1. I am counsel for Plaintiffs in this action. Except as otherwise stated, the information contained in this declaration is based upon my personal knowledge and if called upon to testify, I could and would competently testify thereto.

FHFA's Failure to Search Agency Phone Messages

- 2. Defendant FHFA has not searched Agency phone messages which may be responsive to Plaintiffs' FOIA request, because "Plaintiffs' FOIA request did not identify any individuals who may have called the Agency." *See* ECF No. 47 at 8. Plaintiffs have previously disputed this decision not to search Agency phone messages in their Cross-Motion and Opposition. *See* ECF No. 41 at 12-13.
- 3. I have reviewed all of the documents produced by FHFA to Plaintiffs and have identified several instances in which the documents reflect that Agency officials exchanged phone calls and phone messages with trade group representatives about eminent domain. Evidence of these phone calls is contained in the Agency's first production of documents, dated December 30, 2013, relevant excerpts of which are attached as Exhibit 1 to this declaration.
- 4. The excerpts attached as Exhibit 1 include: (1) a July 23, 2012 email from Michael Powers at FHFA to Jon Greenlee at FHFA, in which Mr. Powers forwards a statement by SIFMA about eminent domain and states: "Not sure you are aware of this *I received a lengthy voicemail from Richard Dorfman*. You may want to give him a call." Exh. 1 at Bates 1 (emphasis added). Richard Dorfman is cc'd on the email and has a "sifma.org" email address; (2) an April 18, 2013 email from Chris Killian, with a "sifma.org" email address, to Alfred Pollard, FHFA General Counsel, cc'ing Richard Dorman, and forwarding an email about SIFMA sending letters to officials in Richmond, CA and North Las Vegas, NV opposing eminent domain proposals. The email from Mr. Killian to Mr. Pollard reads: "I wanted to send this your way; Richard may have given you a heads up *earlier this week when you spoke*. ... Have a good weekend *if we don't speak*." *Id*. at Bates 2 (emphasis added); and (3) a June 11, 2013 email from Chris Killian to Alfred Pollard, in
