- I, Brian S. Paszamant, hereby certify under penalty of perjury, that the following is true and correct and within my personal knowledge:
- 1. I am over the age of 18, have personal knowledge of all facts contained in this declaration, and am competent to testify as a witness to those facts.
  - 2. I am one of the attorneys representing Defendants James Elmer Mitchell and John "Bruce" Jessen (collectively, "<u>Defendants</u>") in the above-captioned action.
- 3. On or about November 29, 2016, I executed an affidavit and the accompanying subpoenas in accordance with *Touhy* and the regulations promulgated thereunder for submitting a request for information to the Central Intelligence Agency ("CIA"), as well as pursuant to the procedures established by the parties (the "*Touhy* Request"). The *Touhy* Request sought testimony from CIA employee "Gina Doe, former Chief of Staff to Jose Rodriguez when he served as the Chief of the CIA's Clandestine Service and former Deputy to Jose Rodriguez when he served as the Director of the CIA's Counterterrorism Center," and from CIA employee "John/Jane Doe, former Chief of Special Missions for the CIA's CTC and immediate successor to Jim Cotsana in that position and who also served as the Chief of the CIA's CTC Renditions Group." A true and correct copy of the *Touhy* Request is attached hereto as **Ex. A**.

4. On December 1, 2016, I served a copy of the *Touhy* Request on the CIA by transmitting it to Mr. Andrew Warden via email and regular mail. A true and correct copy of my December 1, 2016, email to Mr. Warden is attached hereto as Ex. B.

- 5. On December 14, Mr. Warden responded to my December 1, 2016, email by accepting service of the Touhy Request "on behalf of the CIA." Mr. Warden also stated that he "passed the request on to the appropriate officials at CIA for a decision," and said that he would "advise me once the CIA has made a decision on [the] *Touhy* request."
- Having heard nothing from Mr. Warden or the CIA for two weeks, I again reached out to Mr. Warden via email on January 2, 2017, to inquire about "any movement" from the CIA.
- 7. On February 8, 2017, I emailed Mr. Warden yet again to "follow[] up on the [Touhy Request]. As you can see, it has been quite some time since service of the *Touhy* requests. Of course, we would like to avoid unnecessary motion practice if possible. Please advise."
- Finally, on February 13, 2017, Mr. Warden responded to my 8. December 1, 2016, email and said the CIA will "not authorize" the requested depositions of Gina "Doe" and/or John/Jane "Doe."
- 9. The date of compliance for the Gina "Doe" deposition was January 4, 2017; the date of compliance for the John/Jane "Doe" deposition was January 5, 2017. Both depositions were to occur at defense counsel's Washington, D.C. offices.

- 10. Prior to Mr. Warden's February 13, 2017, email, and despite having the *Touhy* Request since December 1, 2016, the CIA never objected to the subpoenas to Gina "Doe and/or John/Jane "Doe." Nor has it attempted to identify and/or narrow the proposed topics for deposition (as was done with other CIA deponents).
- Defendants' motion to dismiss and preliminary discovery issues. (ECF No. 38.) Mr. Warden appeared at the hearing. Throughout the hearing, the Court advised that the action would be proceeding into discovery and informed the parties and Mr. Warden it expected the Government would cooperate in discovery. The Court also made clear the parties should bring discovery issues to its attention: "[i]f you, whether it be a party or the Department of Justice, that you represent, the United States, want to object, then present the objections and I'll rule upon it." A true and correct copy of select portions from the April 22, 2016, hearing is attached as **Ex. C.**
- 12. On July 8, 2016, the Court held a telephonic scheduling conference. (ECF No. 58.)
- 13. During the conference, the Court set a February 17, 2017, discovery deadline. (ECF No. 59  $\P$  7). A true and correct copy of the Court's *Scheduling Order* is attached as **Ex. D**.
- 14. During the July 8, 2016, conference, the Court specifically asked Mr. Warden if the Government had any issues with the dates proposed, and the Government said, "[t]he dates you've set, your Honor, are acceptable to the

25 26 Government." The Court then reiterated that any discovery issues should be promptly brought to its attention because it is "not going to delay this case at the instance of the Government." Defendants also specifically asked if the Court would potentially order the Government to respond to *Touhy* requests within a certain timeframe and the Court responded:

Well, the case is assigned to me. I'll decide the issues . . . as they arise. And, if there's an issue, get it timely noted in a motion or other filing; and I'll give the Government a reasonable period of time. I'm not going to let the Government delay this case, and I'm not going to let defendants delay this case because they say, well, there's classified information that . . . issue[] need[s] to be resolved.

A true and correct copy of select portions of the transcript from the July 8, 2016, hearing is attached as **Ex. E**.

- The CIA only recently officially acknowledged Gina "Doe's" 15. identity as Gina Haspel on February 2, 2017, when she was selected to serve as Deputy Director of the CIA. A true and correct copy of the posting from the CIA's website (available https://www.cia.gov/news-information/press-releasesstatements/2017-press-releases-statements/gina-haspel-selected-to-be-deputydirector-of-cia.html#) is attached as Ex. F.
- 16. On the same day the CIA acknowledged Gina "Doe's" identity as Gina Haspel, the New York Times published an article titled "New C.I.A. Deputy Director, Gina Haspel, Had Leading Role in Torture." This article discussed Ms. Haspel having played a "direct role in the C.I.A.'s 'extraordinary rendition program"; that she "oversaw" the interrogation of terrorism suspects; and that the CIA's first overseas detention site in Thailand was "run by Ms. Haspel, who
