

At approximately 6:45 PM, Officer Biederman spoke by telephone with roommate [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) who was at the airport (he thought with the other 2 roommates) about to board a flight to Pittsburgh. He learned that she had no idea where [REDACTED] was, they had a fuss with [REDACTED] and hadn't seen her in weeks. Not seeing her would be easy if [REDACTED] entered and exited the 3rd floor door.

At about 7:37 PM, I requested Communications Supervisor Emily Hillman to determine through T-Mobile if the phone was on or not. At about 7:54 PM, she let me know that T-Mobile said the telephone was on and the phone was tracking on SR 309 ([REDACTED]) just north of the Florida line, south of Attapulgus, GA. (we later believed this to be a mistake).

At about 8:00 PM, with the approval of Wright, I requested the on-call investigator of the Special Victims Unit to call me and a few minutes later, I spoke with Inv. Rhonda Kerce, briefing her on the situation. She told me that she would get in touch with Inv. Corbett.

Kerce called me back just before 9:00 PM and said Corbett had spoken to T-Mobile and learned the phone was tracking on [REDACTED]. Taylor's apartment sits approximate 40 feet west of [REDACTED].

At about 9:45 PM, we entered the apartment and [REDACTED] bedroom again and did not find her.

At about 10:00 PM, Biederman spoke with roommates [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who said they were on the way back from Jacksonville. They told him that they saw [REDACTED] in passing 2 days ago.

At about 10:45 PM, Inv Corbett arrived and determined that [REDACTED] telephone was on the second floor of apartment. I called [REDACTED] mother, who said she had just received a text message from [REDACTED] telling her to get the fucking cops away from her door.

I spoke to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] by telephone and requested that they come home and let us make sure Taylor wasn't their rooms.

At about 11PM, we checked their bedrooms and the rest of common areas, and again made entry into [REDACTED] bedroom. I found her hiding in a ball behind a clothes hamper in her closet. She denied being in the apartment prior, arriving home about 30 minutes ago. Note : we had been watching her apartment since the initial entry.

I called her mother back, telling her we had [REDACTED] and she was okay. I asked her to forward me [REDACTED] emails to me and she refused. Saying she was worried what [REDACTED] would do when she got out.
