Defendants President Joseph R. Biden, et al., ("Defendants") respectfully notify the Court about recent developments in the above-captioned case. On January 15, 2021, Plaintiffs Leila N. Sadat, et al., ("Plaintiffs") initiated the instant lawsuit challenging Executive Order 13928 ("Blocking Property of Certain Persons Associated With the International Criminal Court") pursuant to the First Amendment of the U.S. Constitution and the Administrative Procedure Act. See Compl., ECF No. 1. Plaintiffs subsequently filed a motion for a preliminary injunction, ECF No. 42; the Court adopted the parties' proposed briefing schedule, which requires Defendants to file a response to Plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction by Friday, April 9, 2021. See Order, ECF No. 44.

On April 1, 2021, President Biden terminated the national emergency declared in Executive Order 13928 revoked the Order. Exec. available and See Order. https://www.whitehouse.gov/briefing-room/presidential actions/2021/04/01/executive-order-onthe-termination-of-emergency-with-respect-to-the-international-criminal-court/; see also Press Statement, available at https://www.state.gov/ending-sanctions-and-visa-restrictions-againstpersonnel-of-the-international-criminal-court/. And on April 5, 2021, the Office of Foreign Assets Control within the Department of the Treasury removed Ms. Fatou Bensouda and Mr. Phakiso Mochochoko from the list of Specially Designated Nationals and Blocked Persons—persons blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13928. See Recent Activity, available at https://home.treasury.gov/policy-issues/financial-sanctions/recent-actions/20210405 33.

Accordingly, undersigned counsel contacted Plaintiffs' counsel to schedule a time to confer about these recent developments. In particular, Defendants would like to discuss whether Plaintiffs
