BEFORE THE COURT is Defendants/Petitioners Motion to Expedite (ECF No. 66) which seeks expedited hearing on the <u>fourth</u> Motion to Compel (No. 64) filed in case # 16-36. Defendants' fourth Motion to Compel seeks to compel the depositions of two CIA officials. The deadline for completion of discovery in this matter is February 17, 2017, with the limited extension the court has granted for specified depositions and medical exams to March 20, 2017. The filing of this fourth Motion to Compel does not comply with the court's Scheduling Order. (See ECF No. 59 in Case # 15-286)("Any motion to compel discovery shall be filed, served and heard on or before the discovery deadline."). Defendants state they issued a subpoena for the two depositions on December 1, 2016, and were not informed the Government would not produce the individuals until February 13, 2017. The court finds good cause for expediting resolution of the fourth Motion to

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The Motion to Expedite (ECF No. 66) is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**. The court grants expedited consideration, but denies at this time the request for oral argument.
- 2. The Government shall file a Response to the fourth Motion to Compel (ECF No. 64) no later than **Wednesday**, **February 22**, **2017**, **at noon**.
- 3. Defendants' Reply brief, if any, shall be filed no later than **February 24, 2017**, **at noon**. The Motion to Compel will be deemed submitted for decision as of February 24, 2017, unless the court determines after submission of the briefs oral argument is warranted. If the court determines oral argument would be beneficial, it will issue a notice setting hearing.

IT IS SO ORDERED. The Clerk is hereby directed to enter this Order and furnish copies to counsel.
