discriminate against" a person voluntarily exercising this right or an individual or entity helping them do so. Ohio Constitution, Article I, Section 22. This new provision took effect in December 2023.

On April 11, 2024, Defendants indicated via email that they do not oppose Plaintiffs' Motion. *See* Civ.R. 15(A) (parties may file an amended pleading at this stage of litigation "with the opposing party's written consent or the court's leave"). Plaintiffs have alleged sufficient support for the new matters they seek to plead and have not acted in bad faith, caused undue delay, or caused undue prejudice to Defendants. *See Danopulos v. Am. Trading II, LLC*, 2016-Ohio-5014, 69 N.E.3d 157, ¶ 24 (1st Dist.); *see also Hoover v. Sumlin*, 12 Ohio St.3d 1, 6, 465 N.E.2d 377 (1984) ("The language of Civ.R. 15(A) favors a liberal amendment policy and a motion for leave to amend should be granted absent a finding of bad faith, undue delay or undue prejudice to the opposing party."). Accordingly, Plaintiffs respectfully request that this Unopposed Motion for Leave to Amend their Complaint be granted.
