DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Pursuant to Rule 56 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Defendants move for summary judgment and ask this Court to grant judgment in their favor with respect to Plaintiffs' claims to procedural due process. *See* Third Am.
